


We created front covers on the computer.




Year 1 working in pairs to describe what they see in English.






























Year 2 are enjoying **Science Week** by creating their own colour catchers using the plants in our grounds.

Our Reception children have had a fantastic time exploring magnetism and floating & sinking in the outdoor area for Science Week!













In maths, they've been investigating number composition up to 8 and revisiting the meaning of 'equal.'

























Year 2 have been very busy this week learning how to write division expressions in maths.

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



Year 1 investigating their sense of smell in science.

They had great fun deciding what the different aromas were.


















The children were excited by a special assembly given by teachers from JHN to celebrate Science Week with the theme of how animals can thrive and adapt in their environments.












We enjoyed learning how we make secondary colours from primary colours and looked at how colours can change and how colours make our world.

The children loved getting hands-on with nature during our fantastic day of plant exploration!







They created beautiful observational drawings, planted cress heads, went on a lovely spring walk, and read about how plants grow.




















Year 5 finished the week off with an amazing assembly about saints - we are so proud of them!


