
The feast of Christ the King 26th November 2023

They could remember lots of details and were ready to share with the class.


















Reception were excited to explore the outside area and thought about how to rescue the animals from the ice, using sticks to trace letters in the sand.

Year 6 exploring the thoughts of the main character, AJ, in our class text, 'Running on Empty'.






The children in Reception drew and printed autumn trees this week.




In preparation for our soup making next week, the Reception children have been learning how to chop safely. They rolled out their play-doh and cut it into lots of pieces.

We started Wednesday with a wonderful assembly about our theme of the week, **Kindness**.








Mrs Whitty revealed the new play equipment in assembly to the whole school. Big thanks to the PSA for all their hard work!








Children in Year 4 used counters to add in 25's






