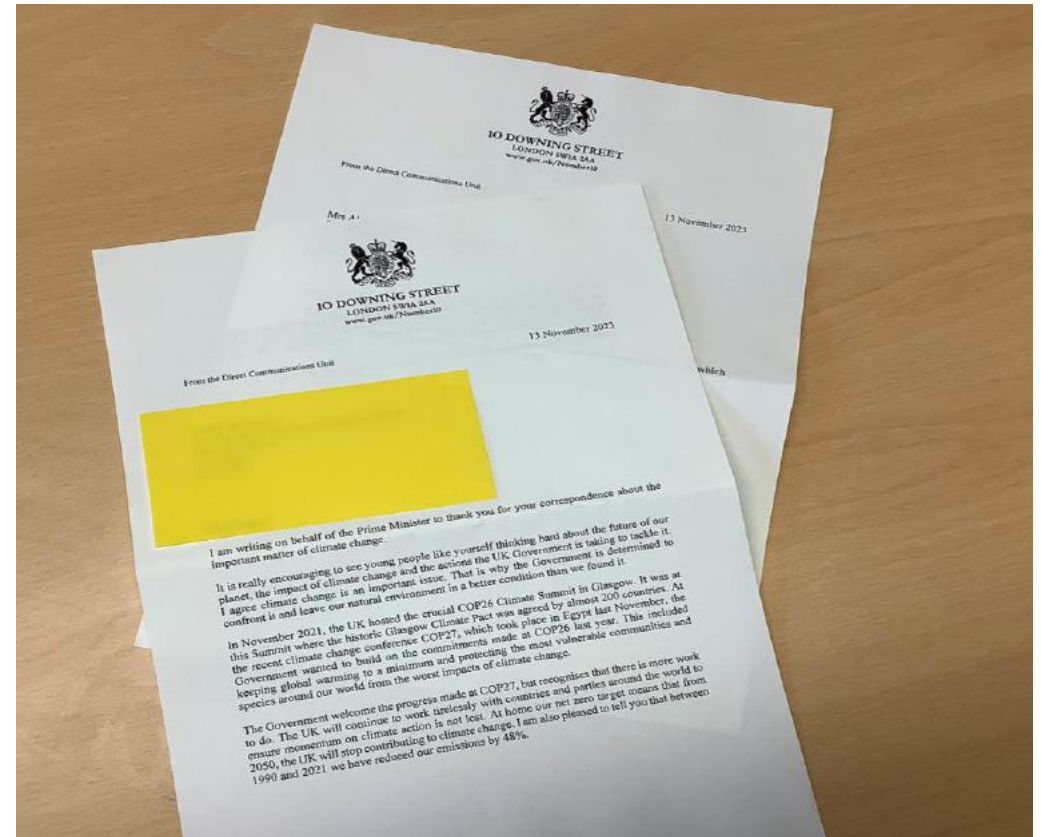
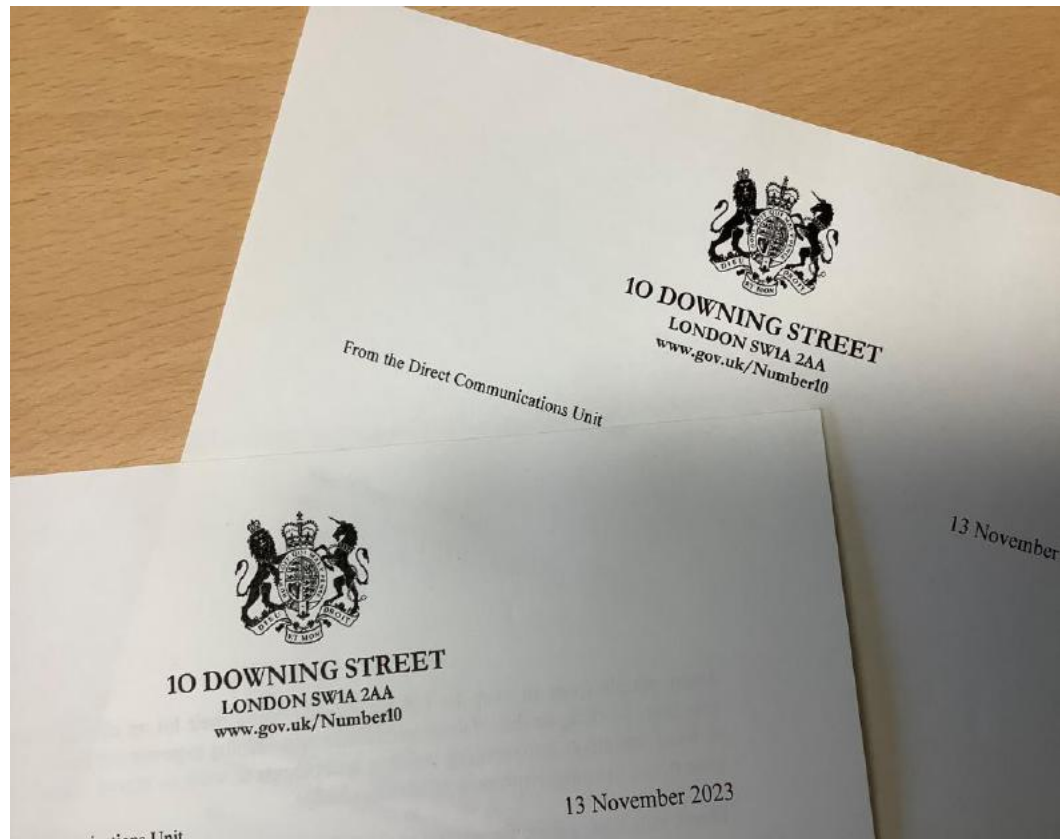

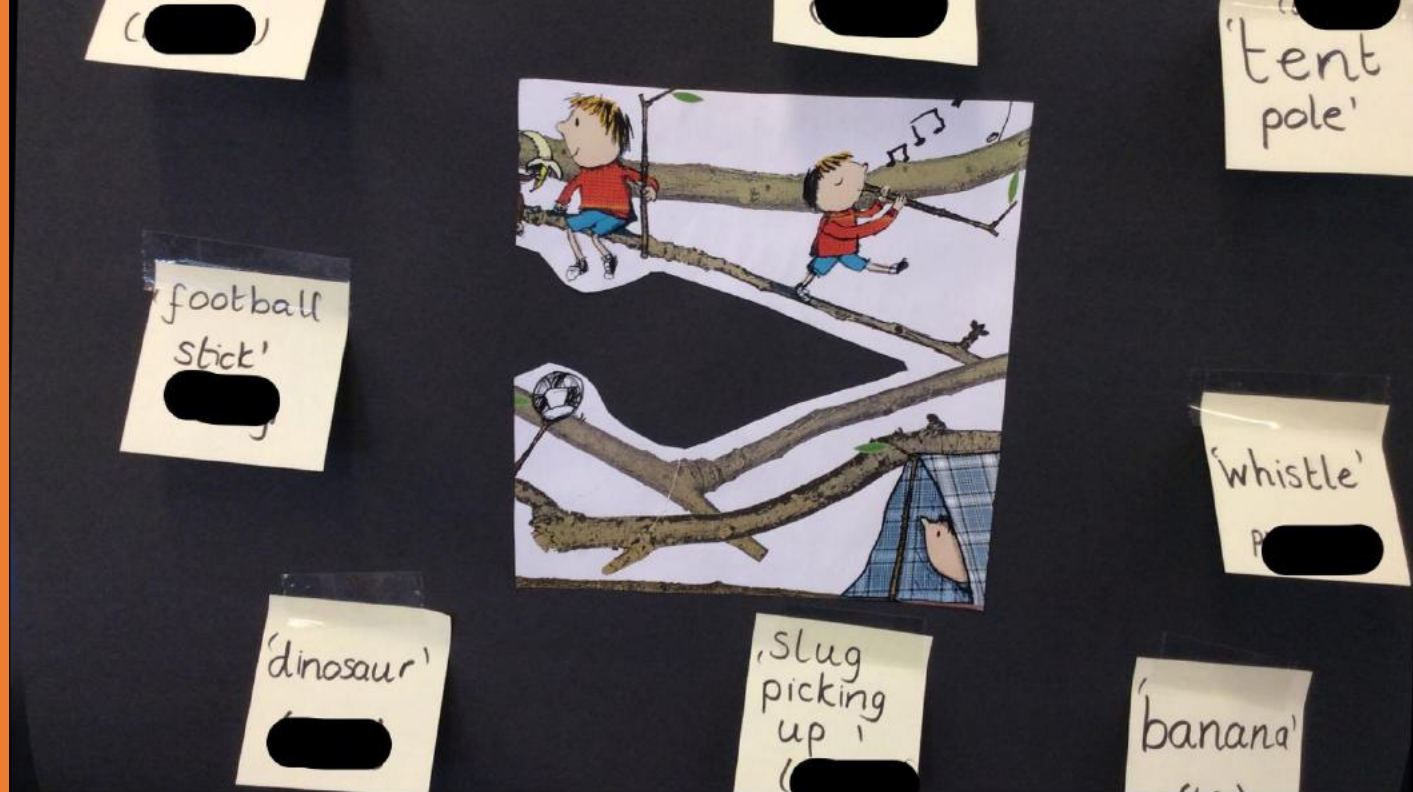
One of our Y4 children wrote a heartfelt letter to Rishi Sunak about climate change in his English lesson. We decided to send it and on Monday he received a reply.

They could remember lots of details and were ready to share with the class.

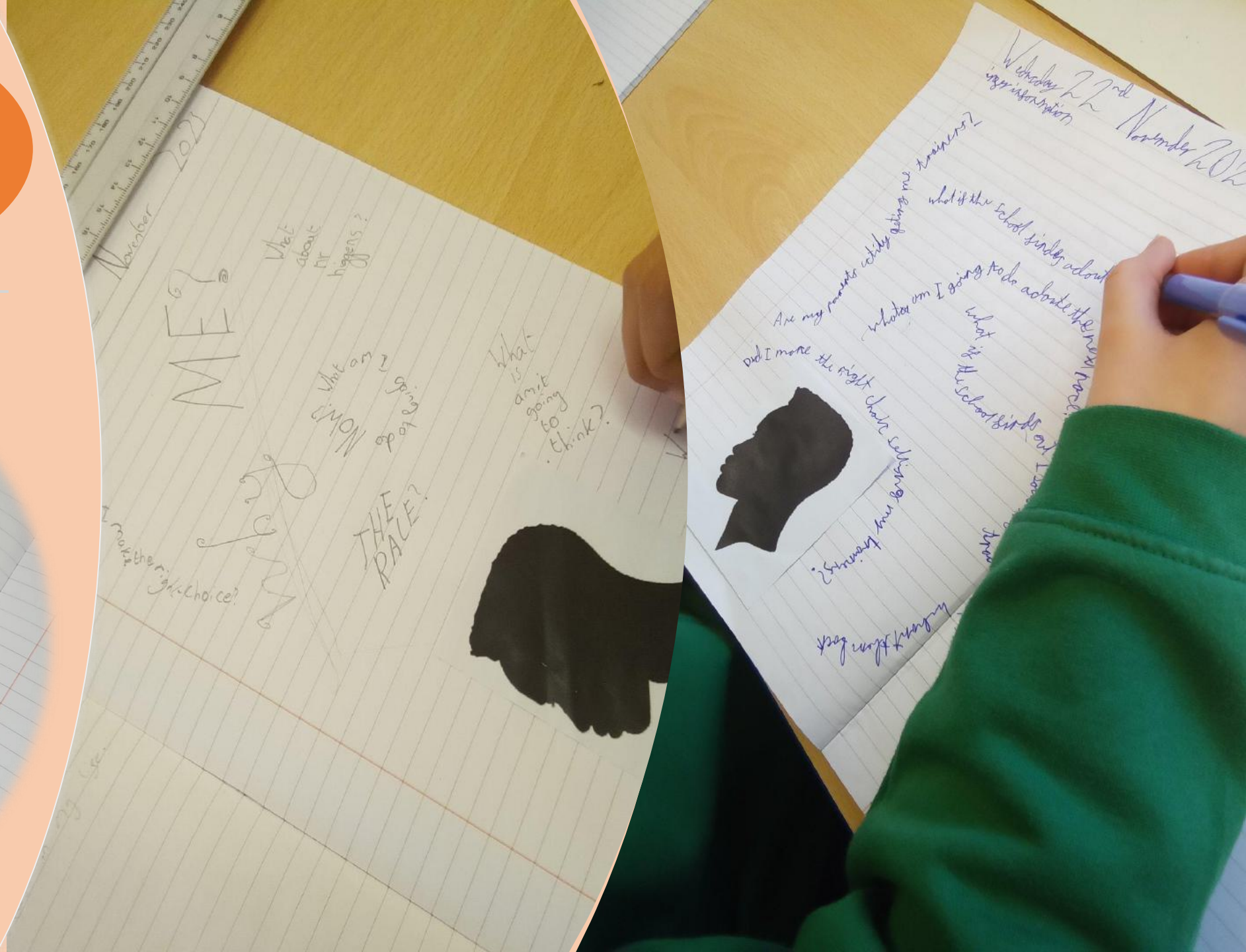
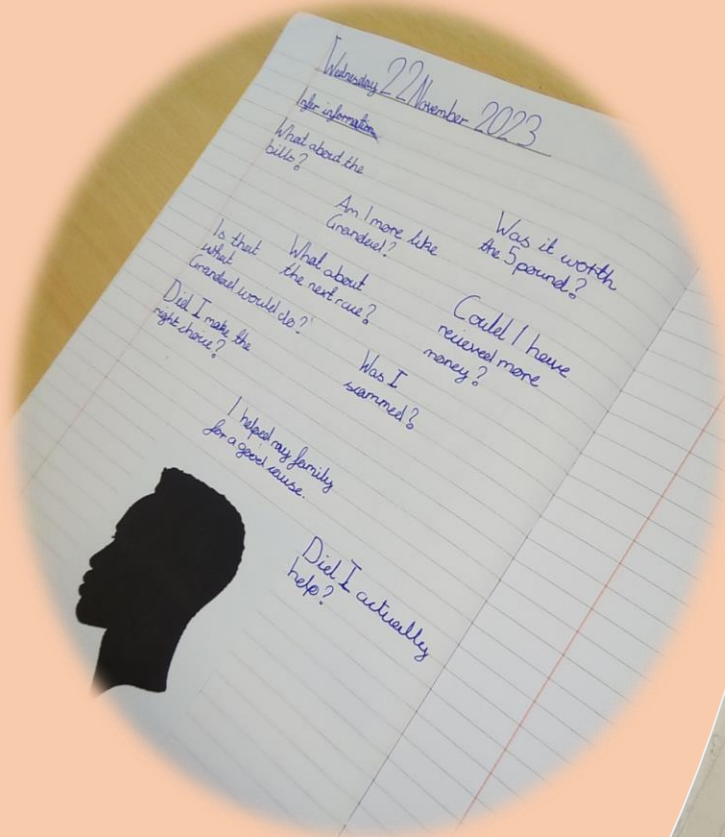

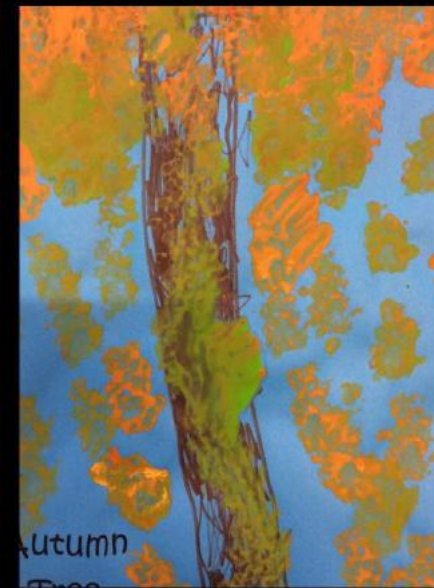


Year 6 exploring the thoughts of the main character, AJ, in our class text, 'Running on Empty'.

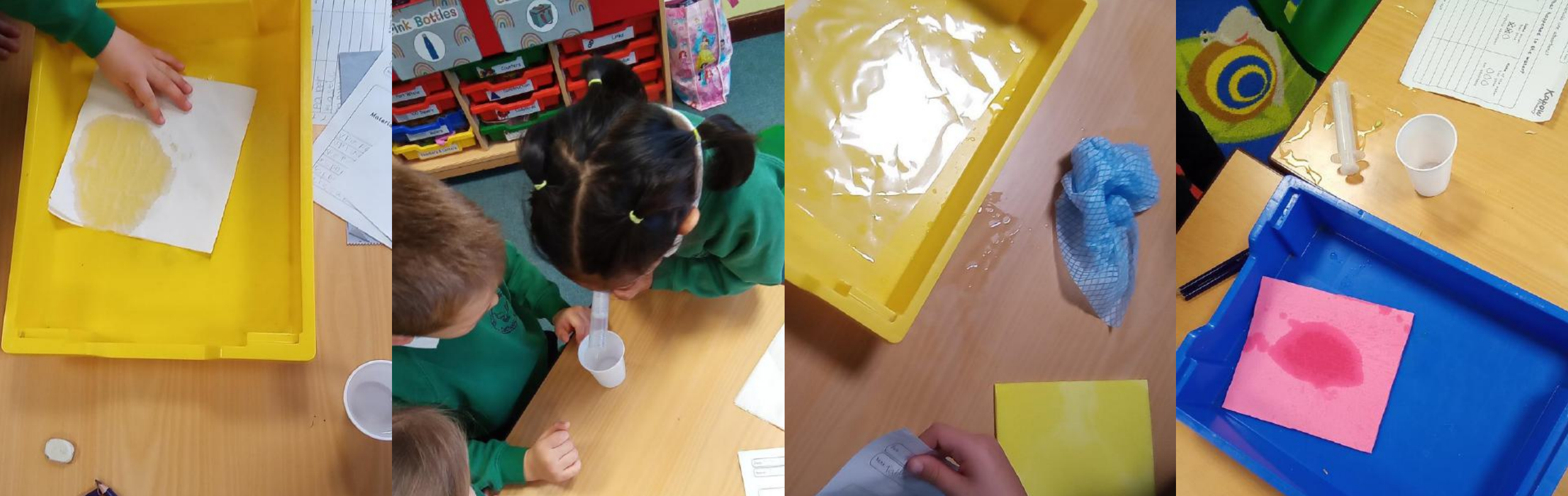

Observing the properties of materials to see how well they absorb water.



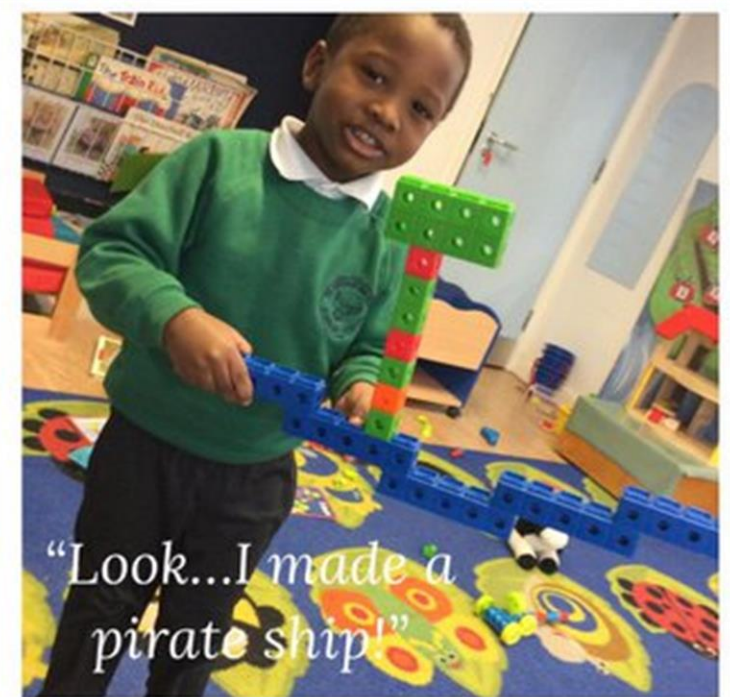
