


We loved celebrating the launch day for The Jubilee Year: Pilgrims of Hope! The Chaplaincy Team did a great job taking photographs around the school.























We had great fun celebrating the Year of Hope to commemorate this Jubilee Year. We hope you like our display! – Year 4





Year Five Teresa had a visit from the Police on Monday morning and learned about the effects of antisocial behaviour.







Year 1 exploring tetrominoes and their arrangements, flipped and rotated, in maths

Reception classes are really enjoying their gymnastics sessions this half term. We have seen some excellent stretches and tucks on and off the equipment.










Year 6MF working on their athletics skills in PE!

We also listened to the story of the 12 animals and how these fit into the Chinese Zodiac calendar.


The children in the Nursery have also been celebrating the Lunar New Year.

They have enjoyed a variety of experiences, including eating rice and noodles with chopsticks.





























Year 1 exploring the faces of 3d shapes in maths They had so much fun with shapes!






Year 1 have enjoyed making their own characters from potatoes, based on our book "My Pet Potato". Their potatoes look amazing!

A Word from Pope Francis
