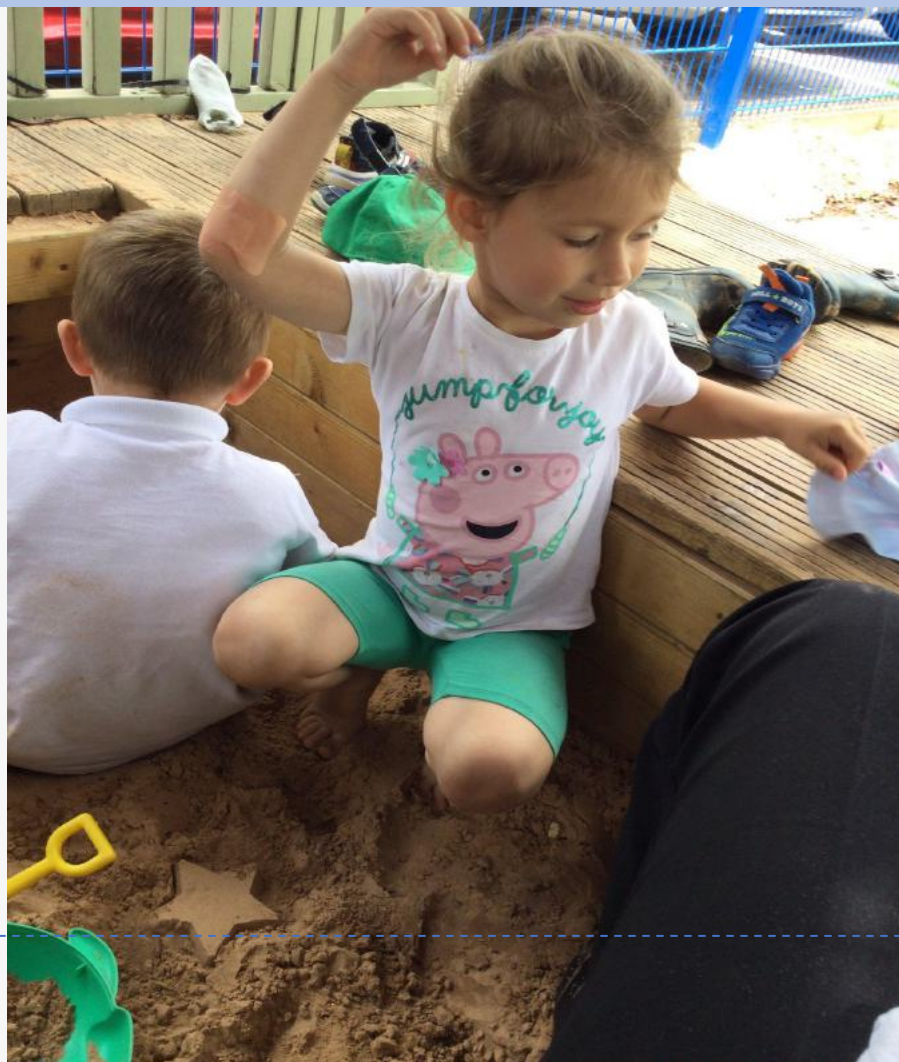




This week in Maths the children in Reception counted sets of objects, tagging each item in the set.
