



















In science, year 3 have been dissecting flowers to see each part and think about the role that part plays in pollination and fertilisation.






Year 4 are learning about the anatomy of flying insects of tropical rainforests

Well done children.
























Reception thoroughly enjoyed the Zoolab visit on Friday! The children asked some amazing questions about the animals.

This new system also means that entry into the disco will be sped up and your child will have more time to enjoy the disco.


Disco ticket reminder
