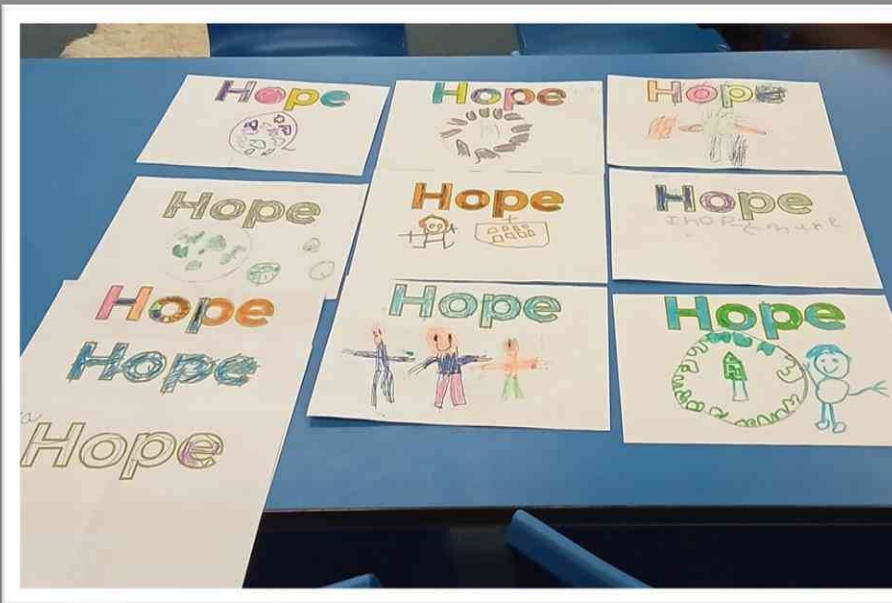
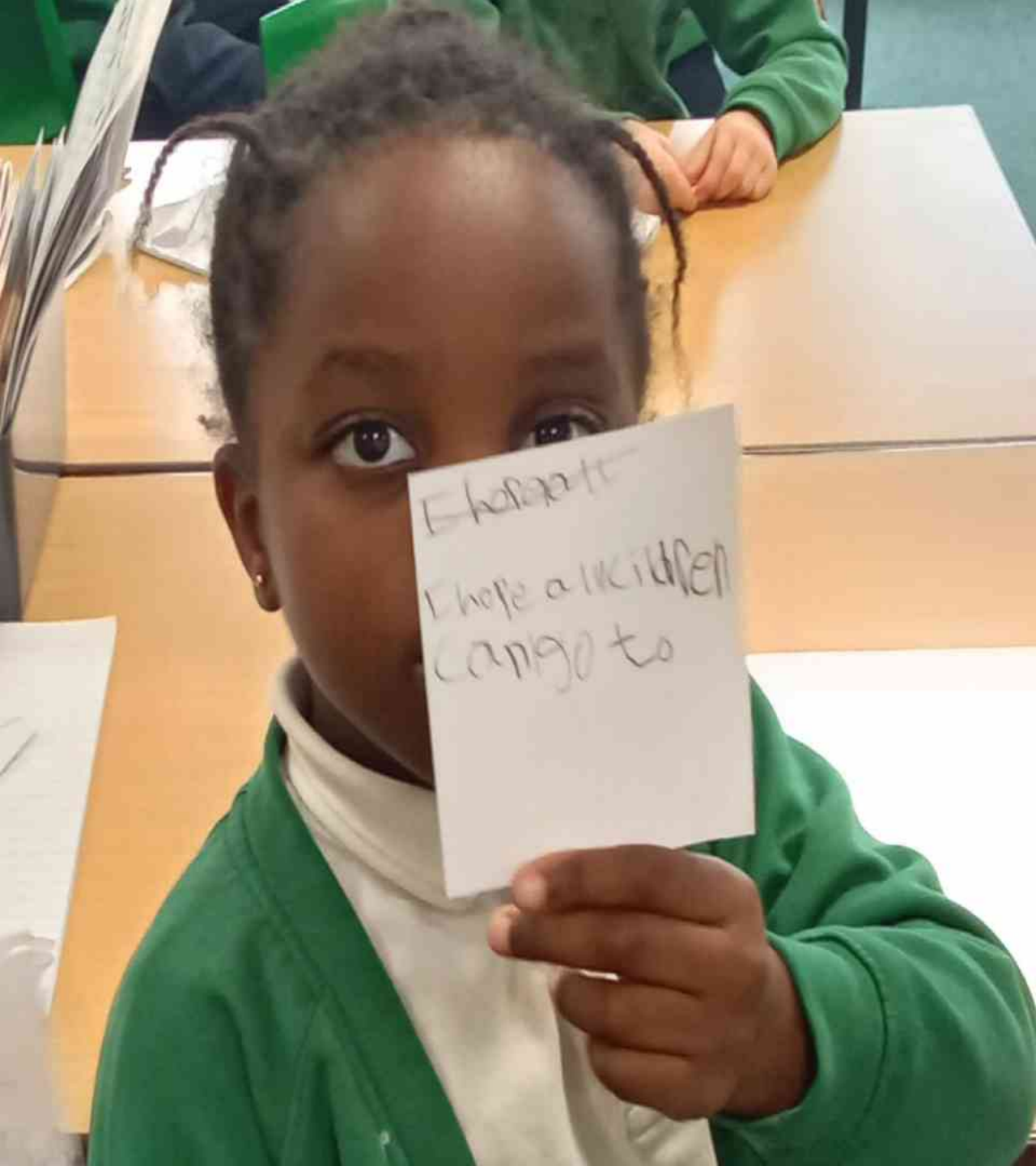




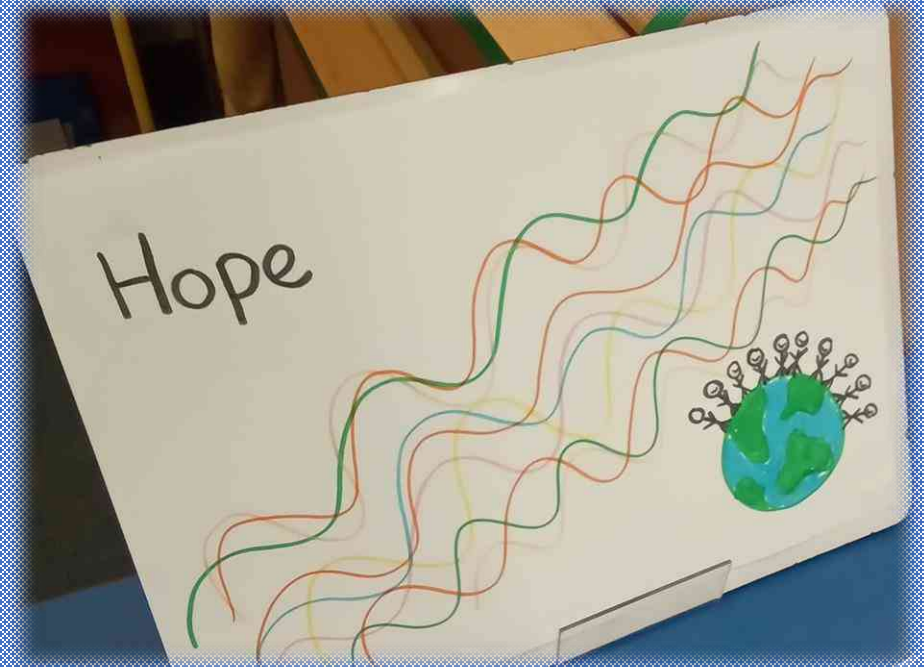
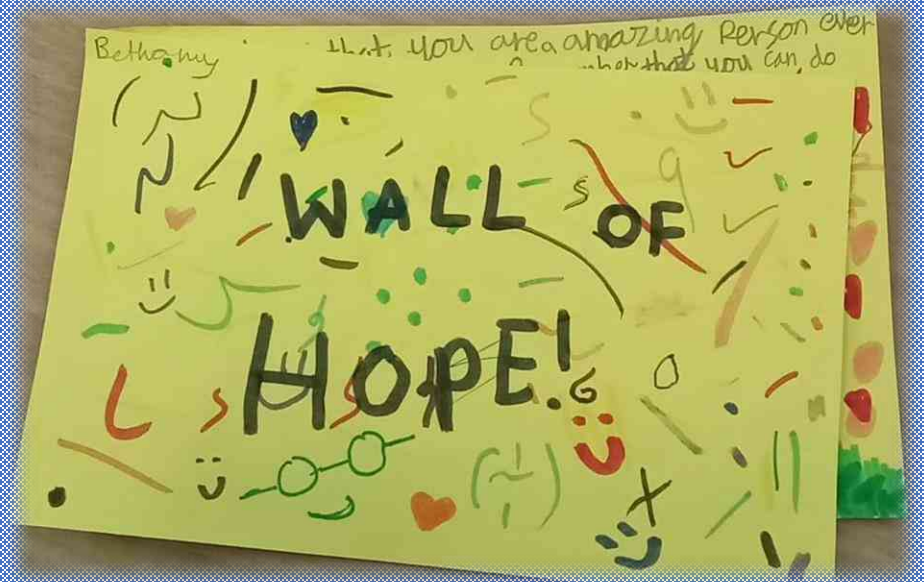


We loved celebrating the launch day for The Jubilee Year: Pilgrims of Hope! The Chaplaincy Team did a great job taking photographs around the school.









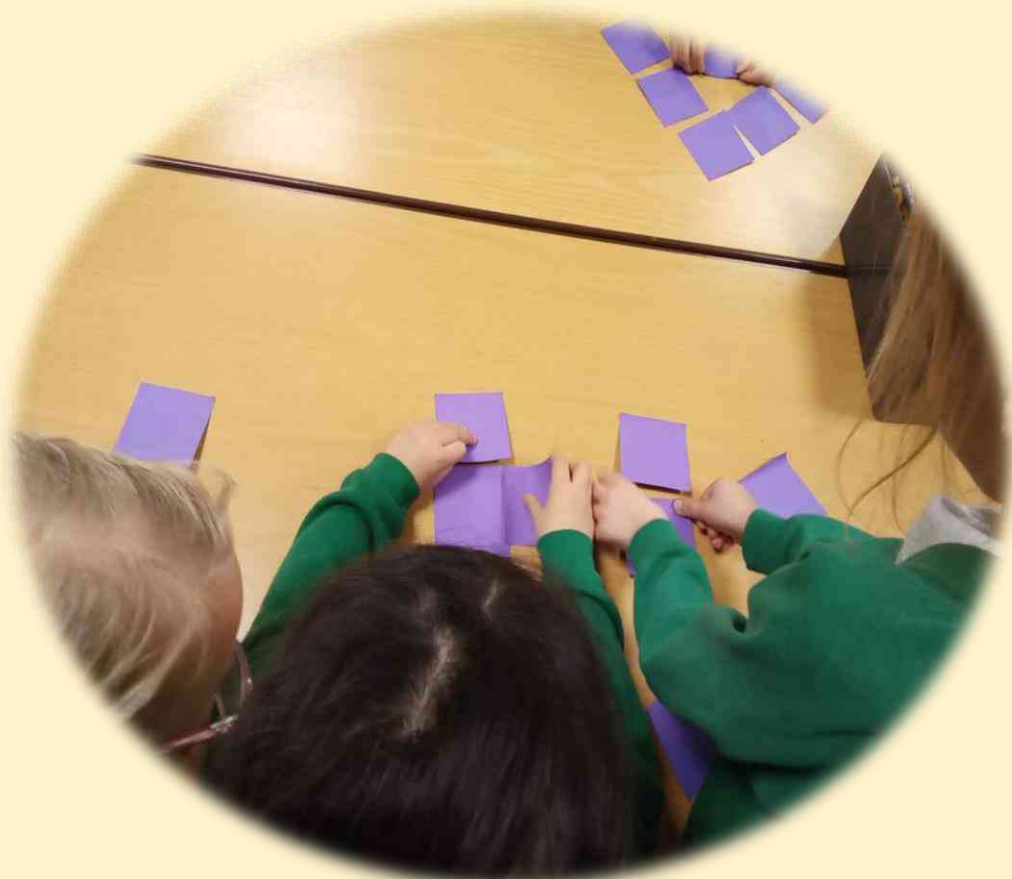
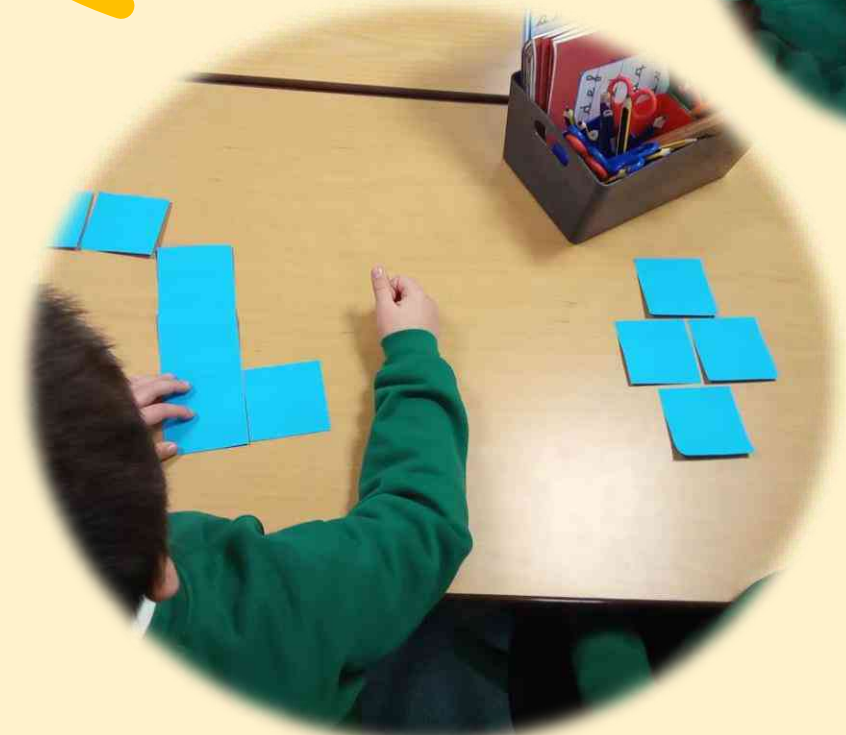
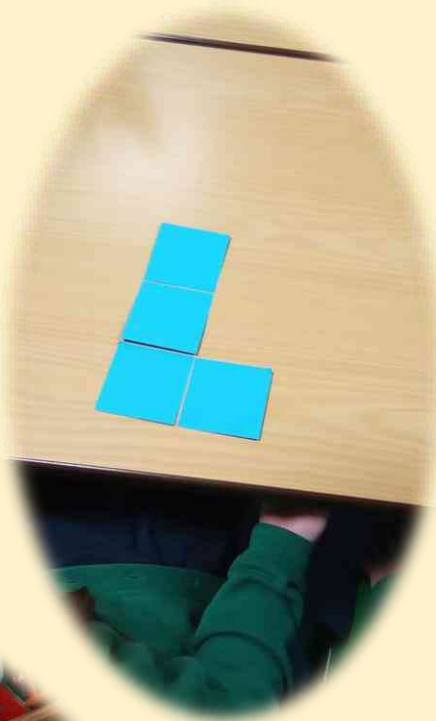
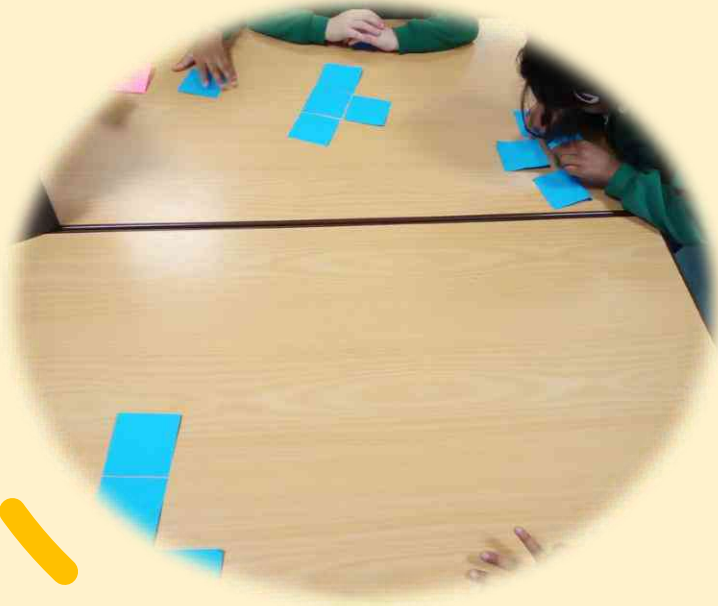

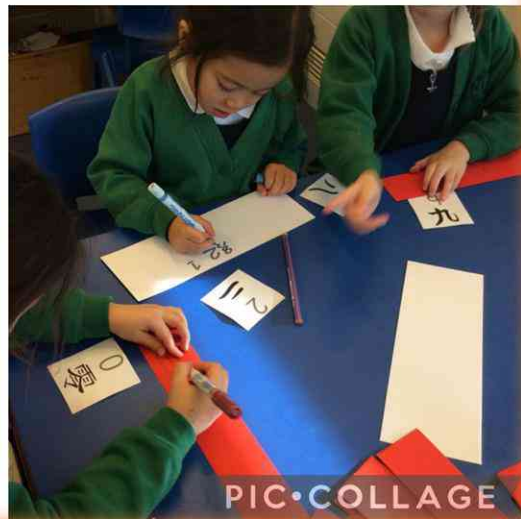
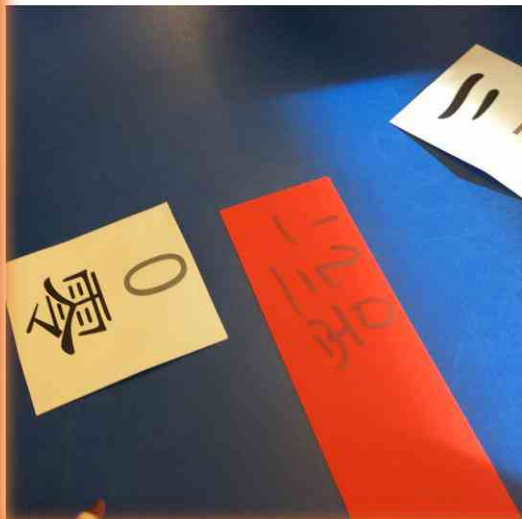
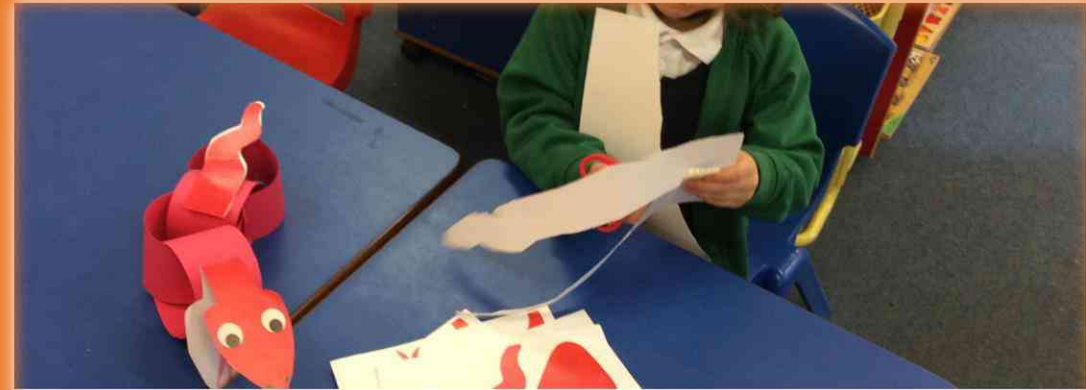
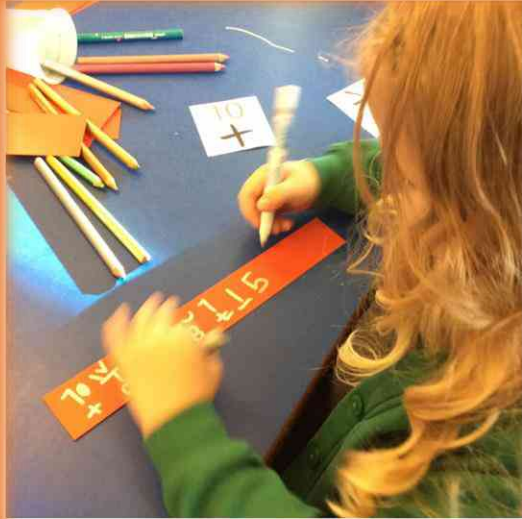


Reception had an amazing, fun filled time celebrating Chinese New Year.





We made beautiful lanterns, colourful dragon masks, and explored this special festival through fun and creative activities.

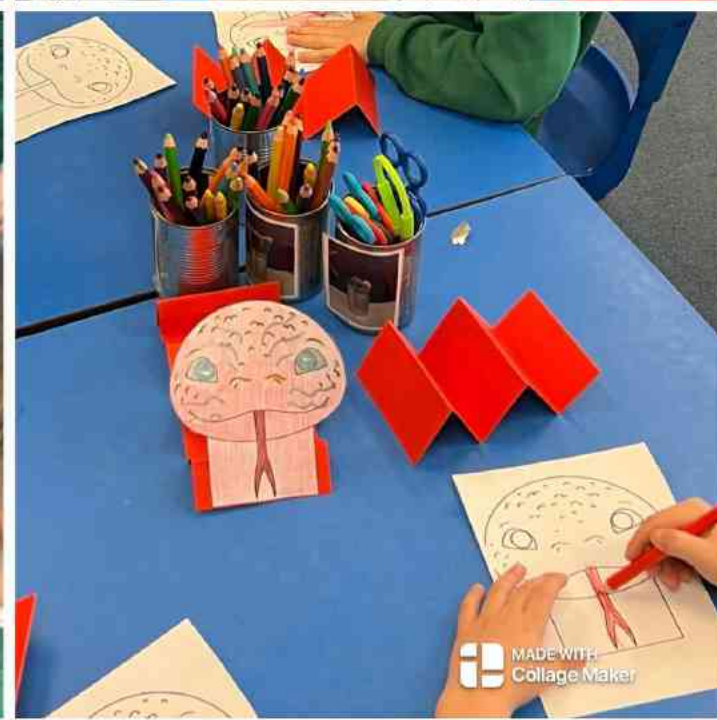

**The children in the Nursery have also been celebrating the Lunar New Year.**

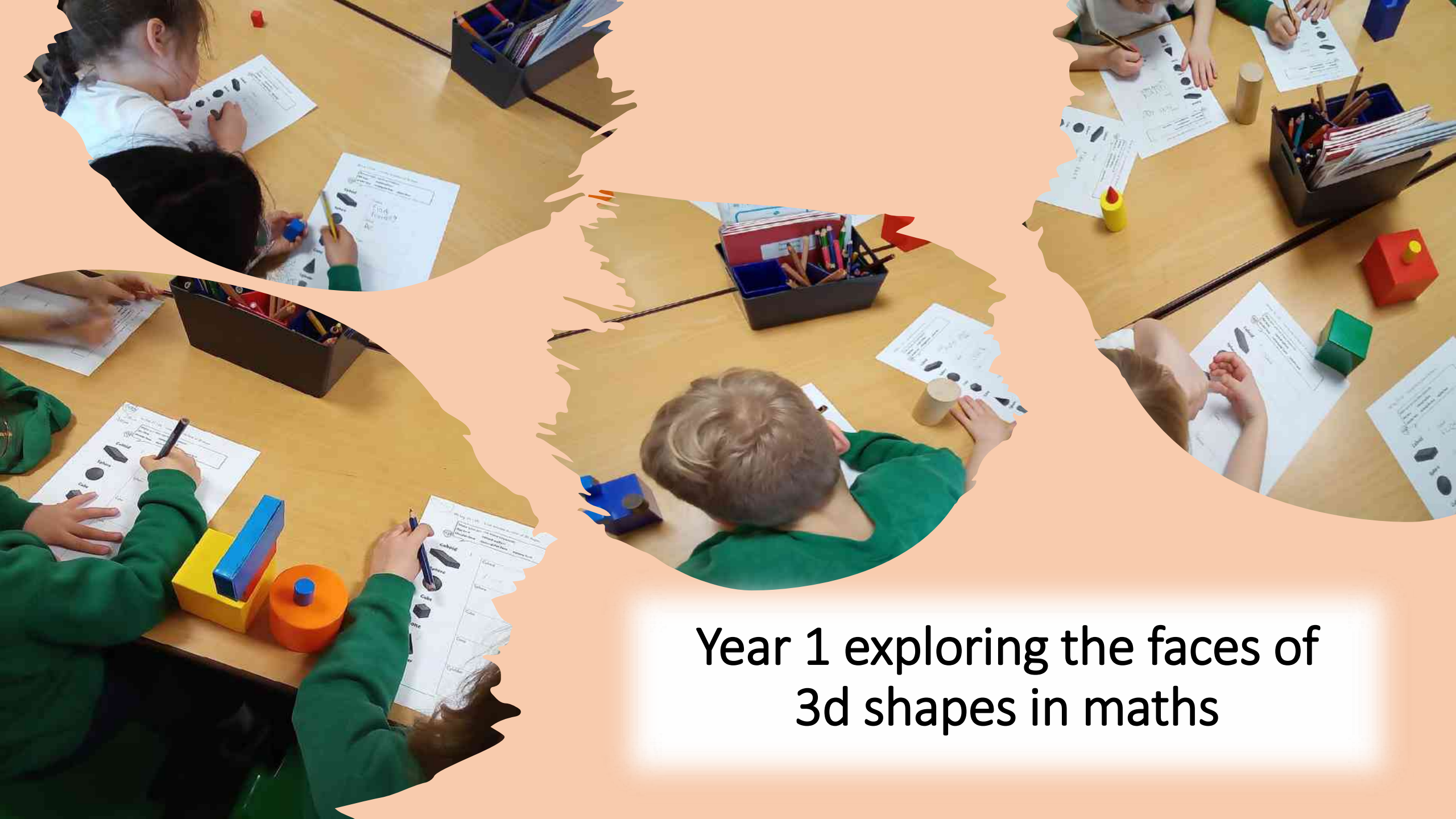

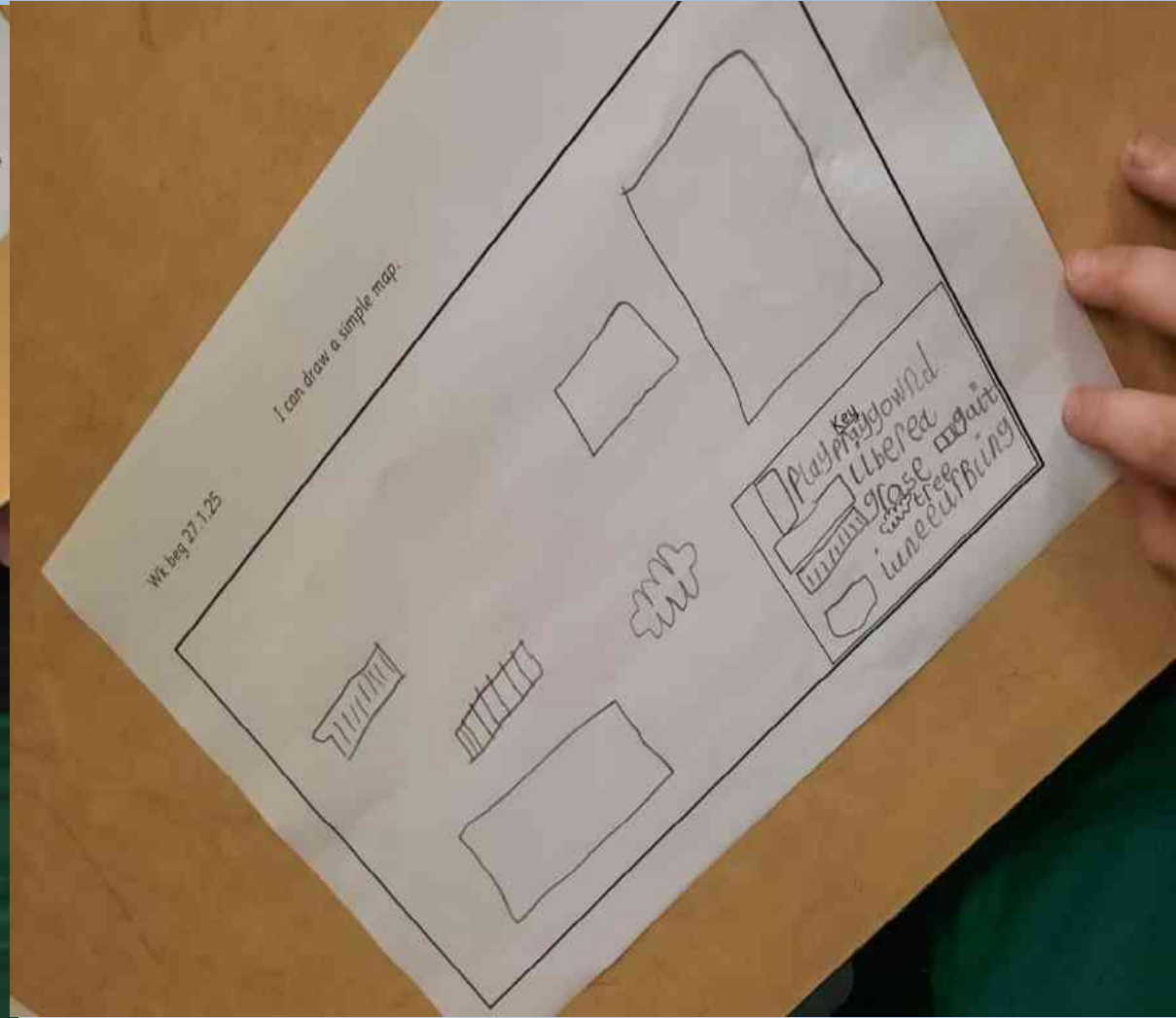
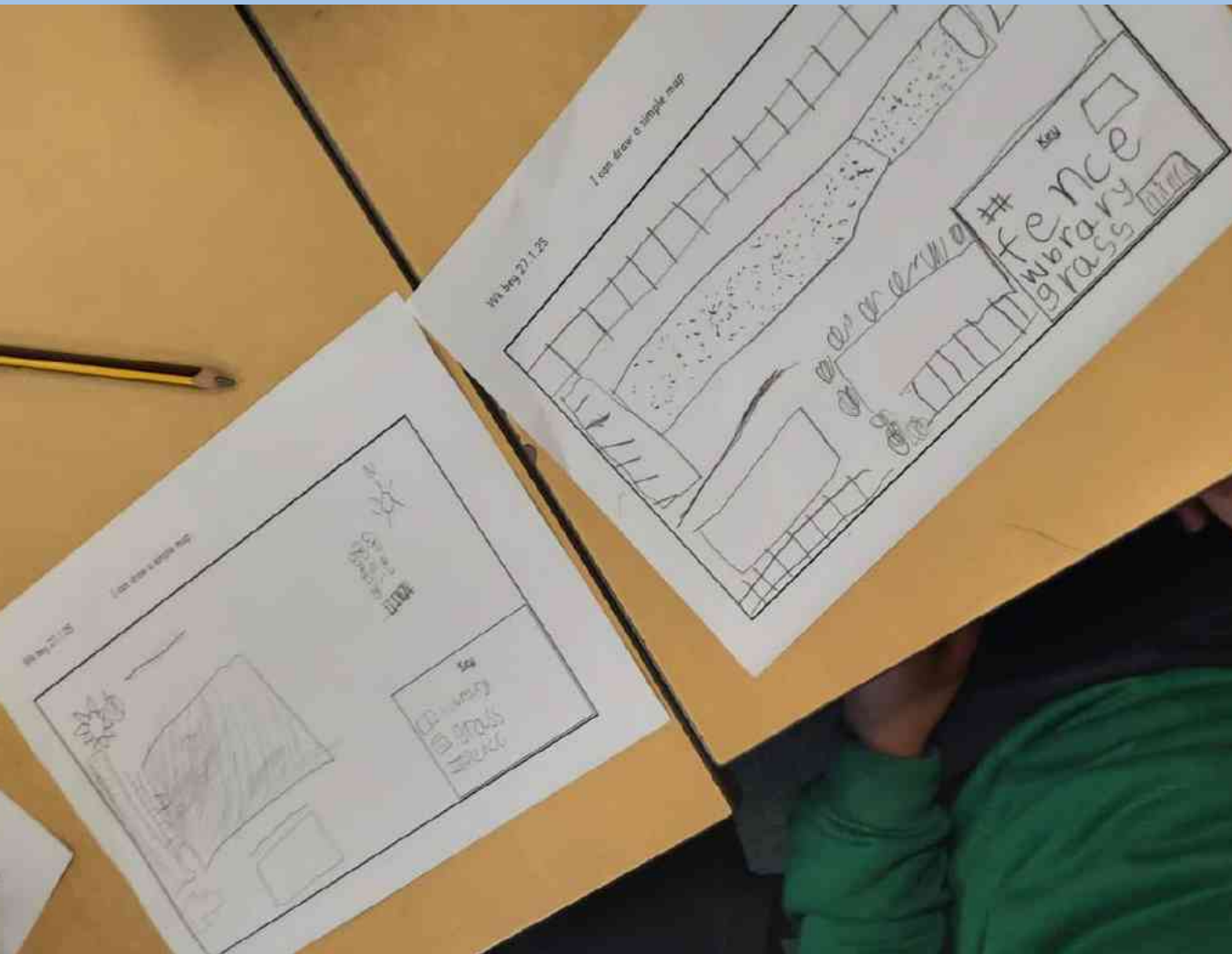




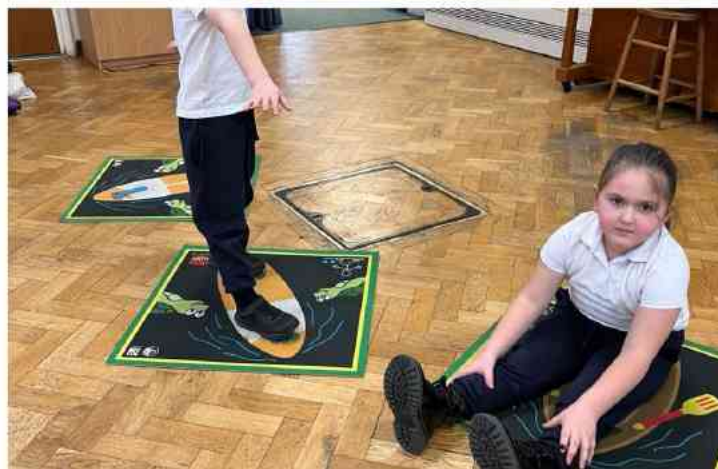
Year 1 have enjoyed making their own characters from potatoes, based on our book "My Pet Potato". Their potatoes look amazing!

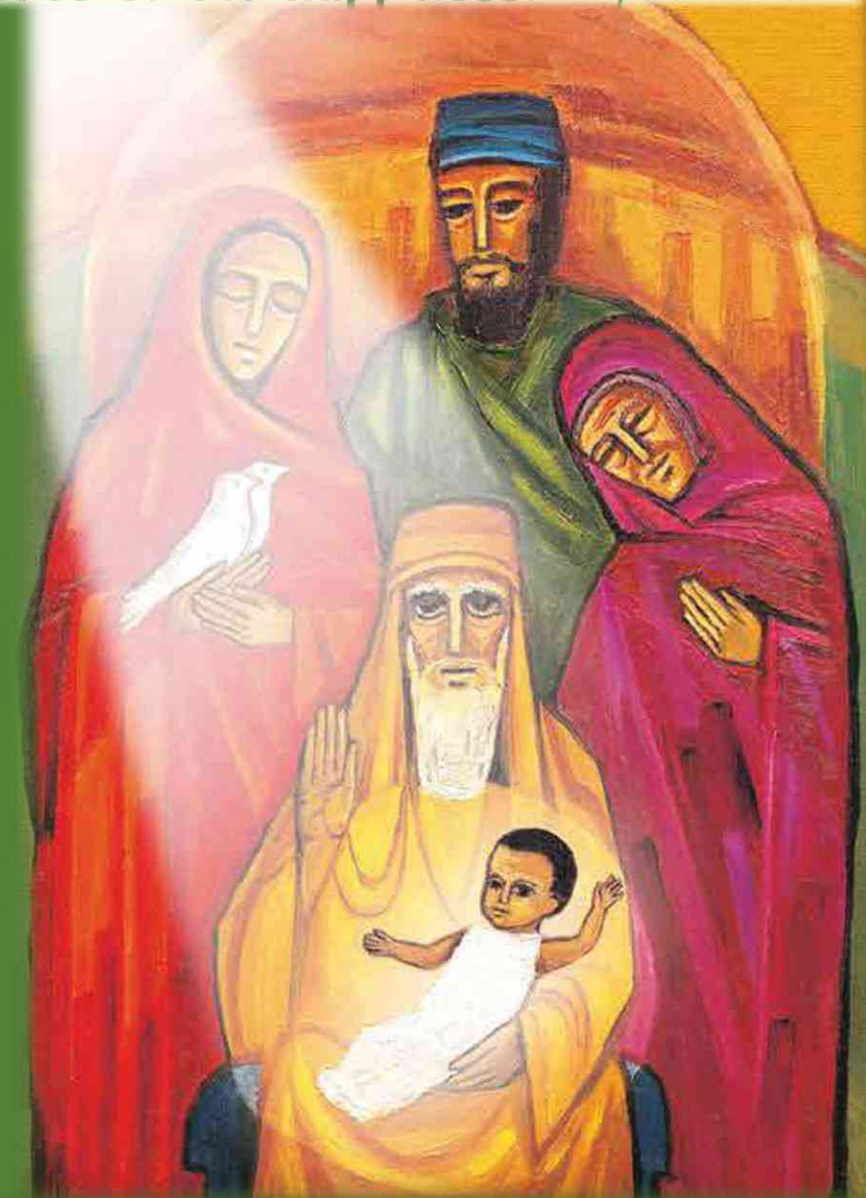
