

Board games club was good fun after school.








Lots of opportunities to compete with friends and learn new games.












Year 4TB is making great progress in their Maths fluency sessions!

They played with some old toys and developed their collaborative skills.




























The children in Reception enjoyed exploring their new garden centre role play and started to think about their new topic













Puzzle Play in the Nursery class - lots of perseverance. "We completed it!"



"Dear young people, may you always live the faith with enthusiasm."




