... while 4 were making circuits to test different materials, to investigate if they are insulators or conductors.

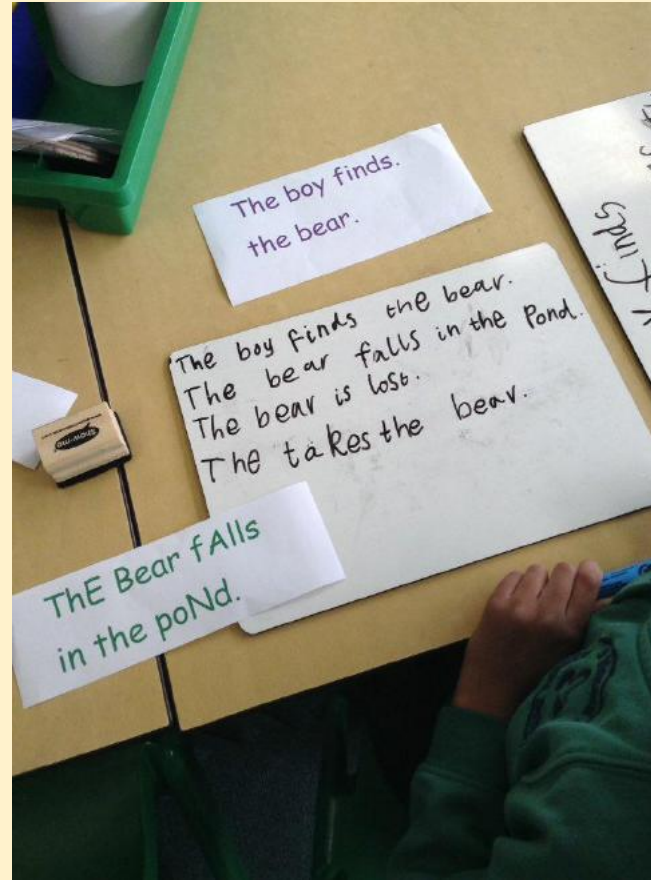


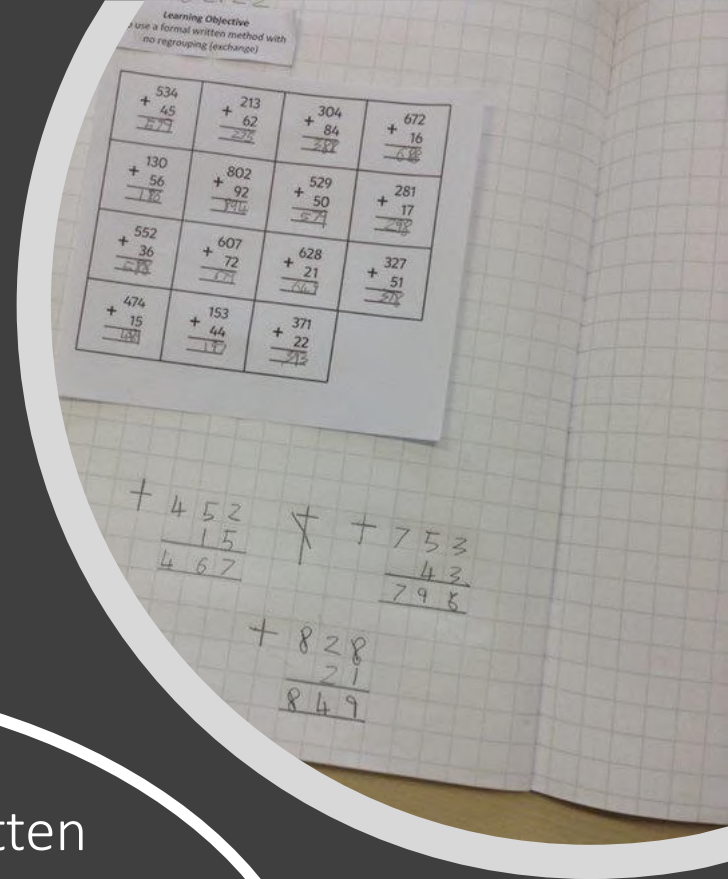
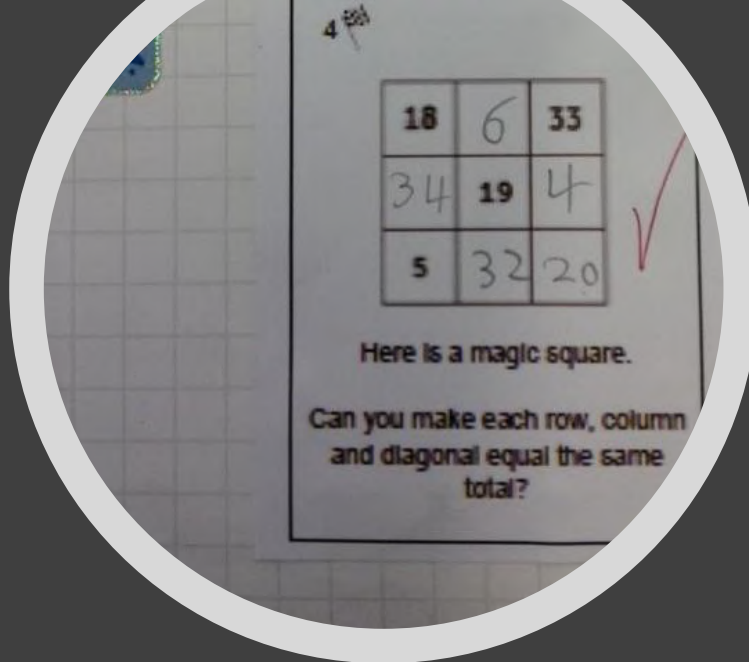
Reception read "The Three Billy Goat Gruff".

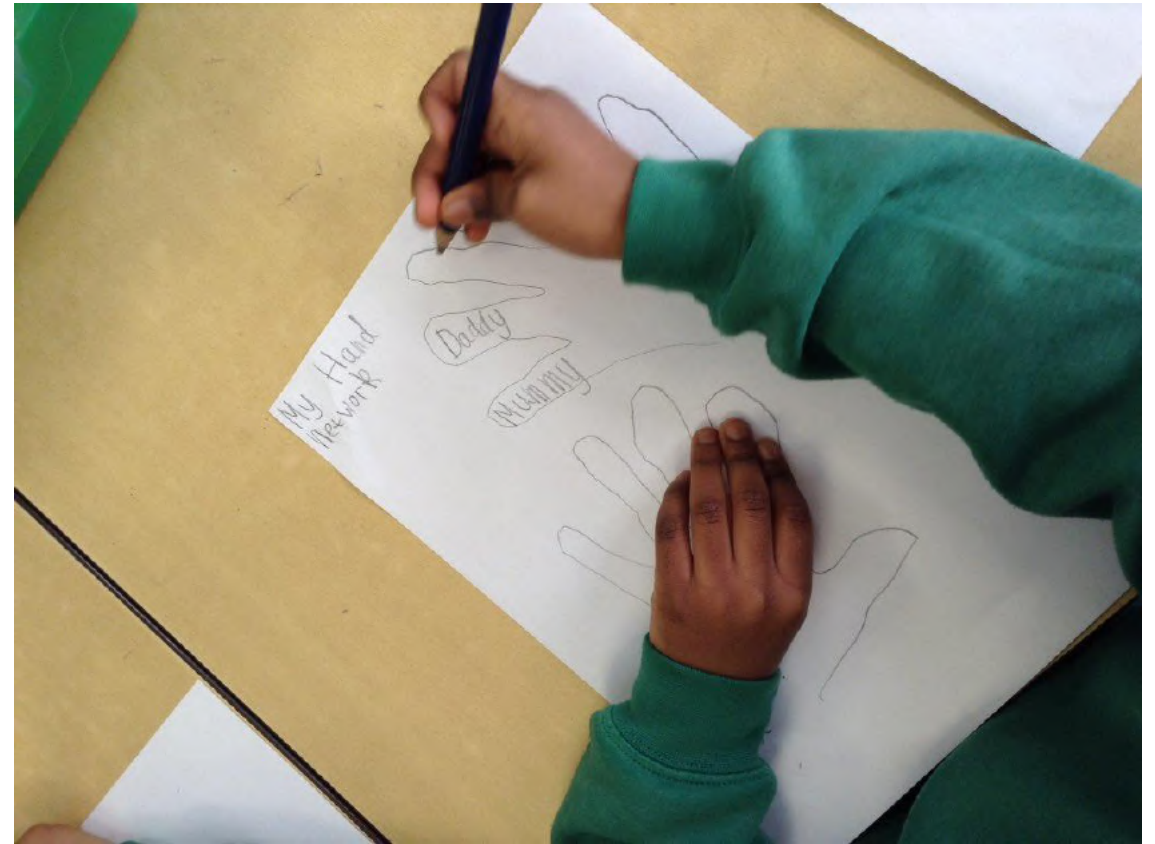
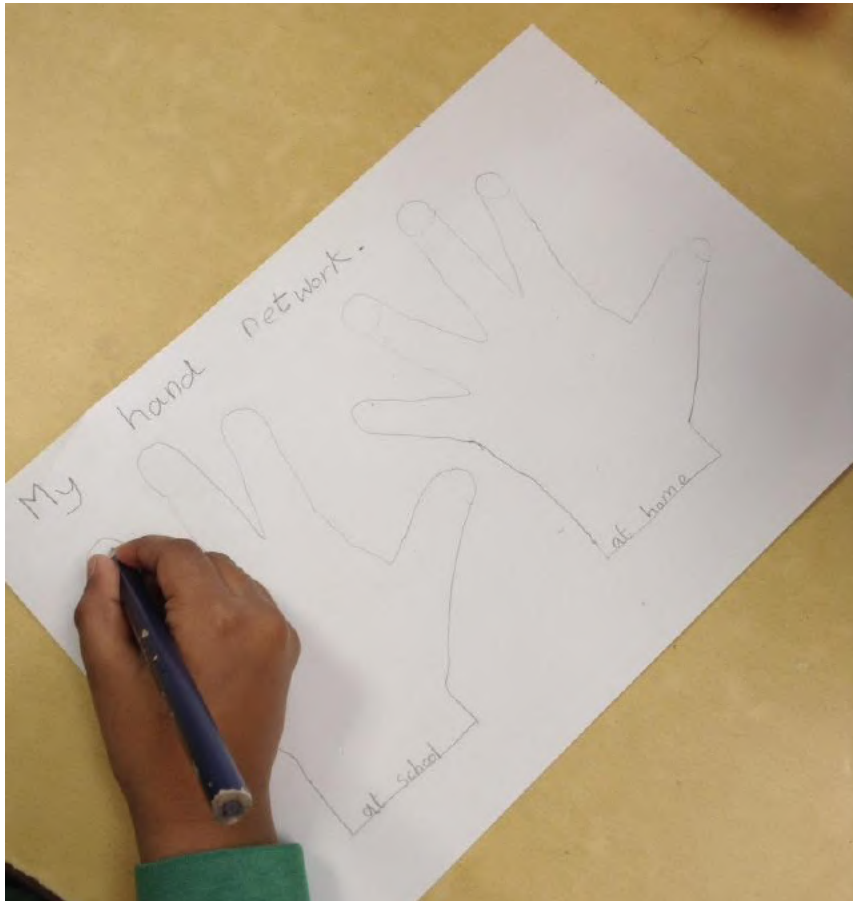


# Fully involved whilst exploring mark-making using different media
