


Year 2 had fun making shapes in our dance lesson.





Our tennis skills are improving each week in Year 3.

This week in Maths the Reception children have been learning about the composition of numbers. The children have been exploring how numbers can be made in different ways and how they can be split into smaller parts. We have been using dominoes to help us practise our number bonds, spotting the different amounts on each side and talking about the numbers we can see.

This practical approach helps to make our number bonds “sticky learning”, so the children can remember them more easily.
The children have done a fantastic job exploring, counting and explaining their thinking!




