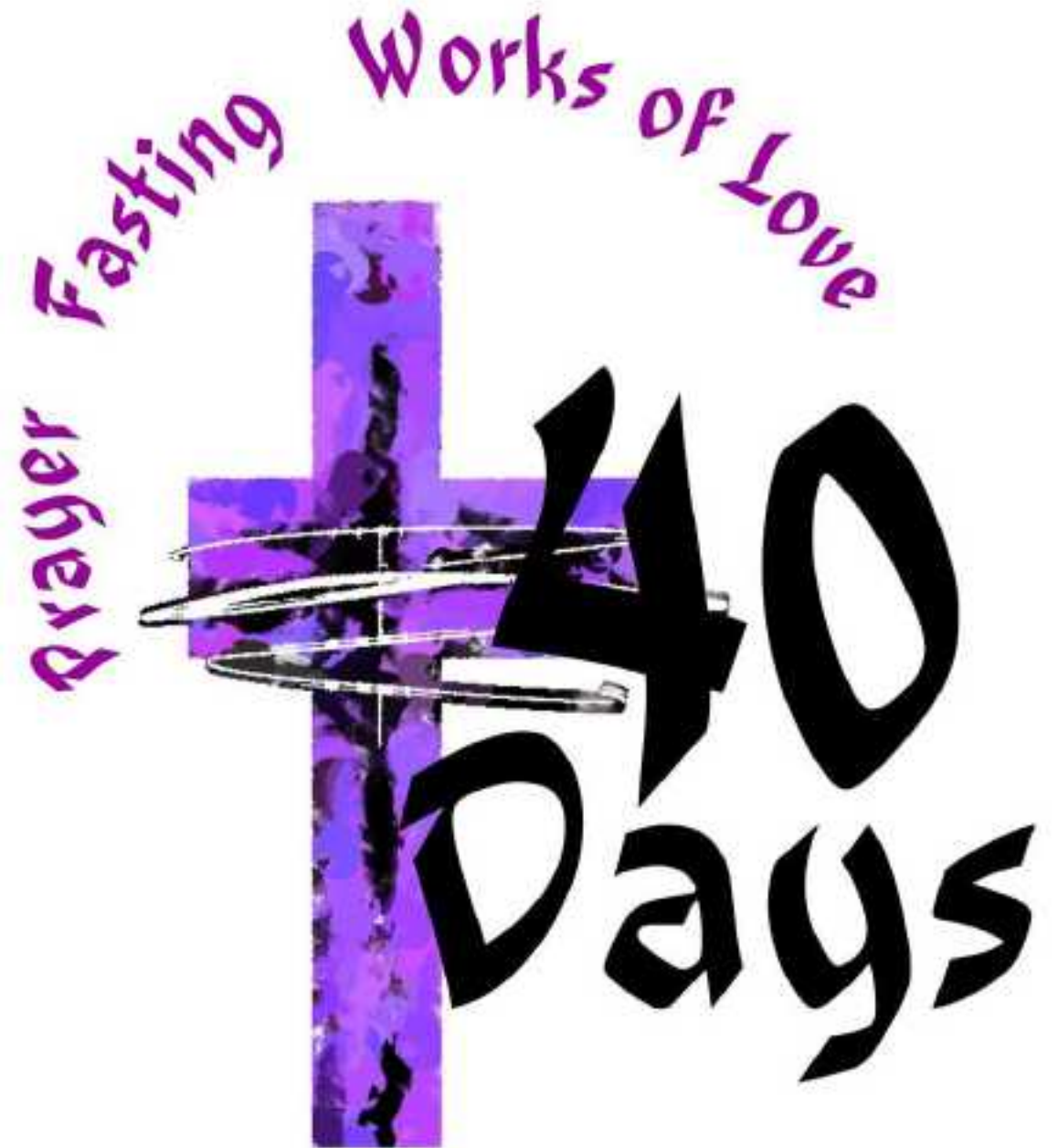

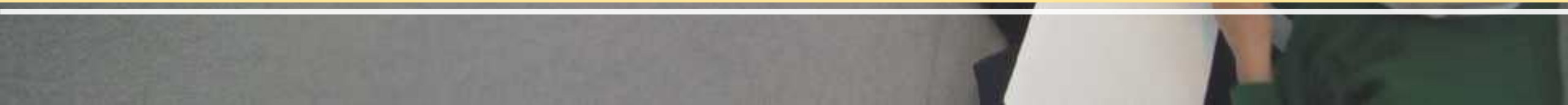
Many thanks to Fr Nigel for welcoming our Reception children into church on Monday. We all had a lovely time looking around the church and learning about different religious signs and symbols.

Year 1 enjoyed some quiet reflection time after receiving their Lenten ashes.

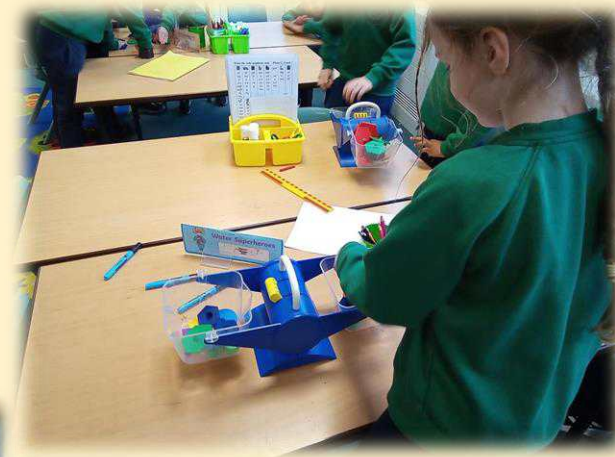

Year 2 investigating mass, using mathematical language and comparing mass using balances.



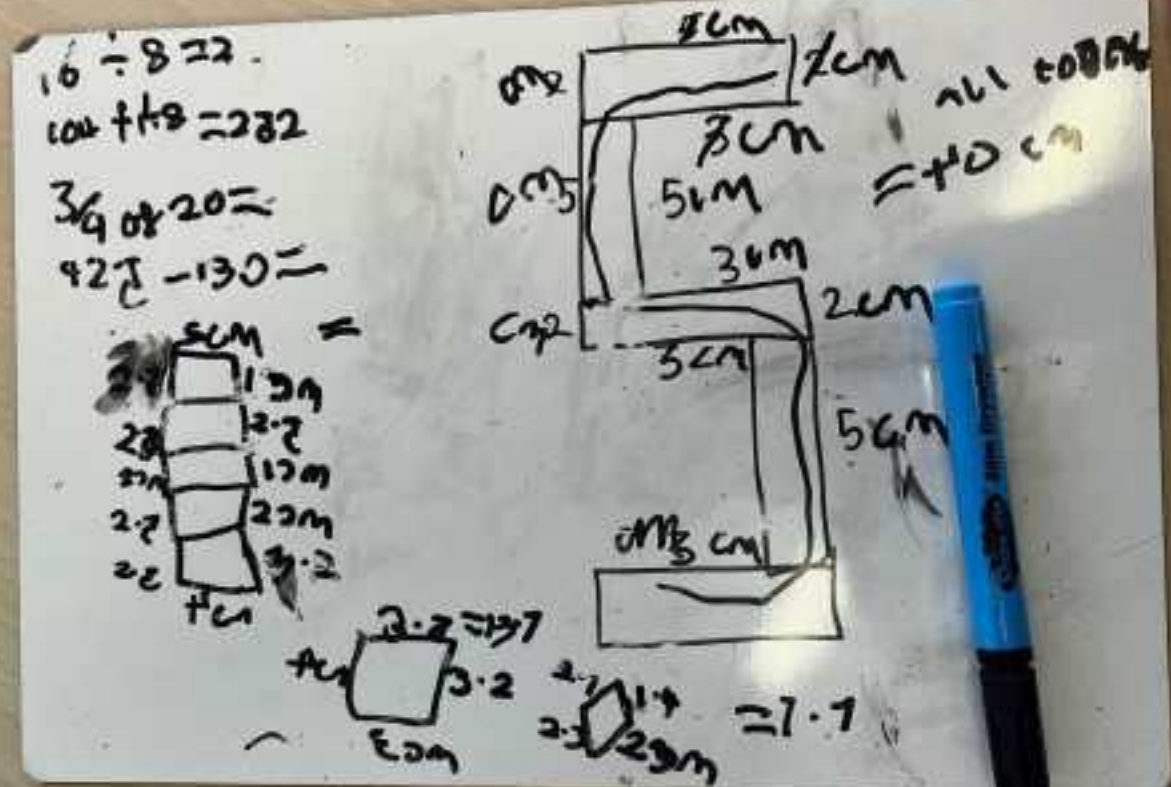
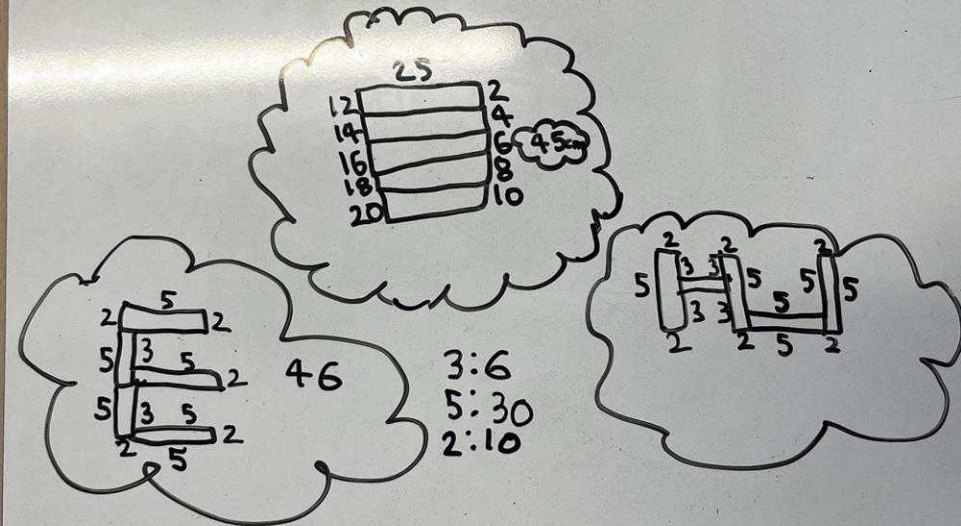

We had to rearrange 5 congruent rectangles to get different perimeters.

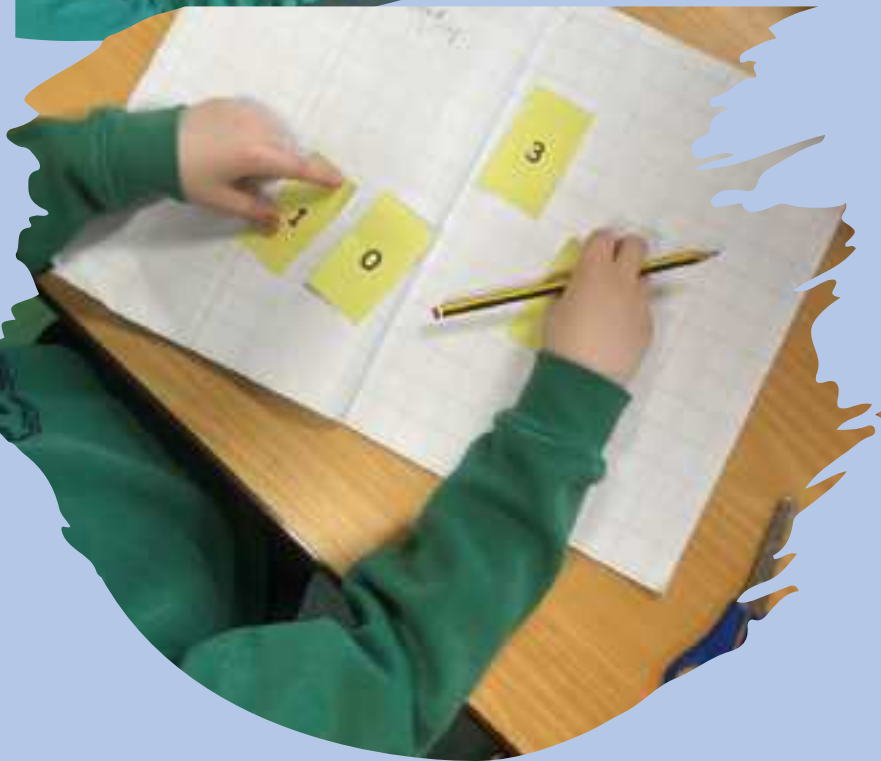


one side is 10, 50 because both sides are equal and that's 10 + 5 + 5 = 30

CPR and the recovery position.

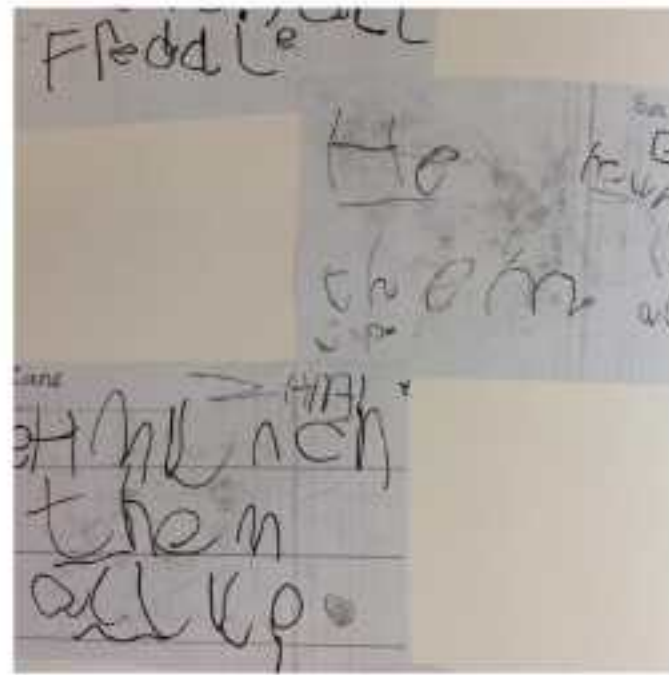
They all did a fantastic job.
