Great fun exploring water, flow and gravity in Year One. We are loving our new outdoor area.





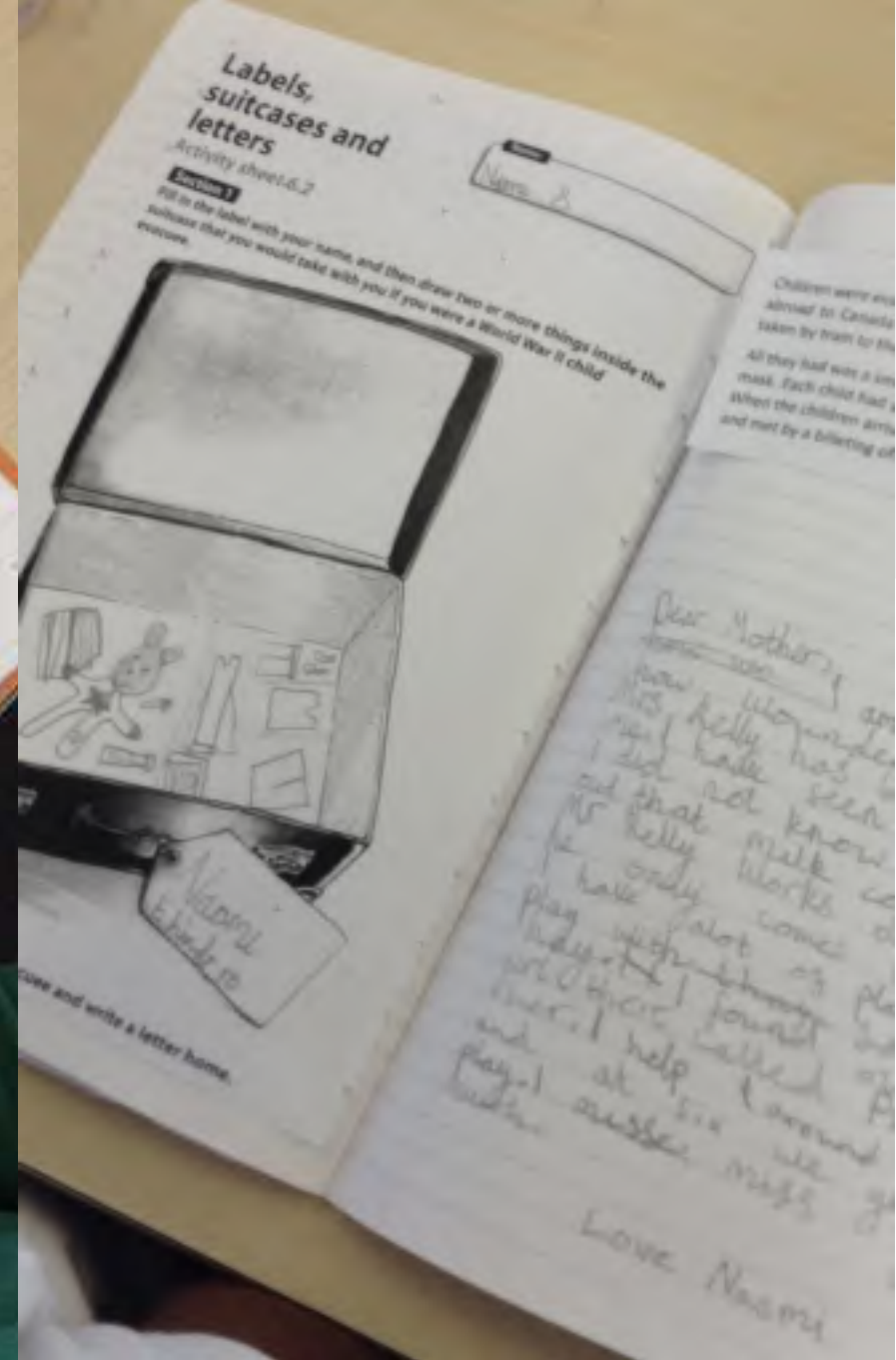
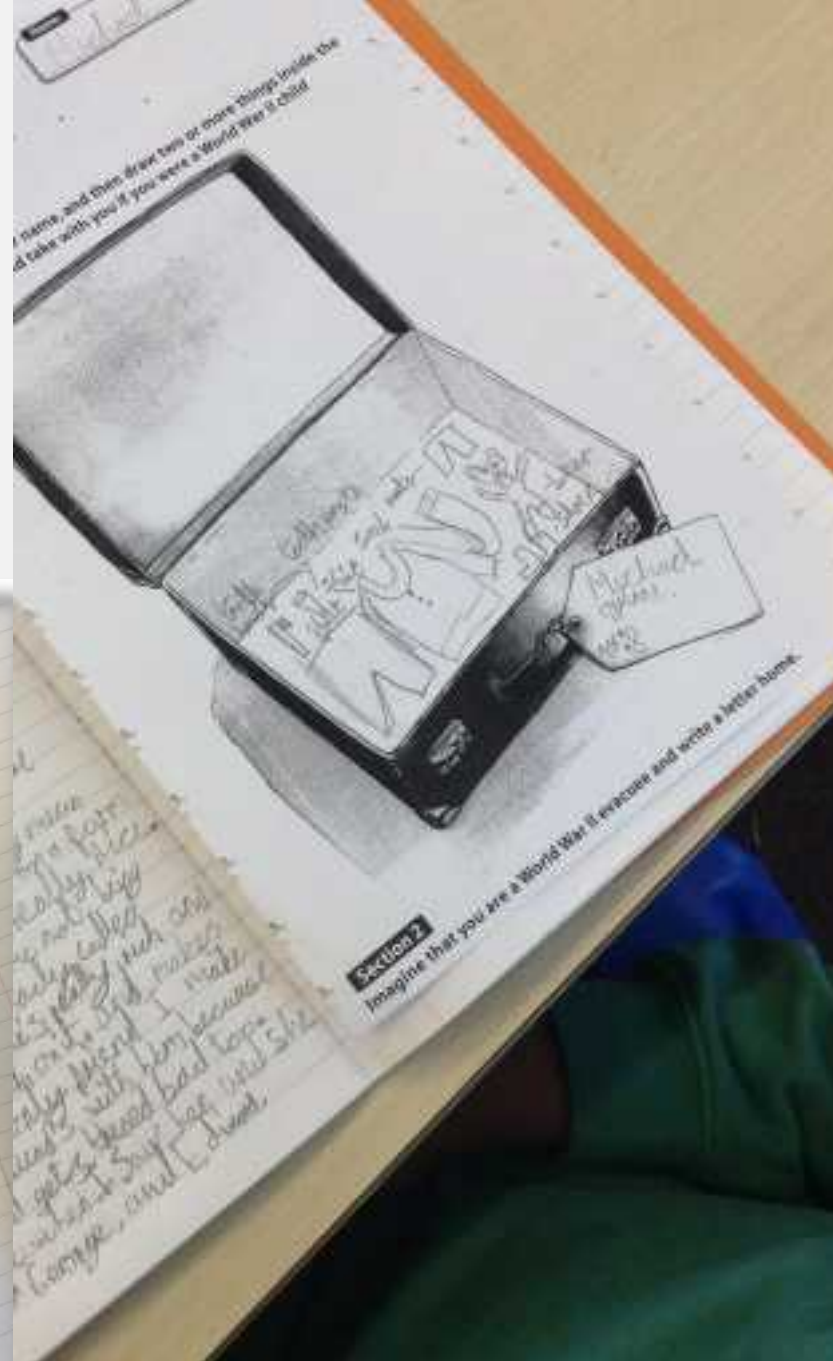
In History, the children in Year 3 imagined they were evacuees during World War 2 and wrote a letter home.

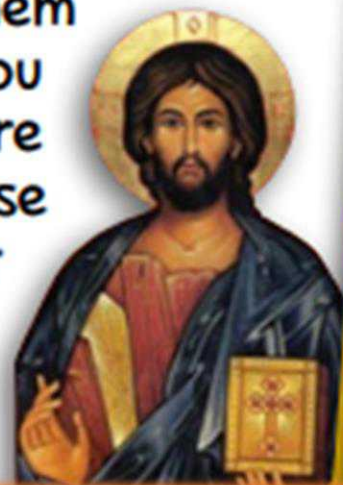
