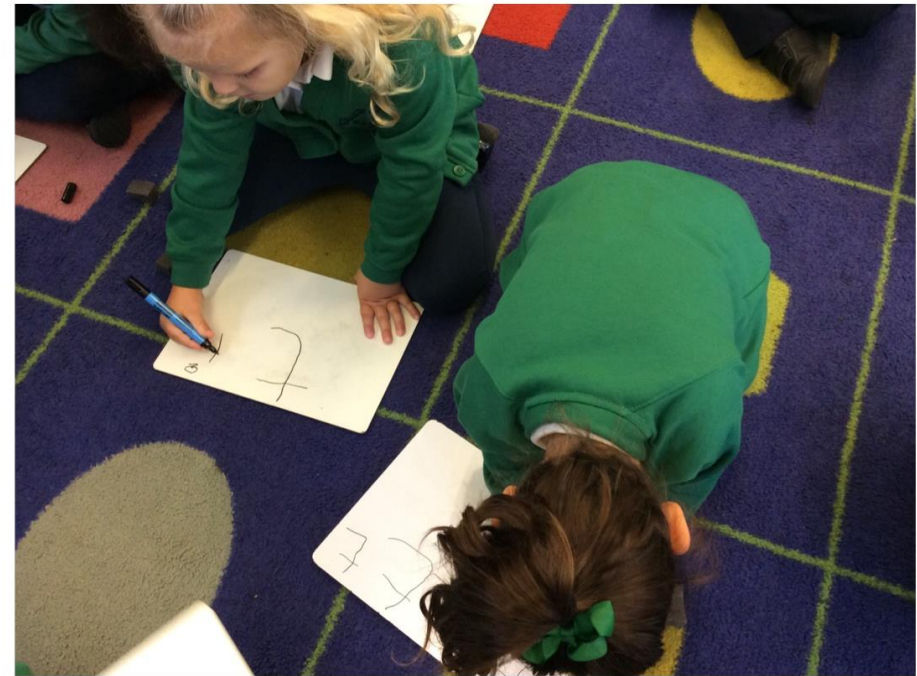
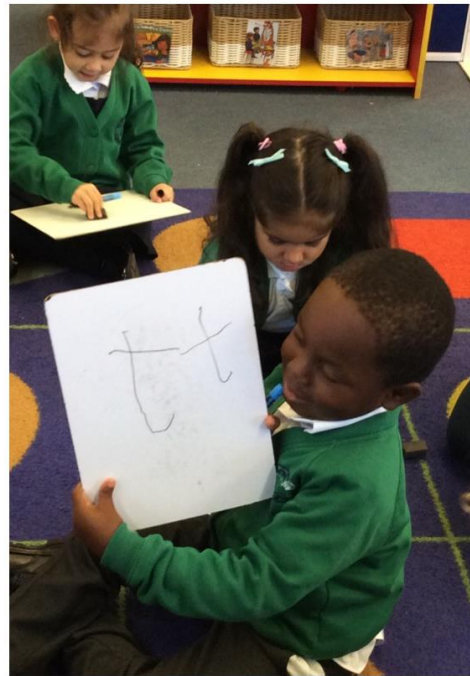
Year 3 enjoyed their art lesson, thinking about shapes in an object and composition. There are very talented artists in year 3; some even began shading in!

They have enjoyed looking at and sharing their 'All About Me' books with their friends. We have also been visiting the Infant library in small groups.



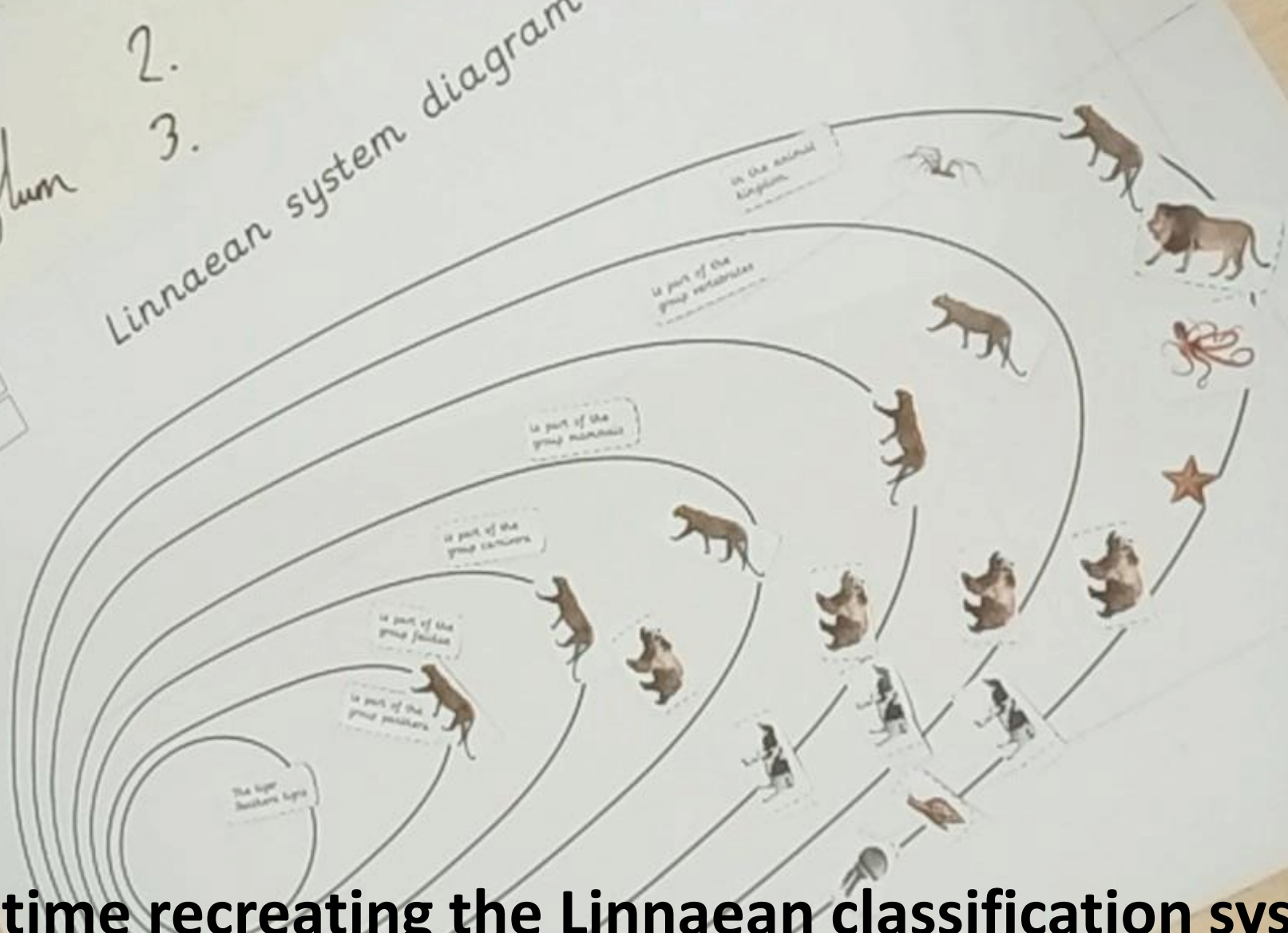

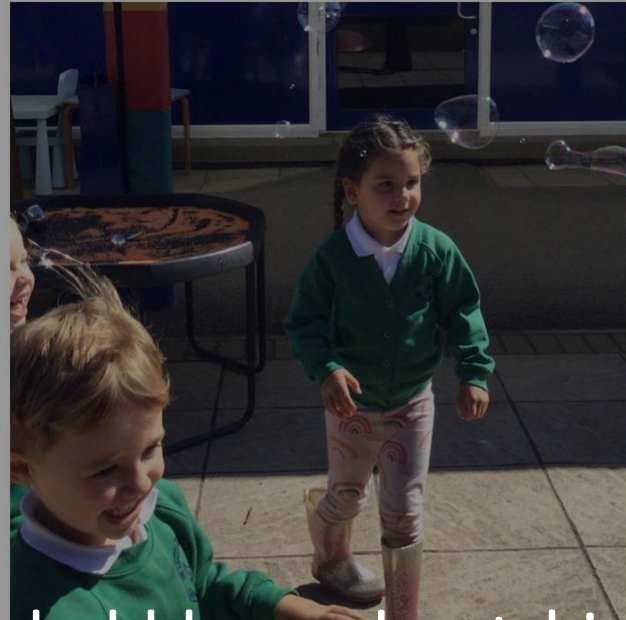
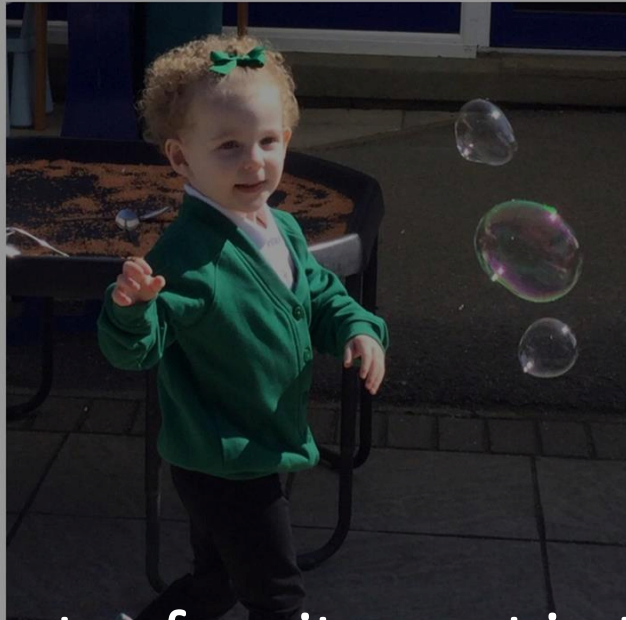
# Linnaean system diagram

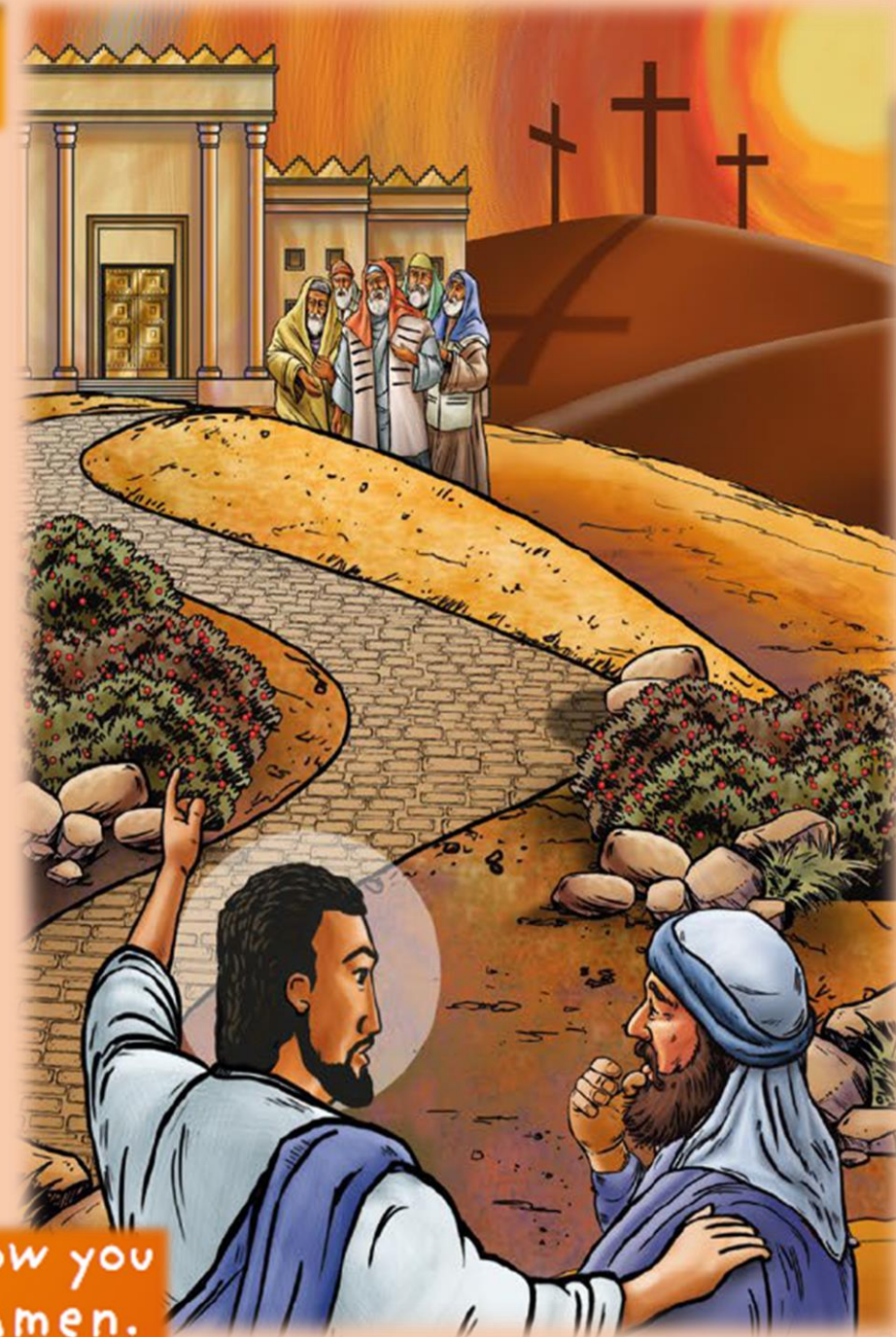
