
St Vincent de Paul was



Year 3 have been finding out about St Vincent de Paul and his work then made cards to spread joy to those who might be missing their family because St Vincent cared for others too.










In Yr 2 Science lessons this week the children explored the affect exercise has on our body.


Enjoying God 's Wonderful World and looking

In year 5A, we like to finish the week with a dance!






