


Year 3 have been looking at bones in the human body.

Year 4 pupils have been exploring proportion in Art. They have used rubbers and charcoal to draw a staged scene.






















## Wednesday Wellie Walk



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We looked at work from Zaria Forman and listened to Debussy. Have a lovely weekend everyone!


