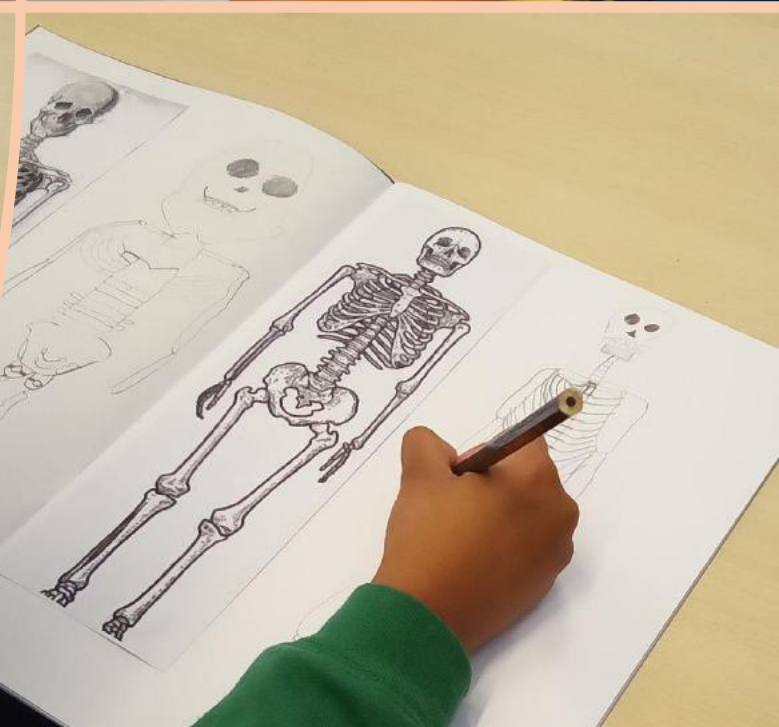
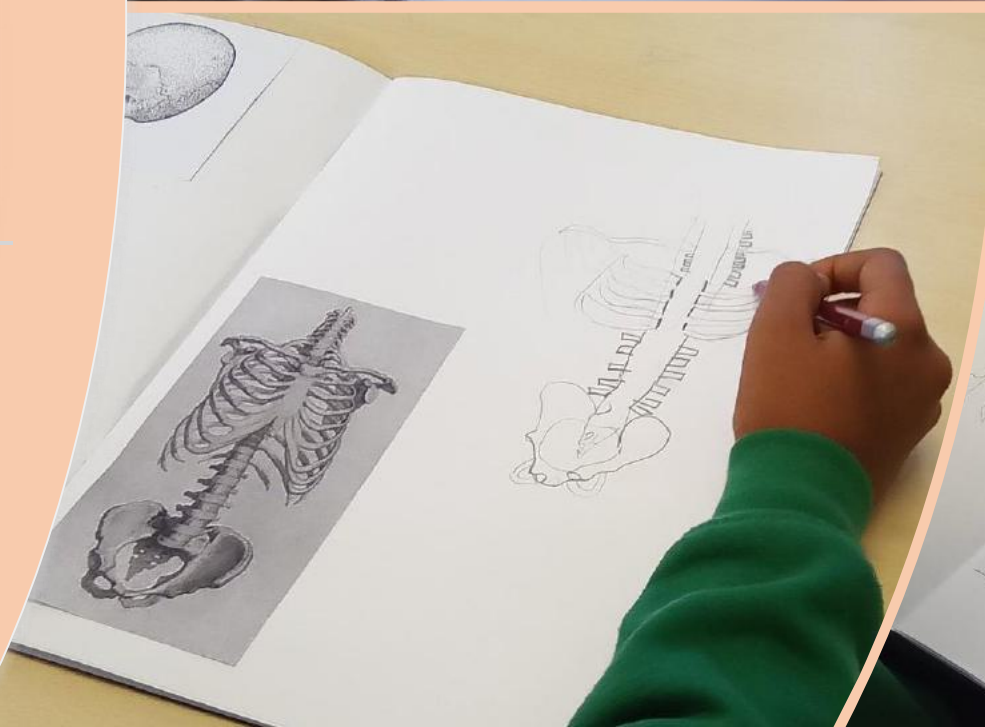
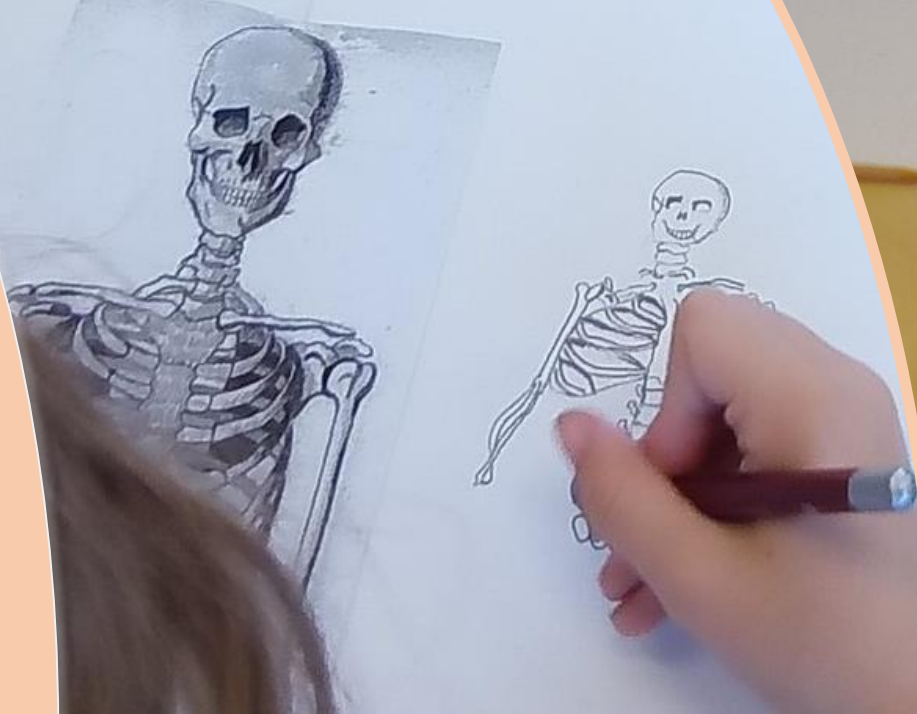
In English Year 1 continued to explore our text about Rapunzel.

This week we have been thinking about witches and spells. We even went out collecting ingredients to add to our potions, ***"Hubble, bubble toil and trouble"***

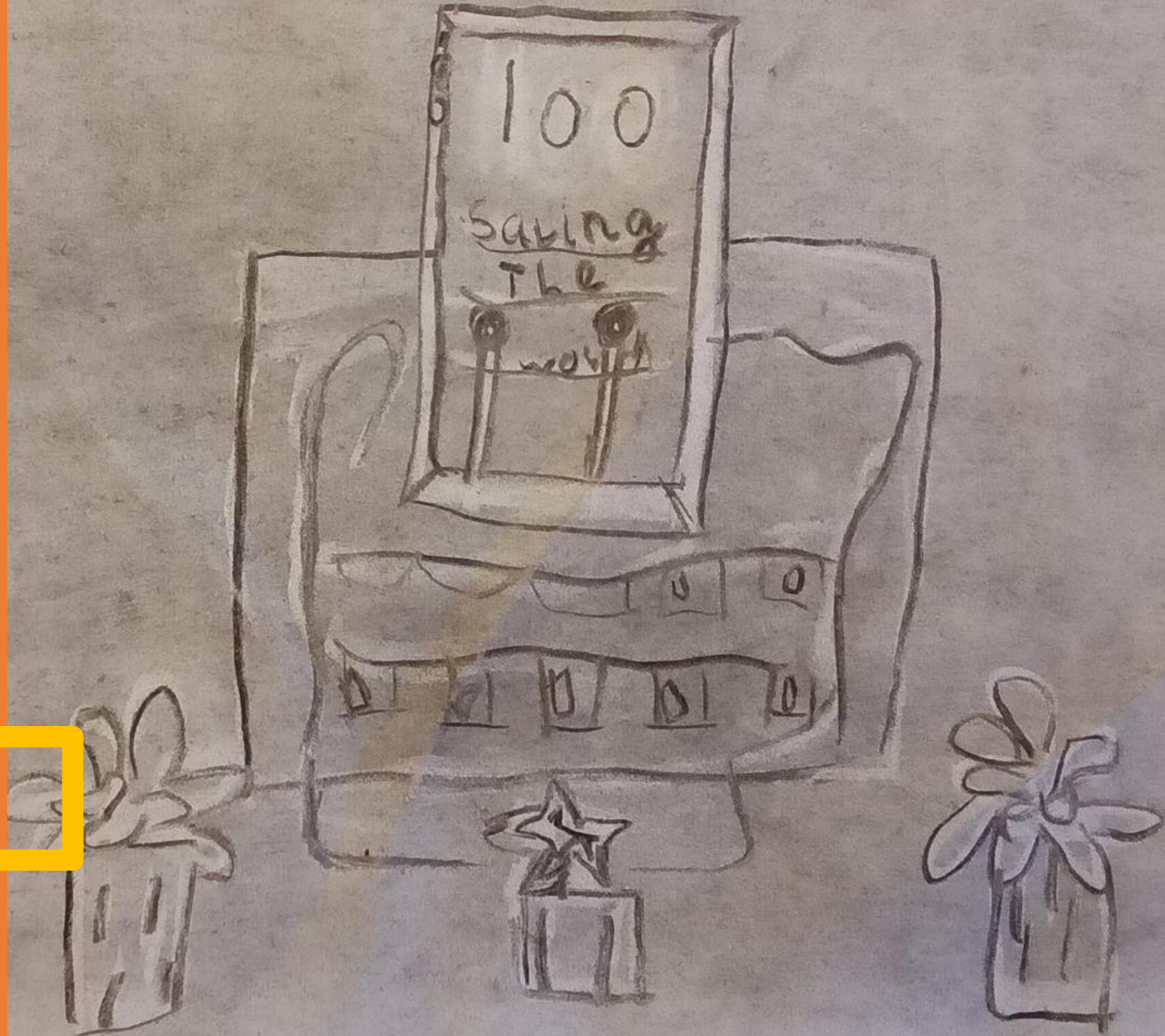

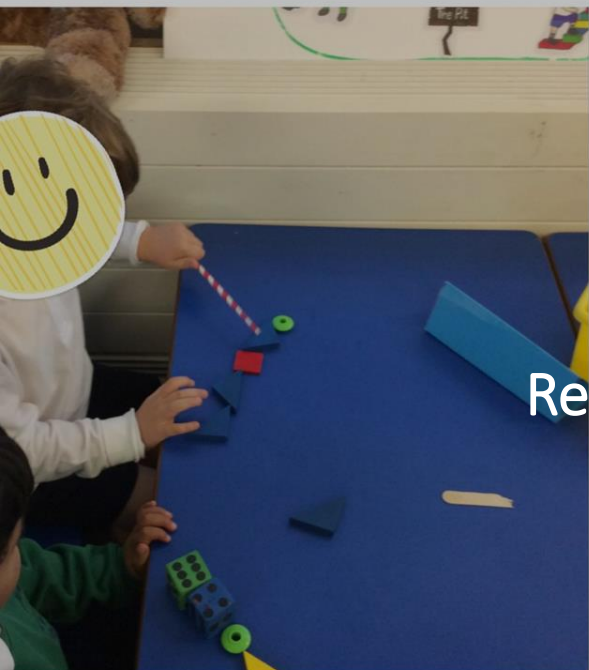
Year 4 pupils have

a staged scene.



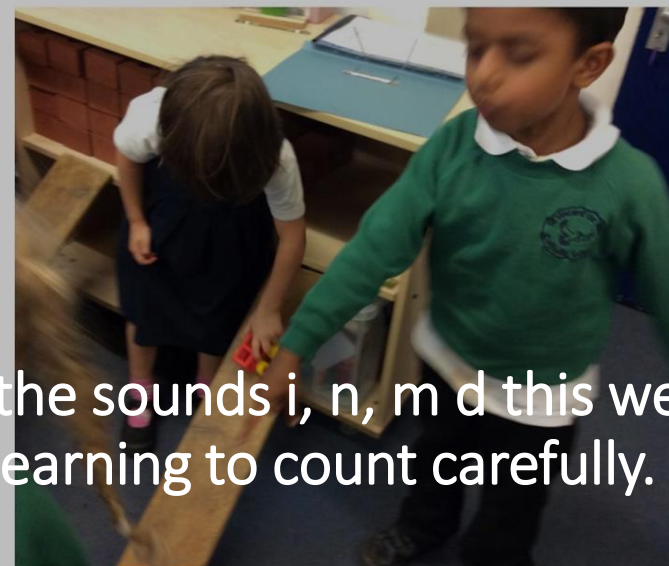

The children have been inspired by Jabari from our story and have made some vehicles using Mobilo, testing them using ramps.

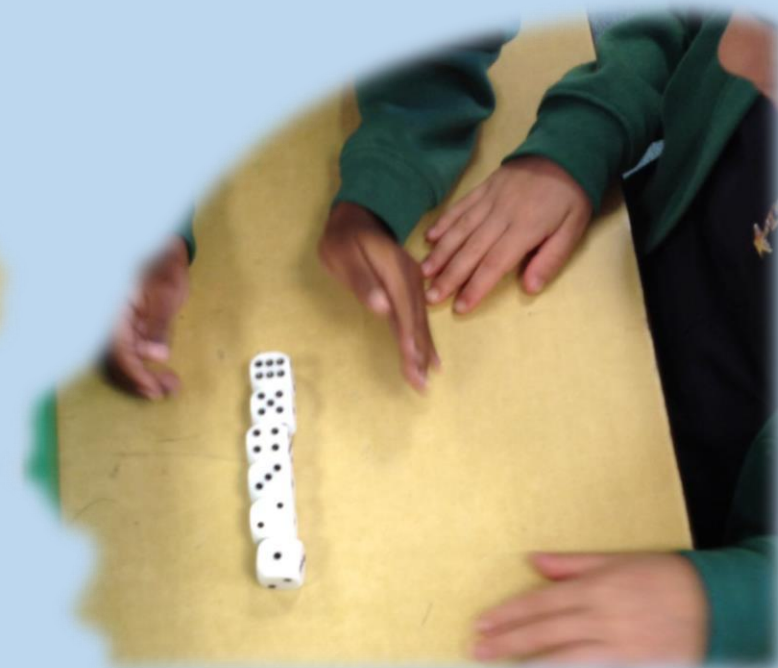
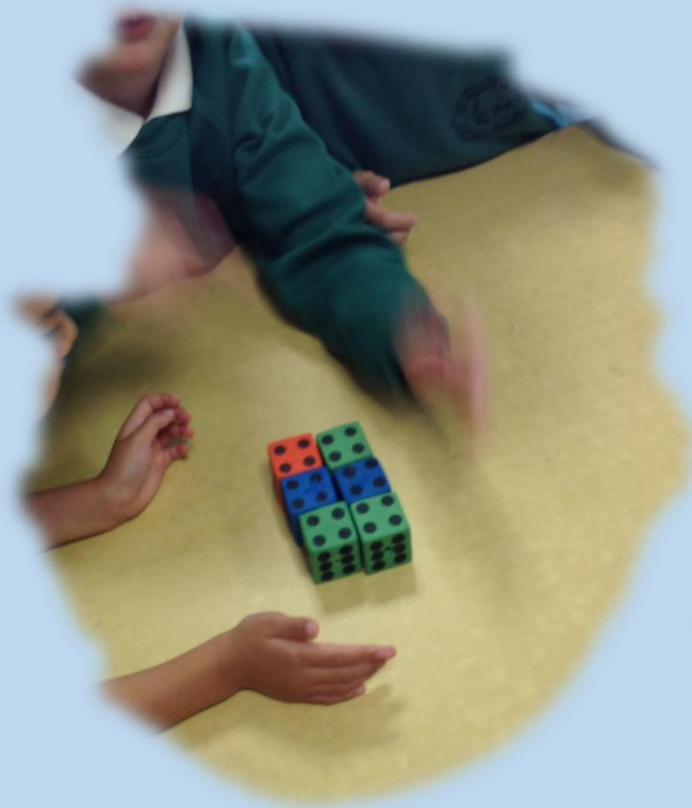
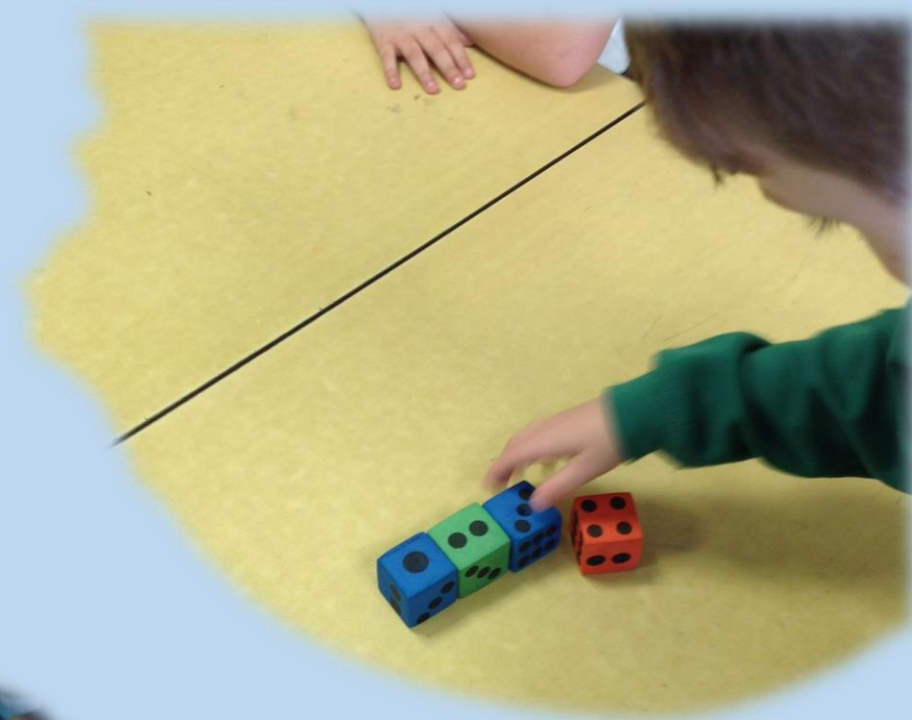
