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## **Class Information Letter - Year 2**

Welcome to the new school year. The children have made a positive start to Year 2 and are beginning to get to know their new routines. We are looking forward to giving the children many opportunities for new learning with lots of challenge. The Year 2 team and all the children have high expectations for learning and having fun.

## **Behaviour and Rewards**

Our school uses the Hertfordshire Steps approach which supports a therapeutic ethos, early intervention and professional responses to complex, challenging or high-risk behaviours. We have developed three universal school rules which each class has spent time exploring and these are:

- Be ready
- Be respectful
- Be safe

In Year 2 the children will be rewarded for particularly good learning or behaviour. Rewards will consist of merit points which go towards certificates for 20, 40 or 60 merits. Additionally, children will sometimes be given a note to take home to celebrate their achievements. For exceptional learning or behaviour children will be taken to

Mr White for special recognition and a Headteacher's Award.

#### **Curriculum**

Here is information relating to the Autumn Term curriculum. If you look on the school website you will see how this fits into the curriculum for the entire Key Stage. This may help you to plan interesting visits that match your child's syllabus.

In RE we shall continue to follow the liturgical year. This term, beginning with Ordinary Time, leads up to the liturgical seasons of Advent and Christmas. Our themes are The Chosen People and Mysteries. We will use Bible stories to learn about some characters that were chosen by God for their special qualities. The children will also learn about the Trinity as well as other Mysteries.

Each term you will also receive a termly RE Newsletter which will help you to support your child's learning and faith journey throughout the liturgical year.

**English** Work in English will cover poems, stories with familiar settings and instructions. The children will be developing their reading skills with a particular emphasis on comprehension through regular guided reading. Drama activities will help to develop their vocabulary as well as speaking and listening skills. The children will be given many opportunities to write in different contexts.

<u>Maths</u> The main focus throughout the year will be to develop reasoning in maths. This will include recognising patterns and using mathematical vocabulary. This term the focus is mainly on number and our number system. You can support your child at home by playing dice and card games, practising number bonds for 10 and 20 as well as the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.











**Science** Our topic is 'Health and Growth' and will cover aspects of nutrition, exercise and knowledge of the human body.

**Computing** The children will be using Purple Mash to develop coding and spreadsheet skills. We will also be considering keeping safe on the internet. Please remember that the children can access Purple Mash to consolidate their learning at home.

<u>Topics</u> The topics this term are '**All About Me'** and '**The Victorians'** and will be covered through science, history, geography and art. There will be links with English to develop skills.

#### **Physical Education**

Throughout the whole school all PE kits consist of navy shorts and white round necked t-shirt.

Children will need their P.E. kit every Tuesday and Friday but it is advisable to leave the PE kit in school and only take home each half term.

**Home Learning** Home learning is set on Fridays to be returned no later than the following Wednesday. This will usually include maths and English. This is supplemented by regular reading, spellings, number bonds and times tables.

Children are expected to bring their reading book and reading record in their school book bag each day.

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The children will be attending Parish Mass regularly during the term.

Water Bottle: All children are encouraged to drink plenty of water during the day, therefore, please supply your child with a refillable sports top water bottle. This must ONLY contain water, NO juices.

Children in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 receive a free piece of fruit or vegetable every day. Children in other year groups may bring in a piece of fruit or vegetable for a morning snack if they wish.

Jewellery. NO jewellery should be worn in school including earrings. Those with pierced ears must remove the earrings during school hours. If you wish your child to have their ears pierced this should take place at the beginning of the summer holidays to ensure the ears are healed before returning in September.

Long hair must be tied back during school hours.

Plimsolls: all pupils must have a pair of well-fitted plimsolls in school. Please ensure all clothing and personal items are named. Lost property is now in a blue box directly outside our main office area and is accessible at all times.
