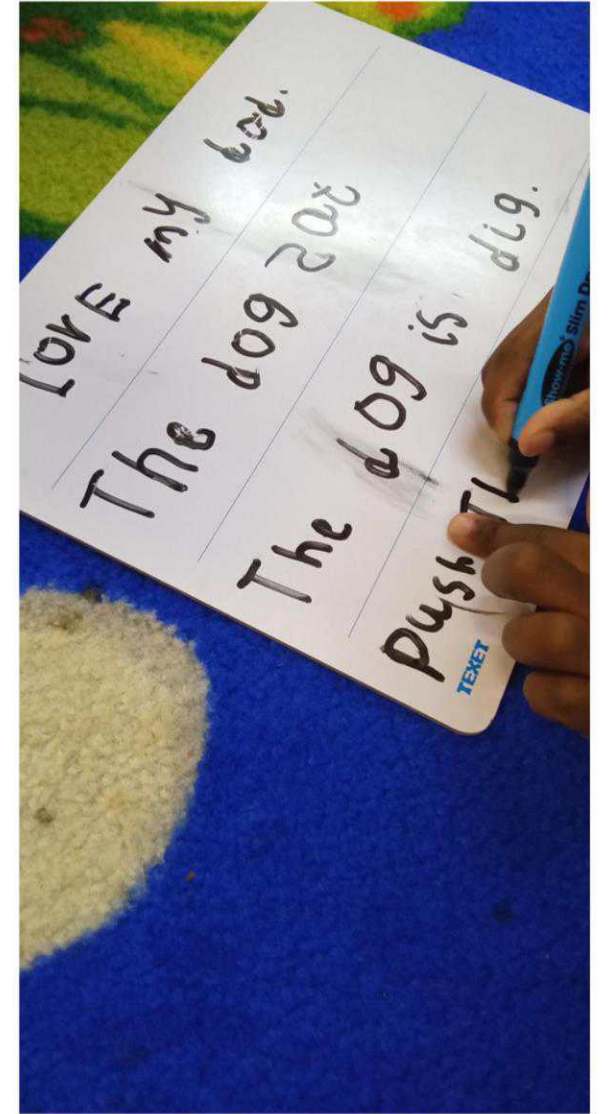
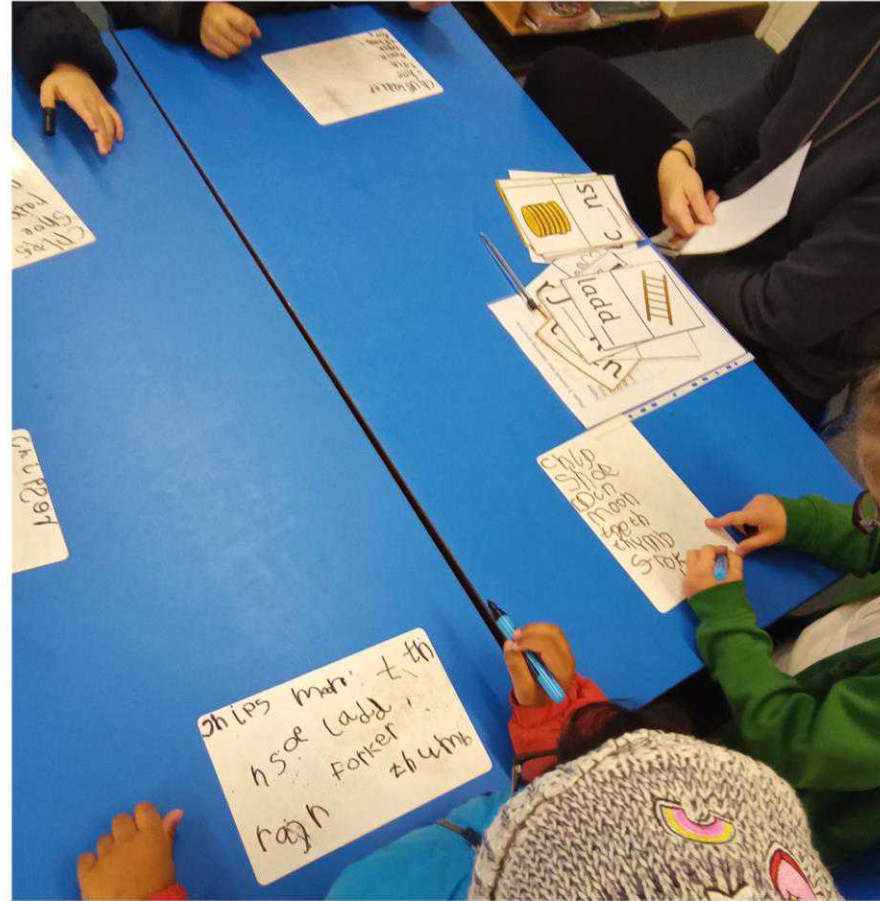

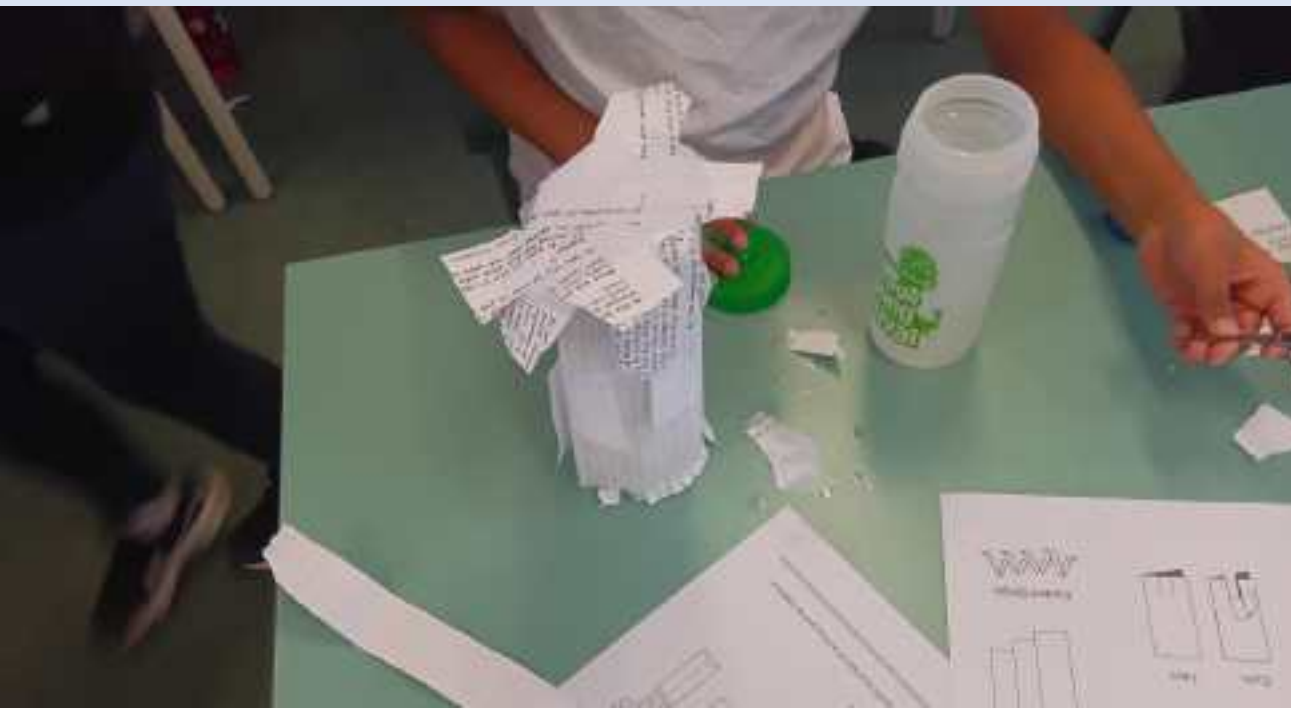
What a great way to celebrate **SCIENCE WEEK**. The children in Reception loved seeing all these exciting experiments during their assembly.



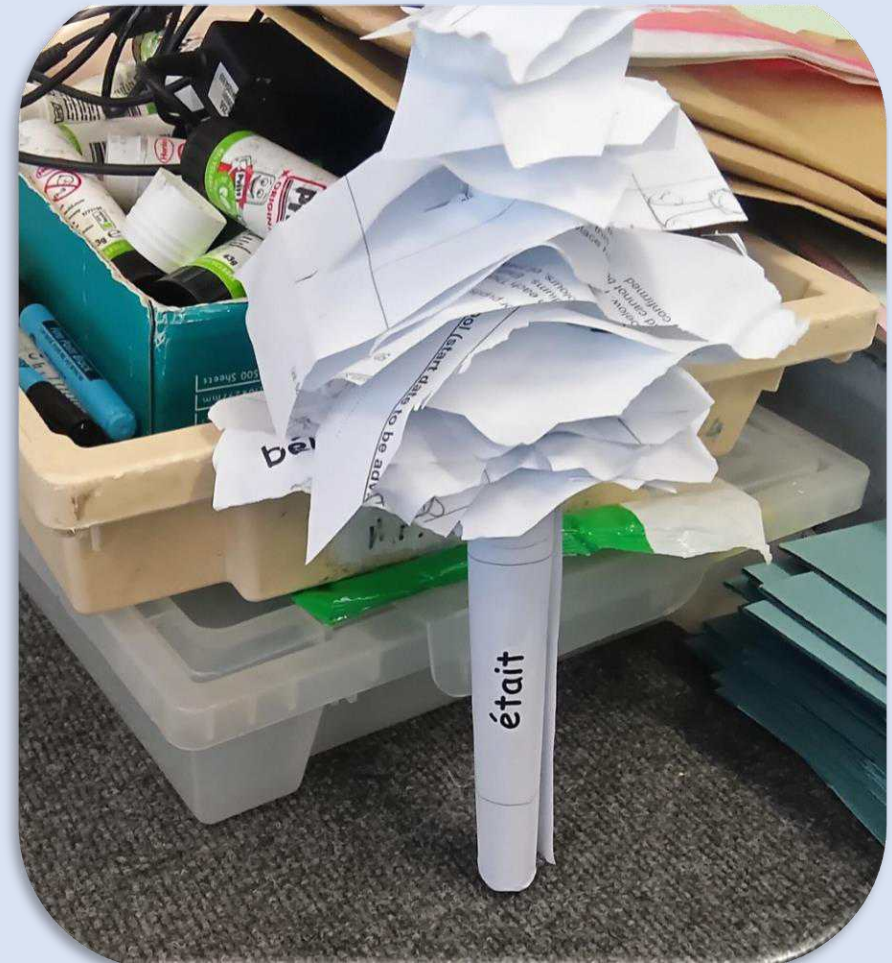
The Year 2 trip to Shuttleworth was a great way to consolidate learning and learn even more facts about the history of flight.

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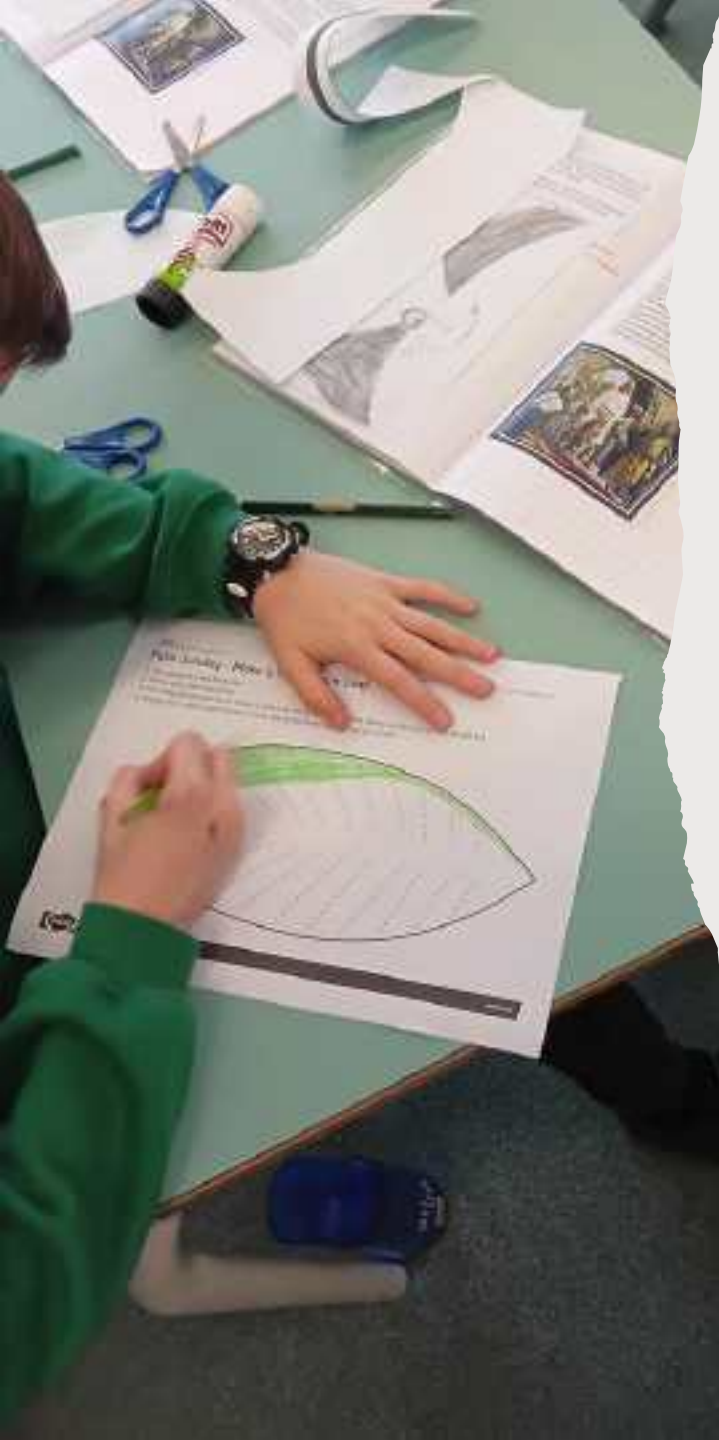
The Reception children have been doing some amazing writing linked to RE.

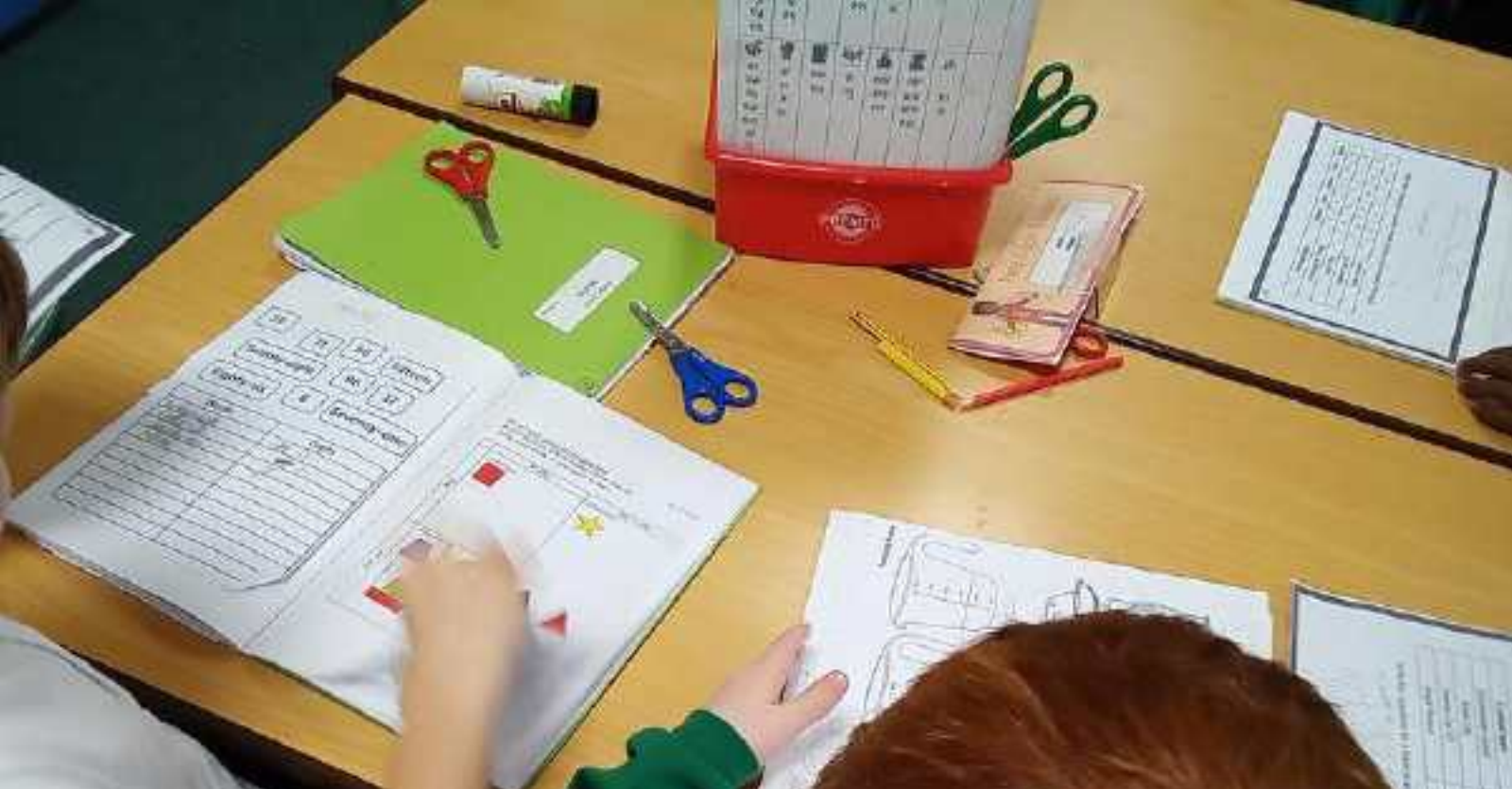

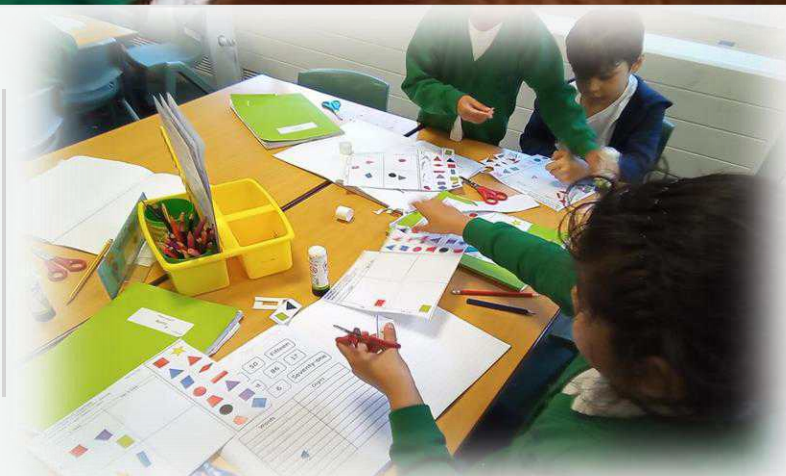

As part of our Science week Year 1 have taken on the challenge of making a tree using only 4 pieces of recycling paper and no glue! They have all done well!

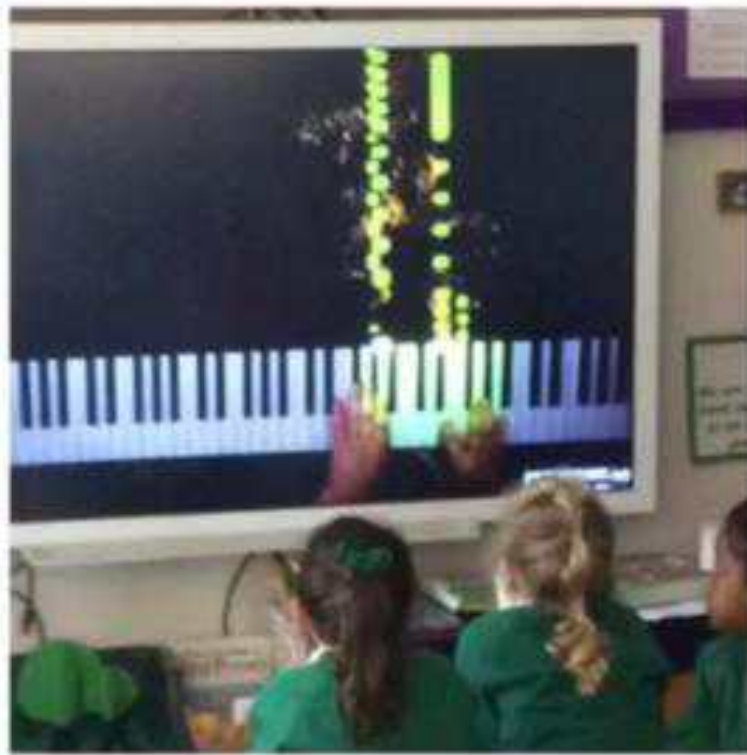






Year 3 took on the Science Week Challenge too.

A **Word** from  
**Pope Francis**

"Lent is a journey during which the Lord asks us to follow three steps: almsgiving, prayer, and fasting."



Jesus said, "Now the hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. I tell you, most solemnly, unless a wheat grain falls on the ground and dies, it remains only a single grain; but if it dies, it yields a rich harvest.

Anyone who loves their life loses it; anyone who hates their life in this world will keep it for the eternal life. Whoever serves me, must follow me; wherever I am, my servant will be there too. If anyone serves me, my Father will honour them. And when I am lifted up from the earth, I shall draw all people to myself." By these words he indicated the kind of death he would die.
