We train on Tuesday evenings and play matches on Saturdays in the Hertfordshire Girls Football Partnership League

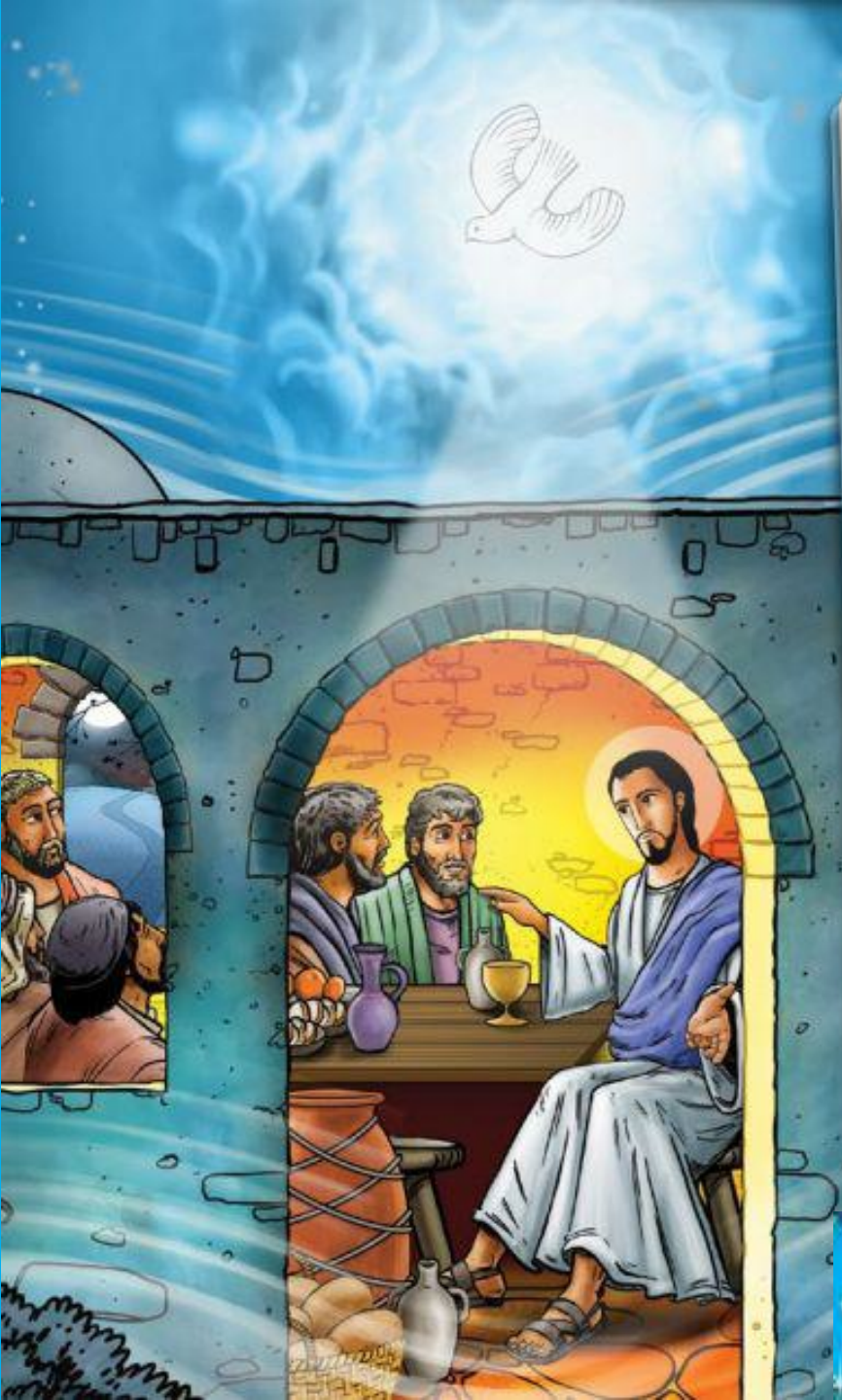
