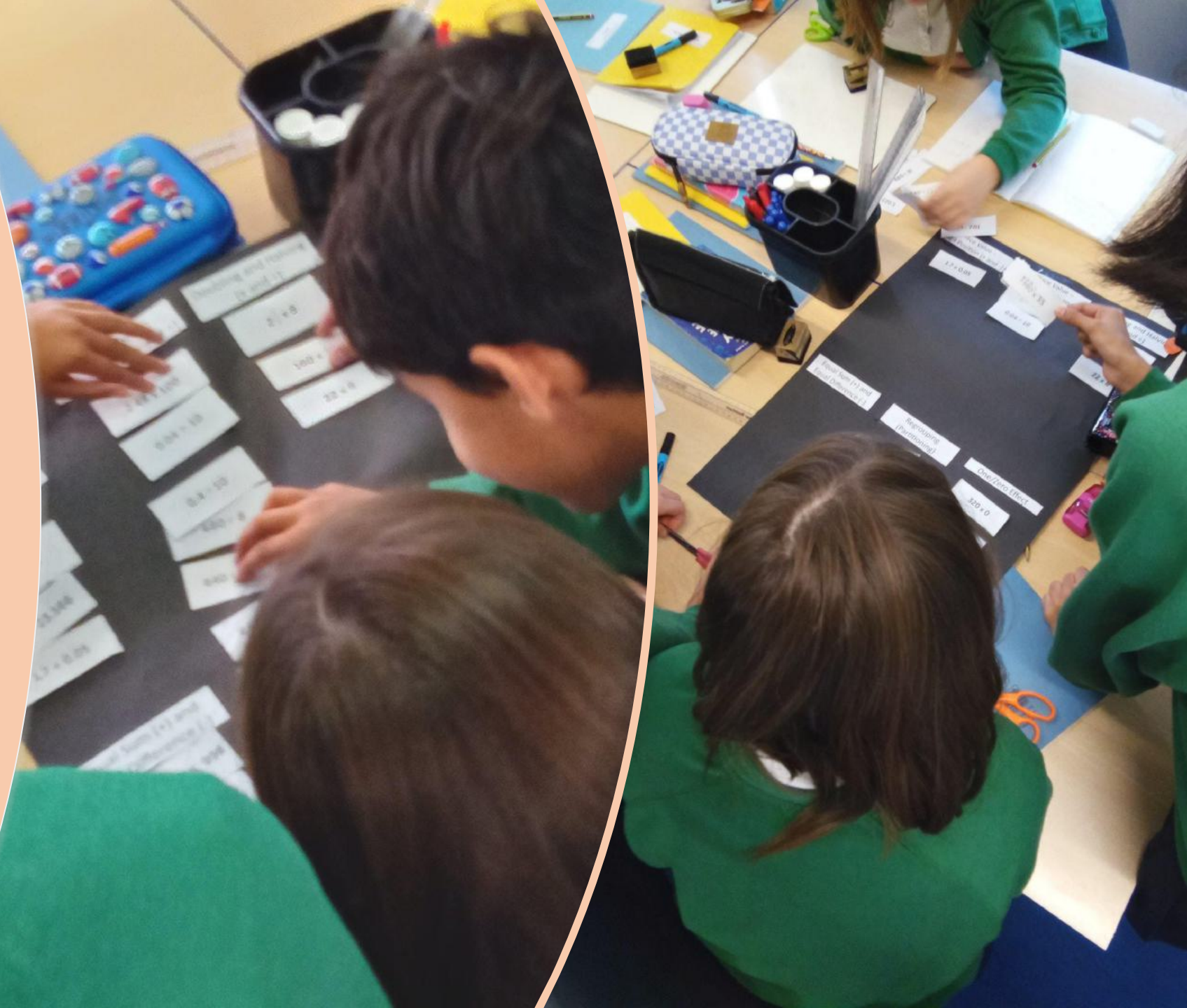

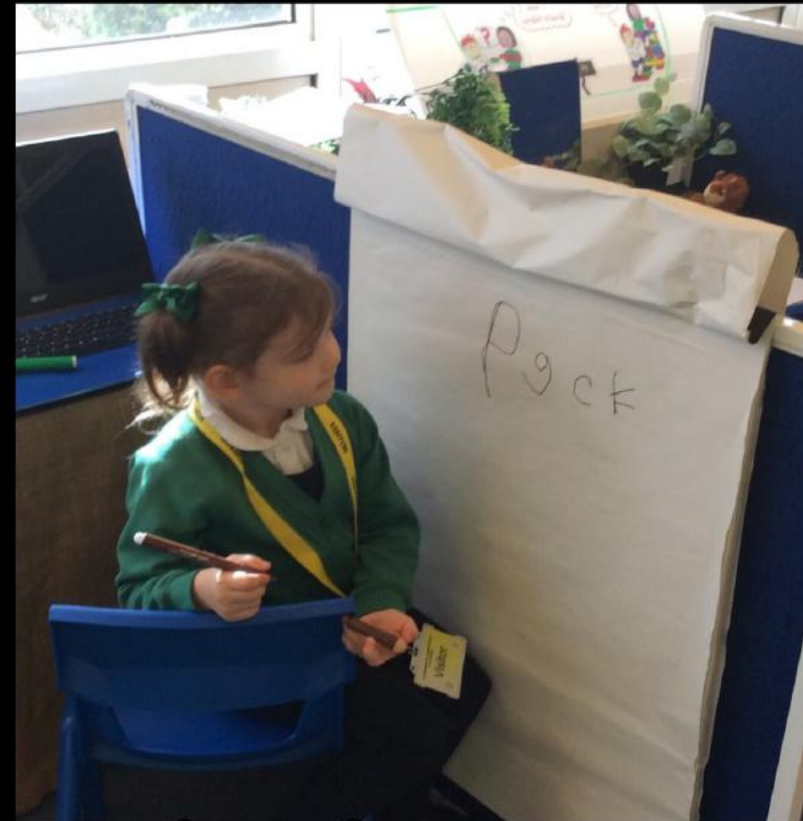

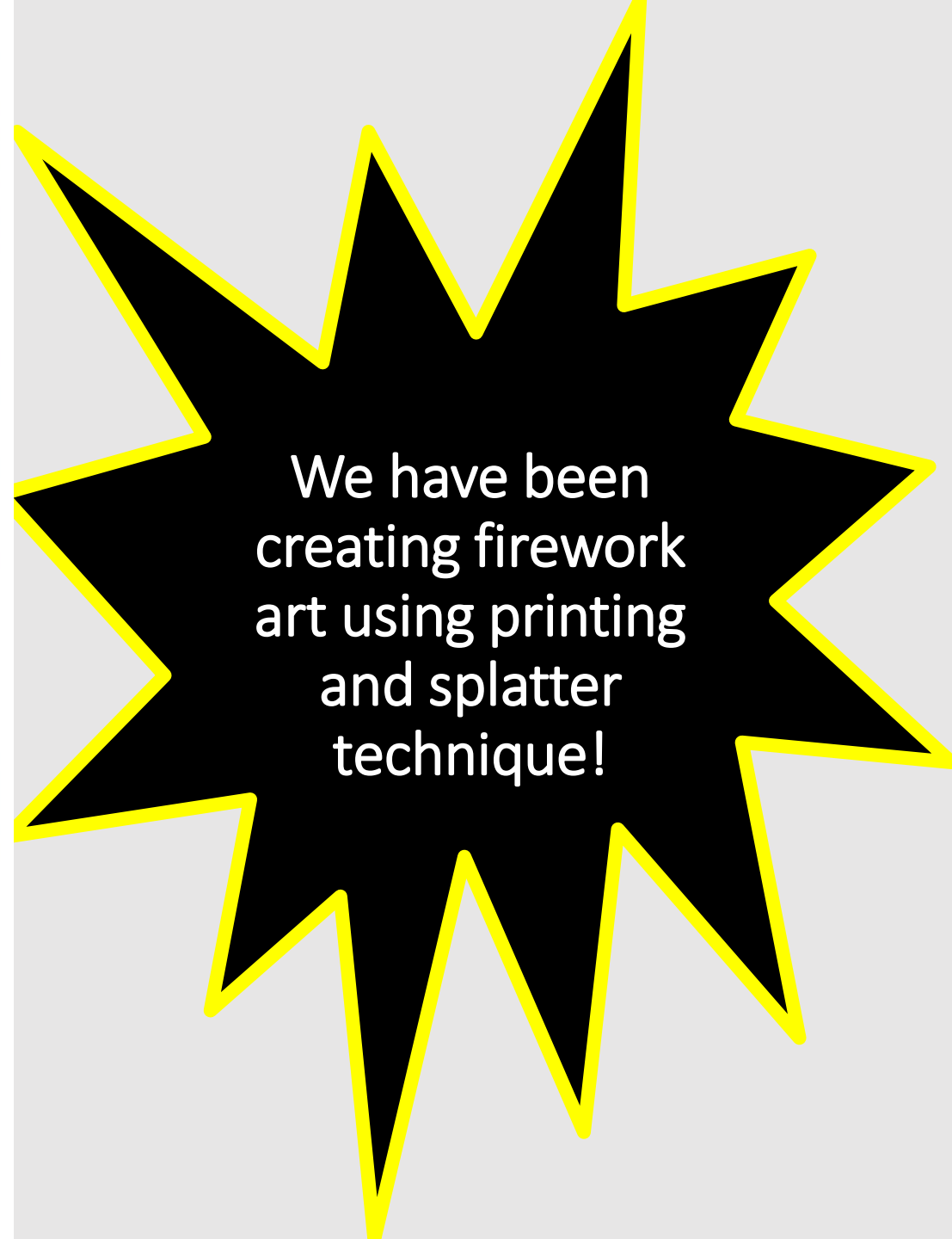




Year 1 have been busy practising their ball and control skills in the hall.

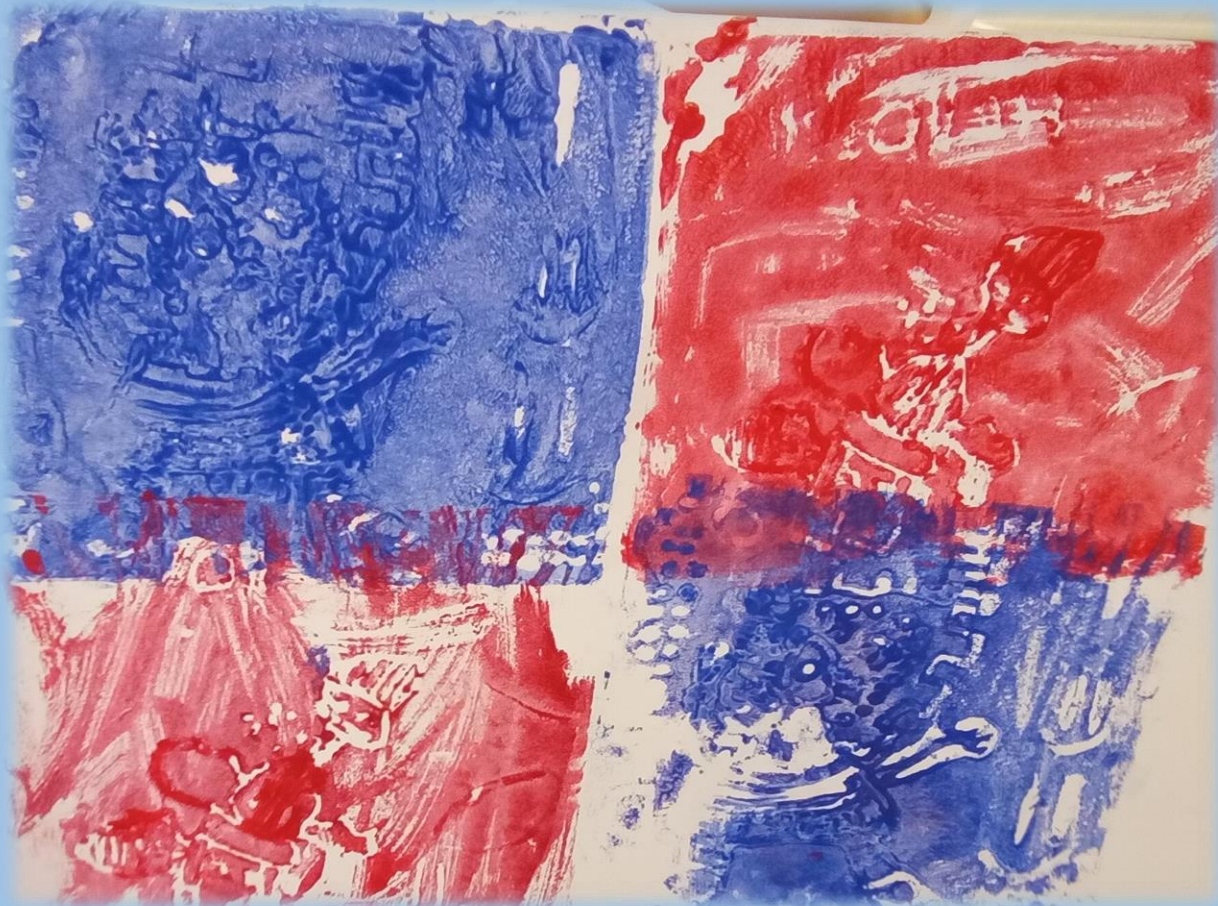

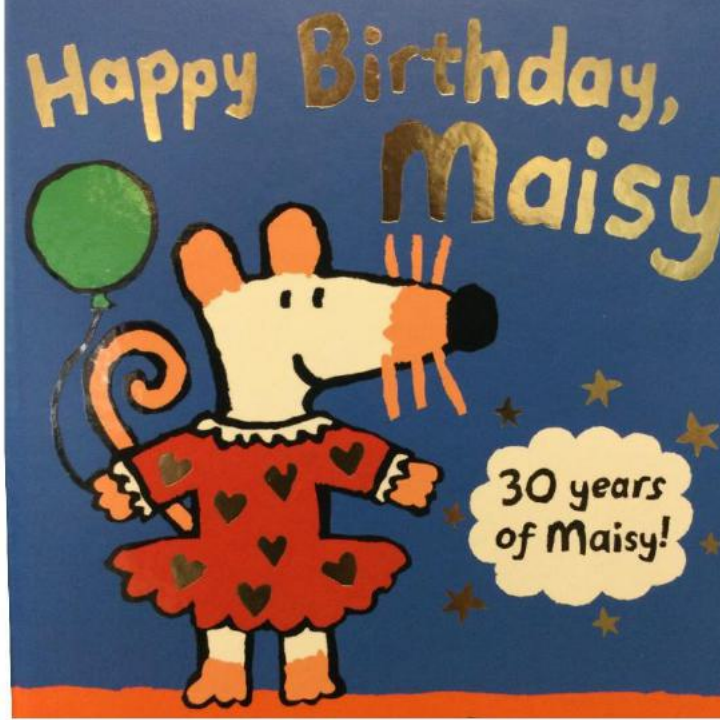
This week Year One have enjoyed starting our new text, with some super sentences. How lovely to see these girls checking out the English wall the next day!

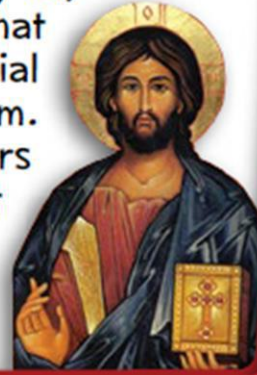

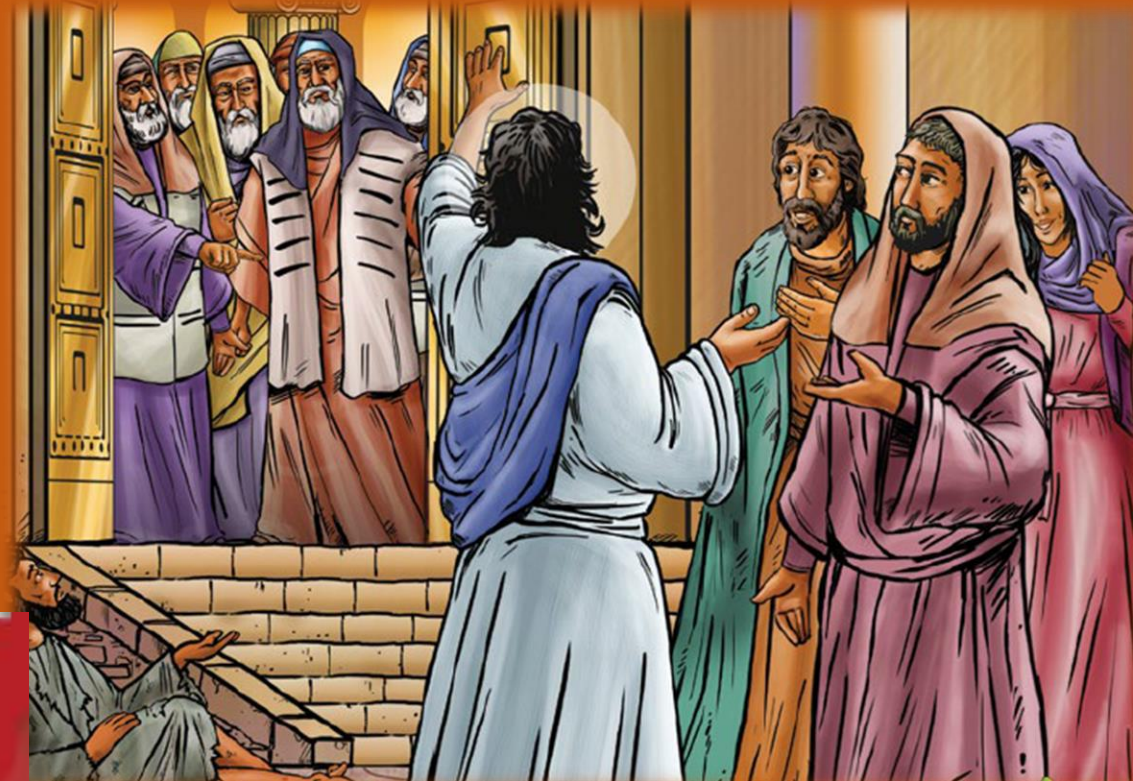
