Our Reception scientists have been busy testing different materials to see which ones are waterproof!














Lots of curiosity, predictions, and splashes along the way











Wow! What a busy Friday afternoon in Year 1. We explored how we can make things move using sliders during our DT lesson. Great fun!



















which come in the middle or at the end of words.


We've also learnt

Our tricky words are


put, pull, and full
