





Reception and Year One had a great time.














What a great way to celebrate SCIENCE WEEK. The children in Reception loved seeing all these exciting experiments during their assembly.

Year 4 made trees for the paper engineering challenge without using glues etc.













SCIENCE IN THE OUTDOORS.




The children in Nursery class are preparing their potatoes for planting.


