

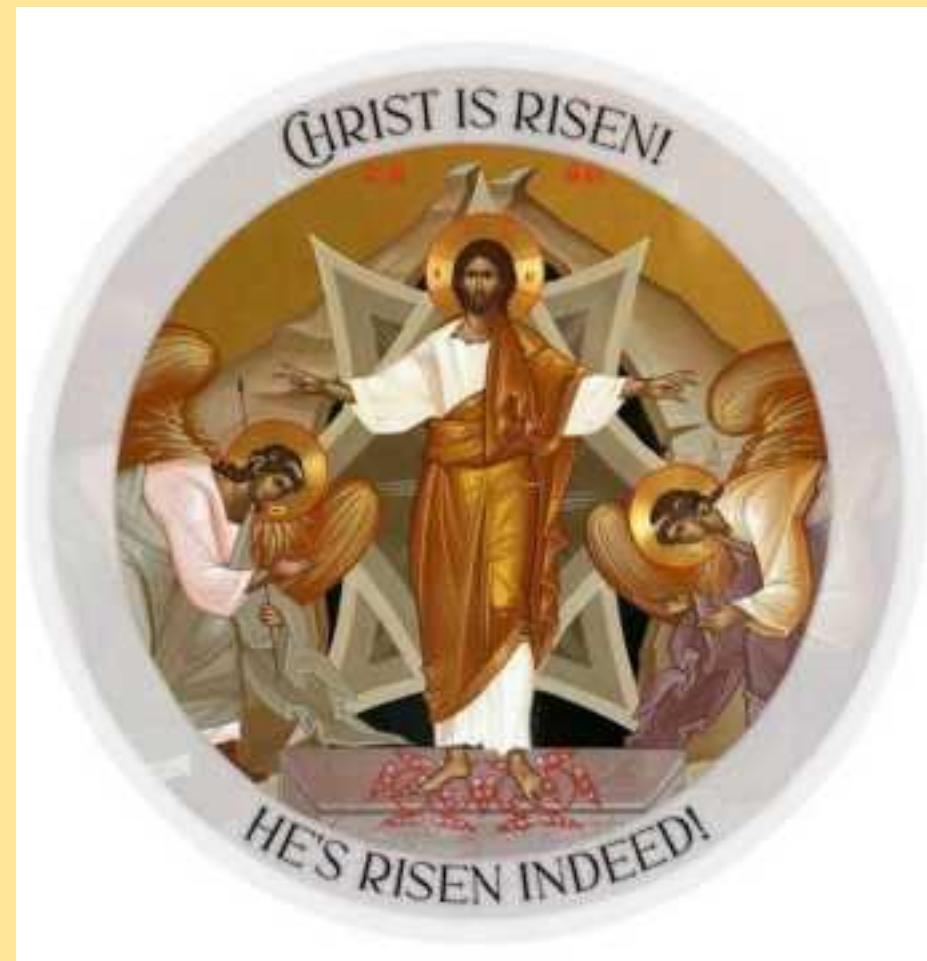

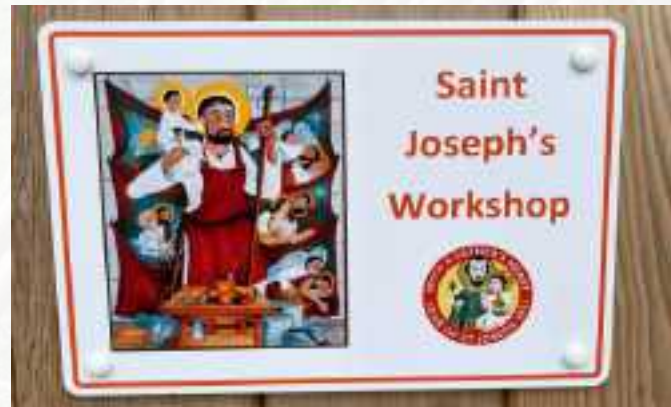
When we wished everyone a happy St George's day last weekend we also said "Happy Easter" to the Orthodox members of our community and Bishop Angaelos.

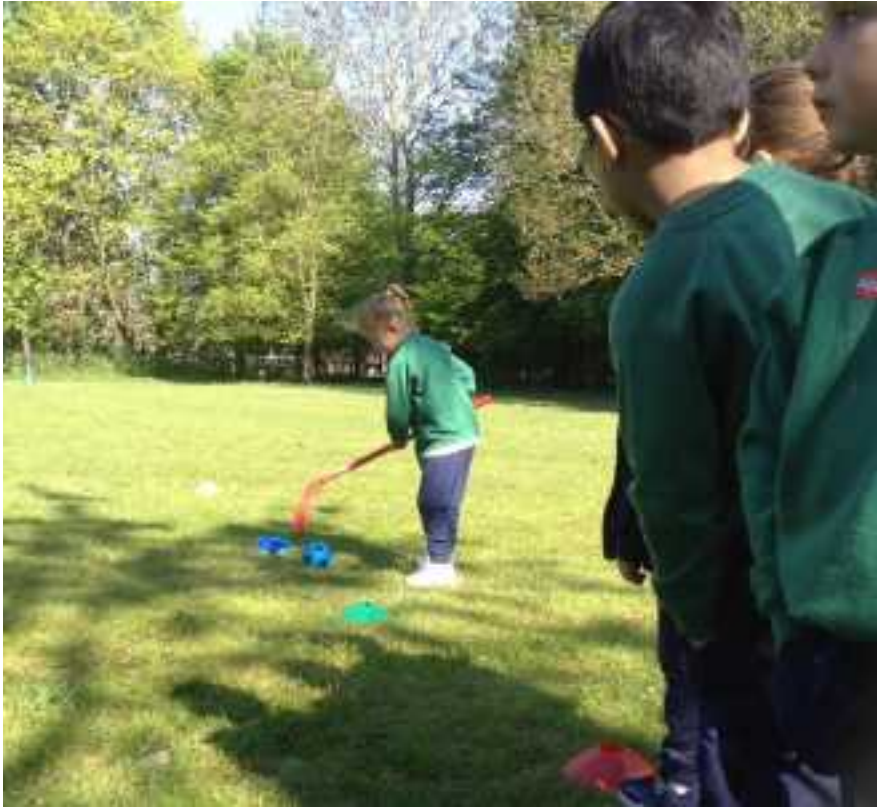


The children have been busy finding out facts about snails. They spent time chatting to him whilst practising their sketching skills

The children learned about different types of homes and then drew a picture of where they live.

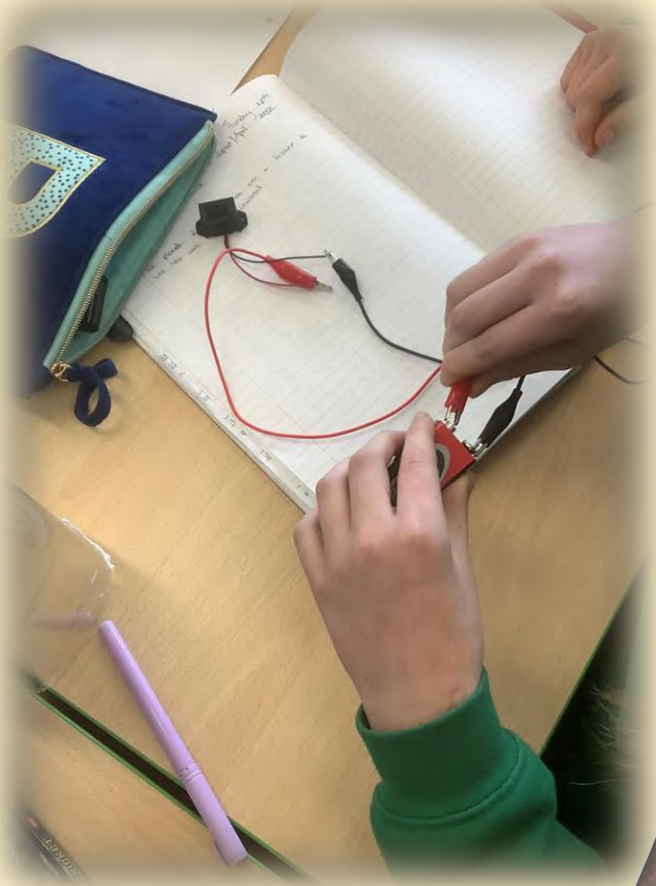
Year 3 have been using a range of conjunctions to extend given sentences by playing a game with dice. They have also been learning to identify prepositions in sentences.

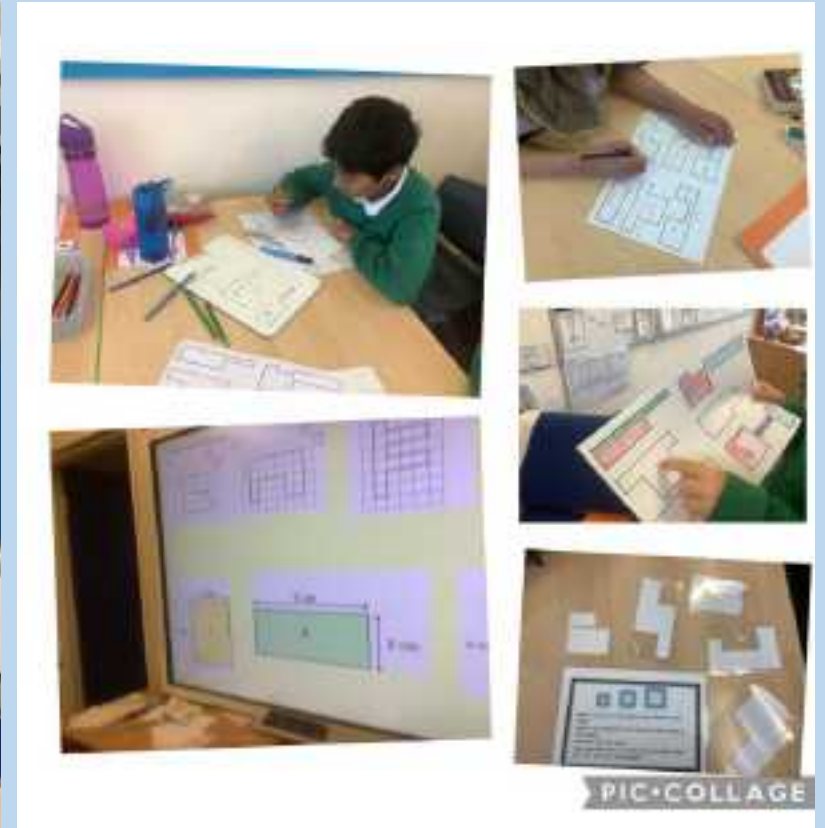
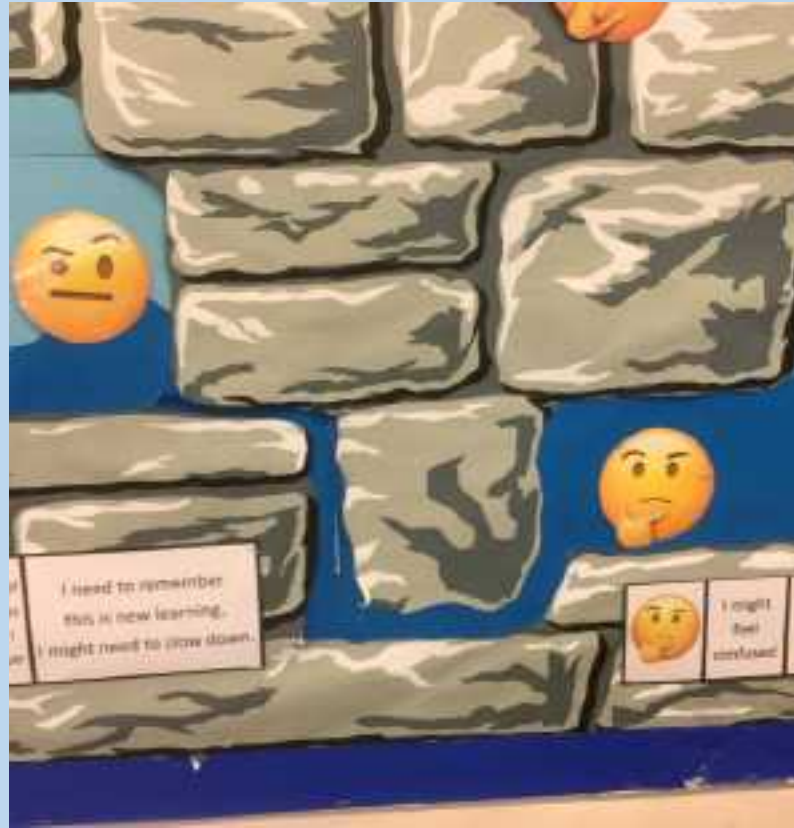

Noticing skills are being worked hard!

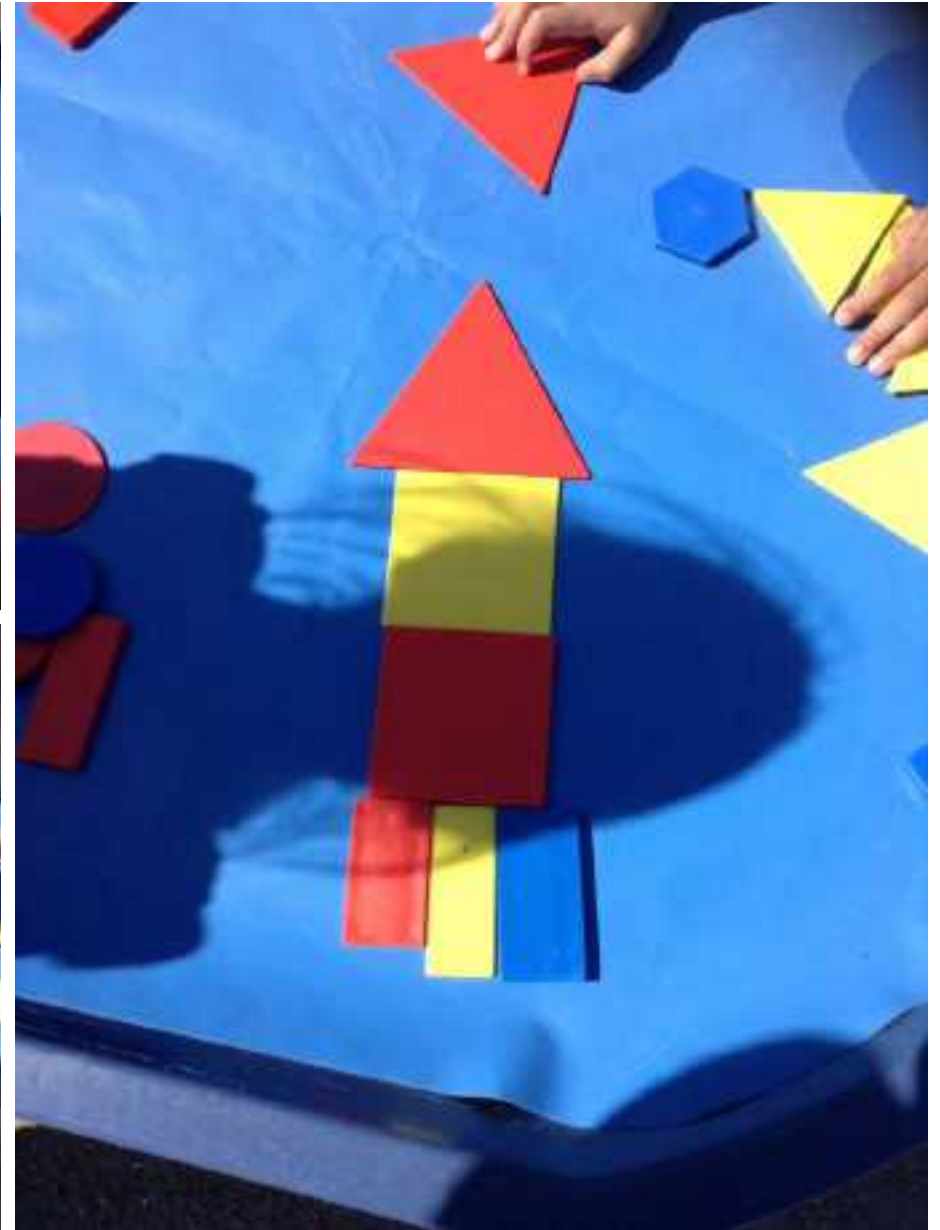


Year 5 have been 'swimming back to something they know' so they can solve new challenges when calculating area
