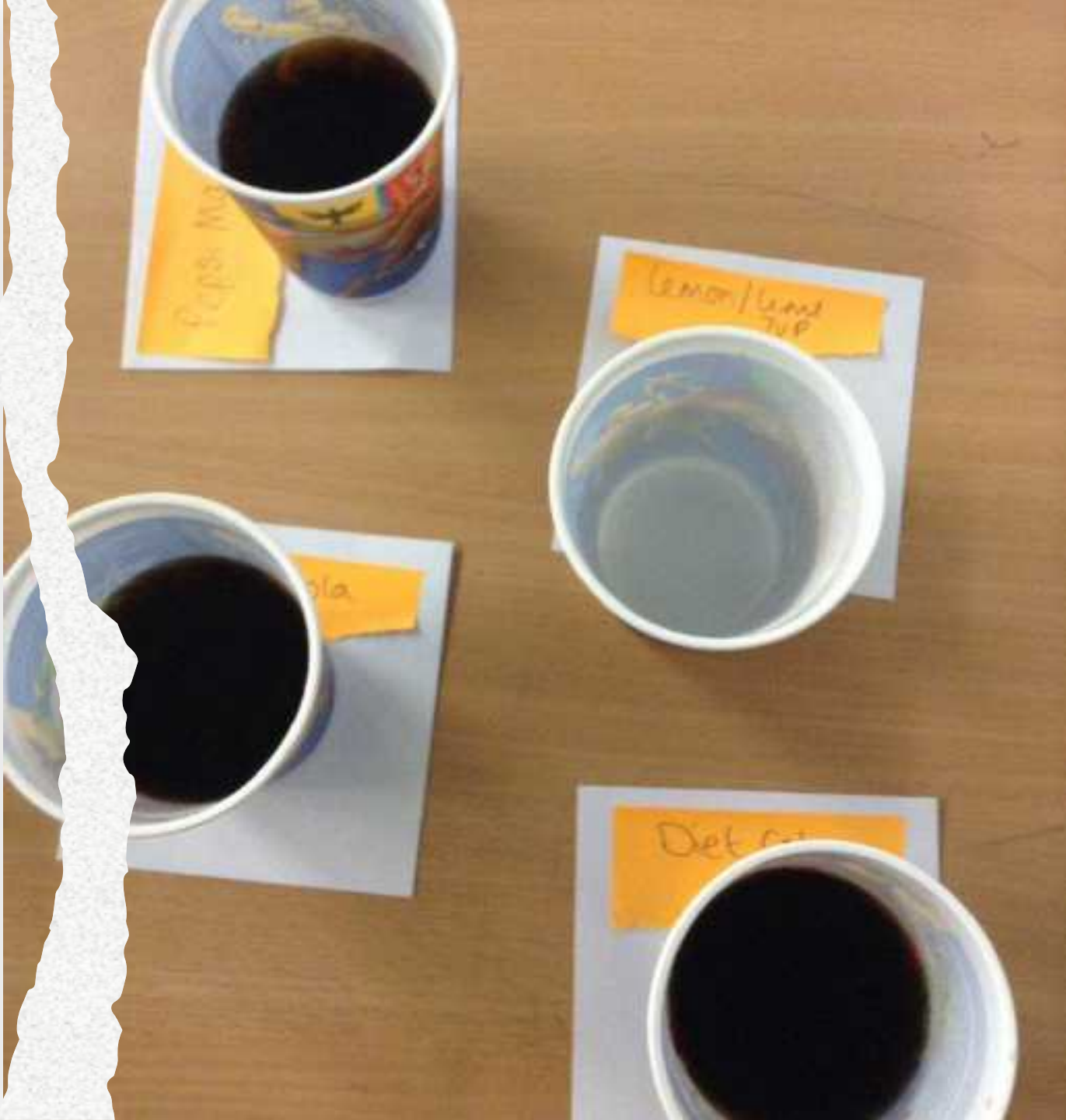

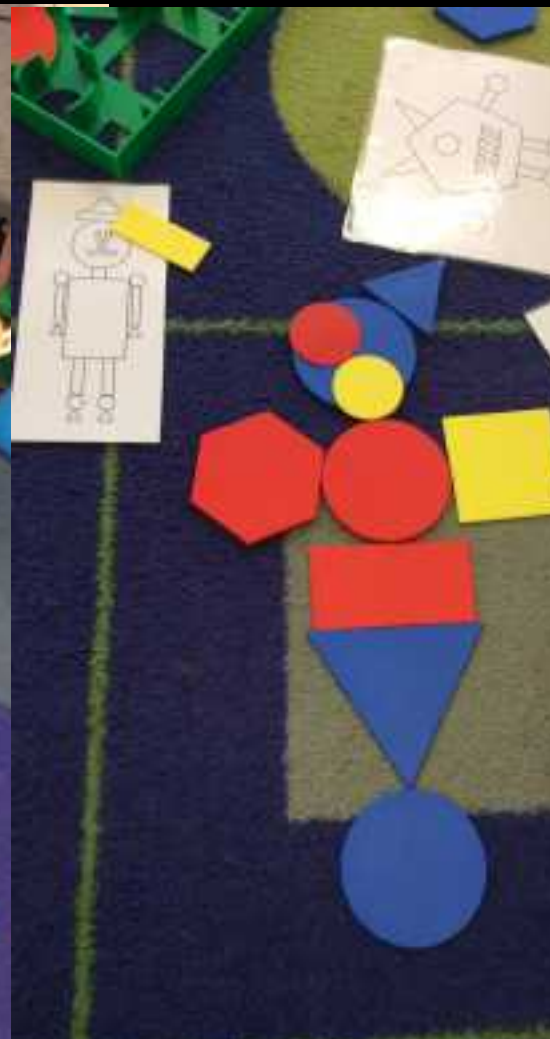

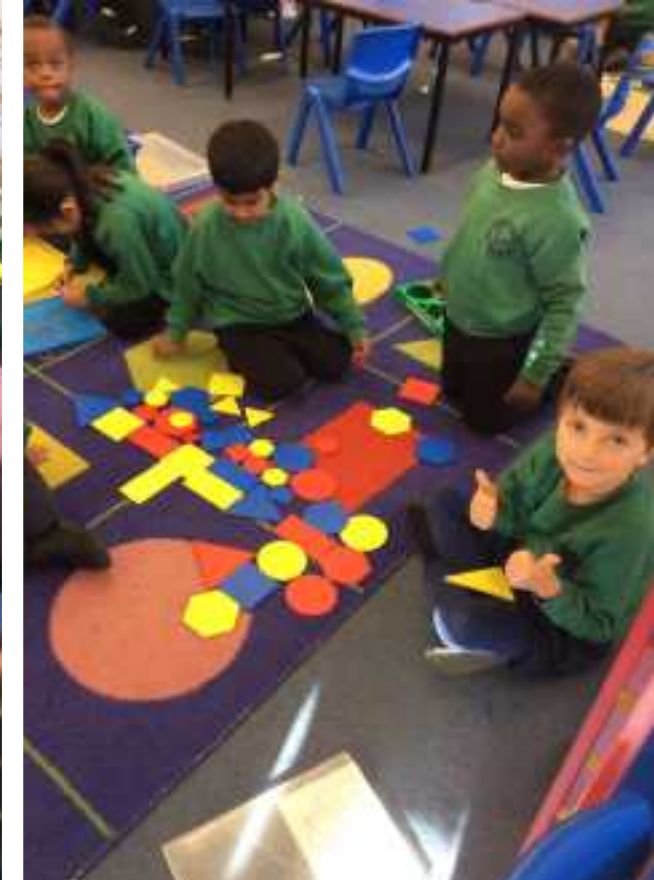
The Nursery children have been creating their own props to retell the story of the week.

Amazing writing from some of our Reception pupils during Child Initiated Learning today. Shiny the robot helps them with their phonics!

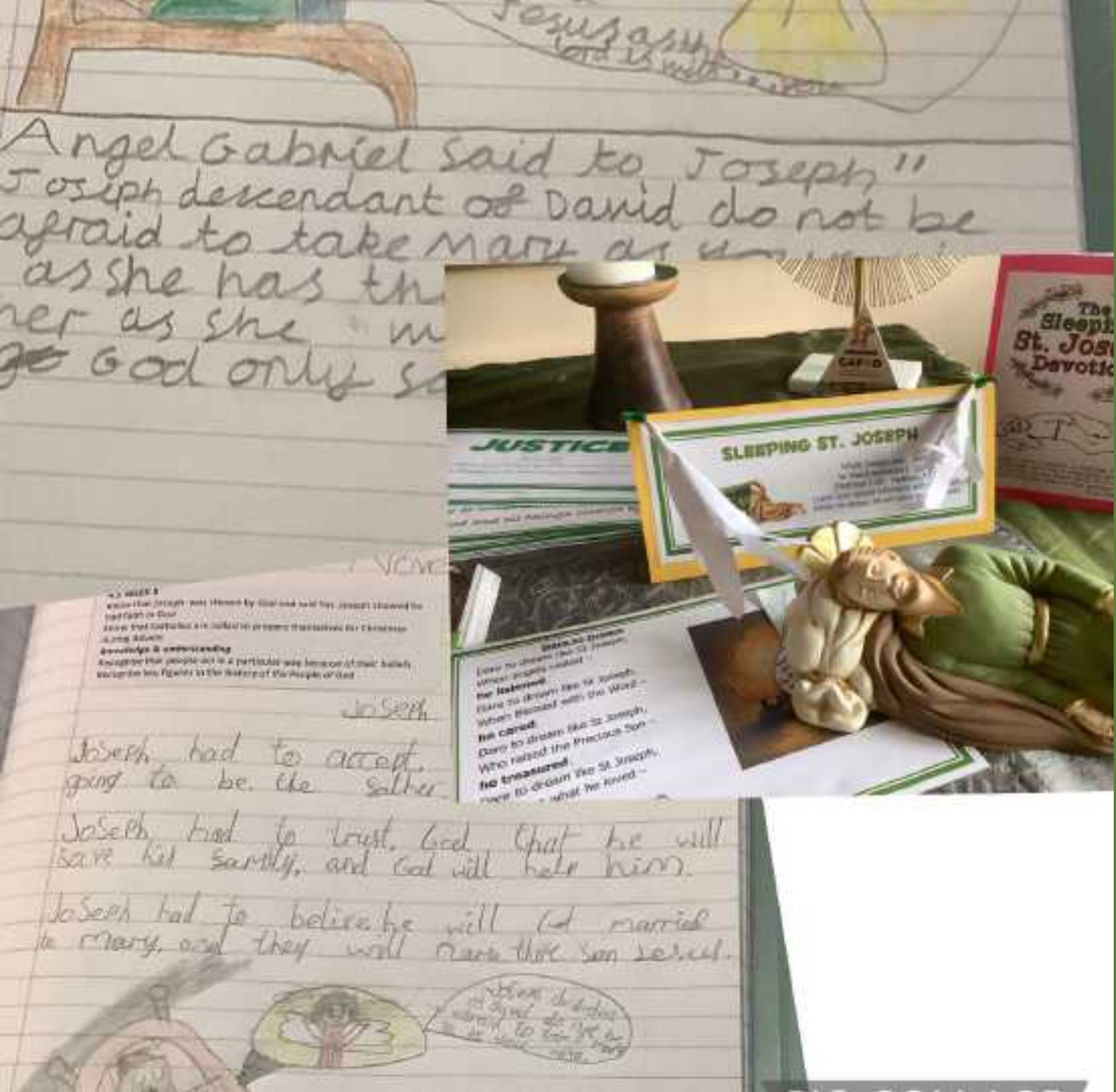

THE GOSPEL IN CHURCH

Sunday 27th November 2022



Jesus said to his disciples, "As it was in Noah's day, so will it be when the Son of Man comes.
