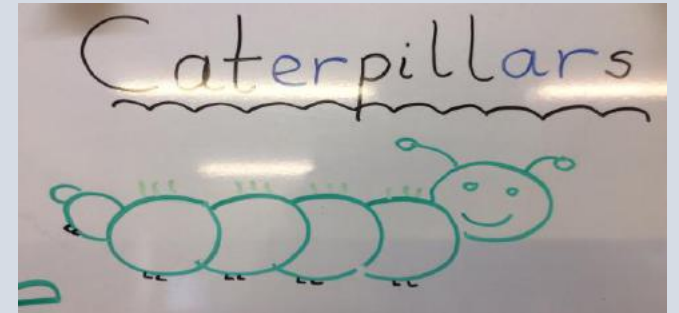
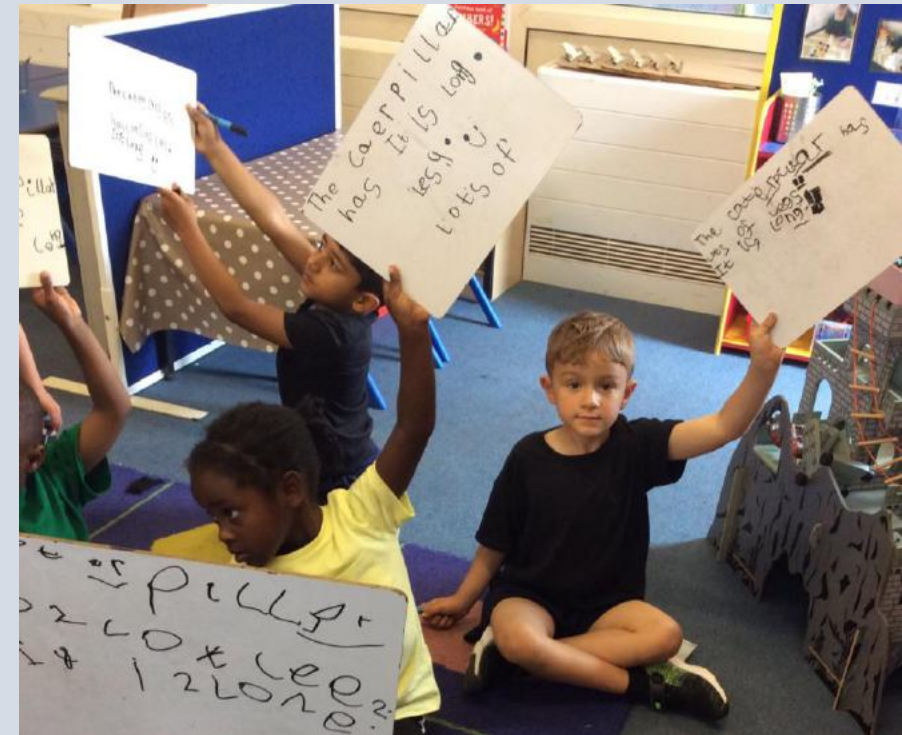
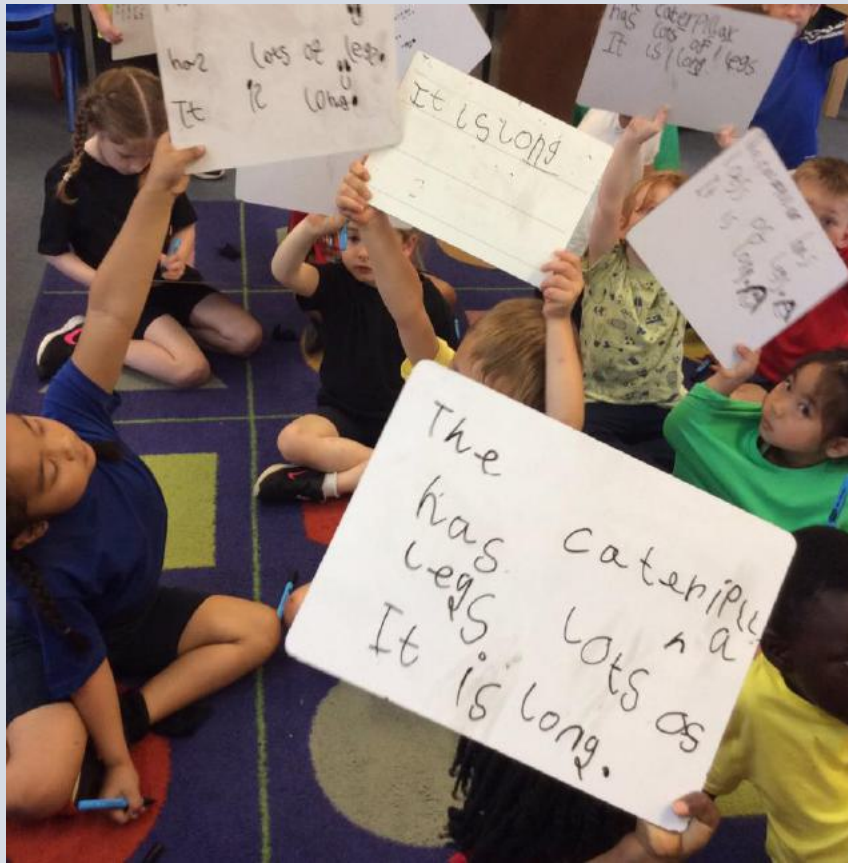




KS1 and KS2 sports day

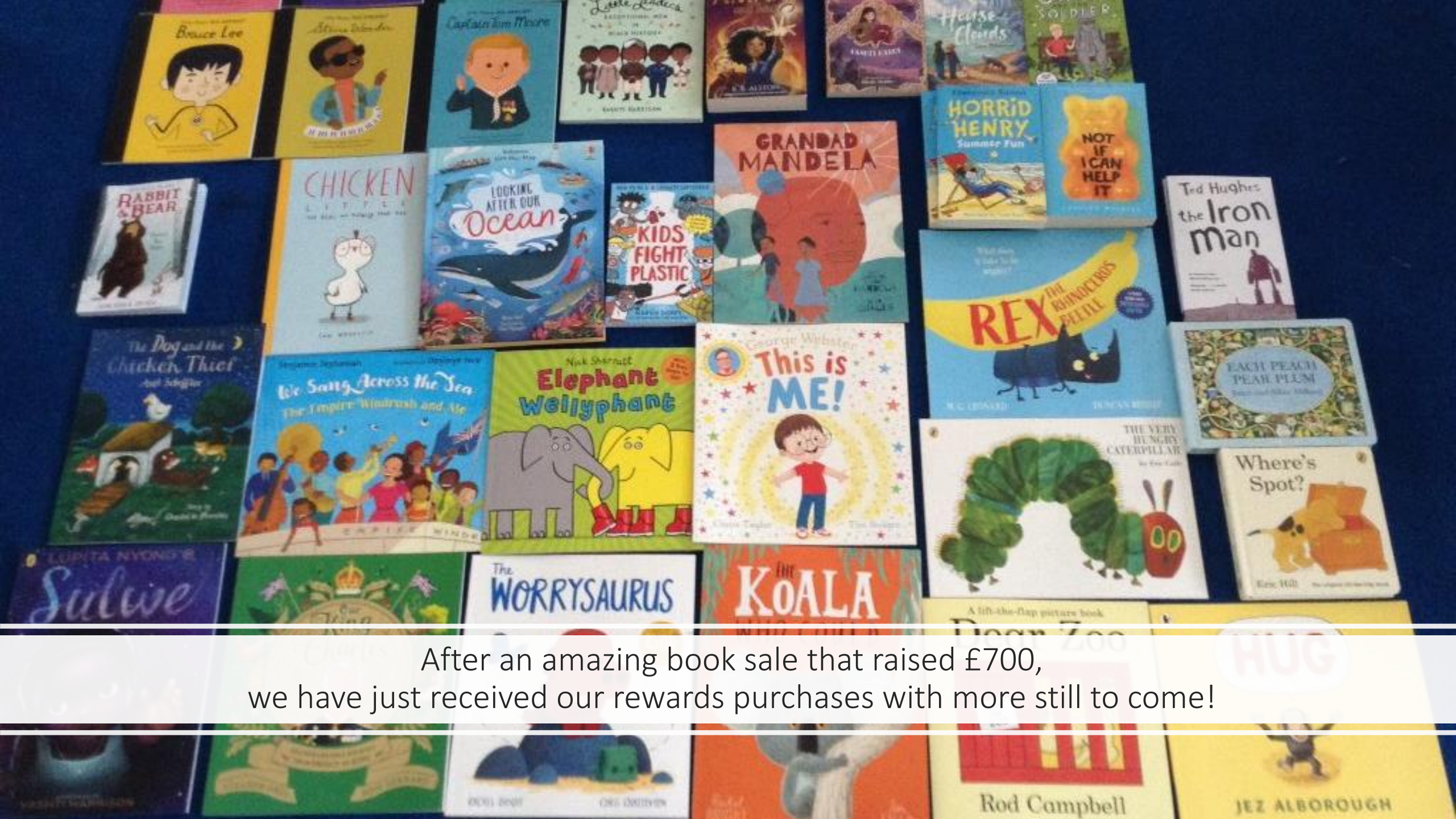

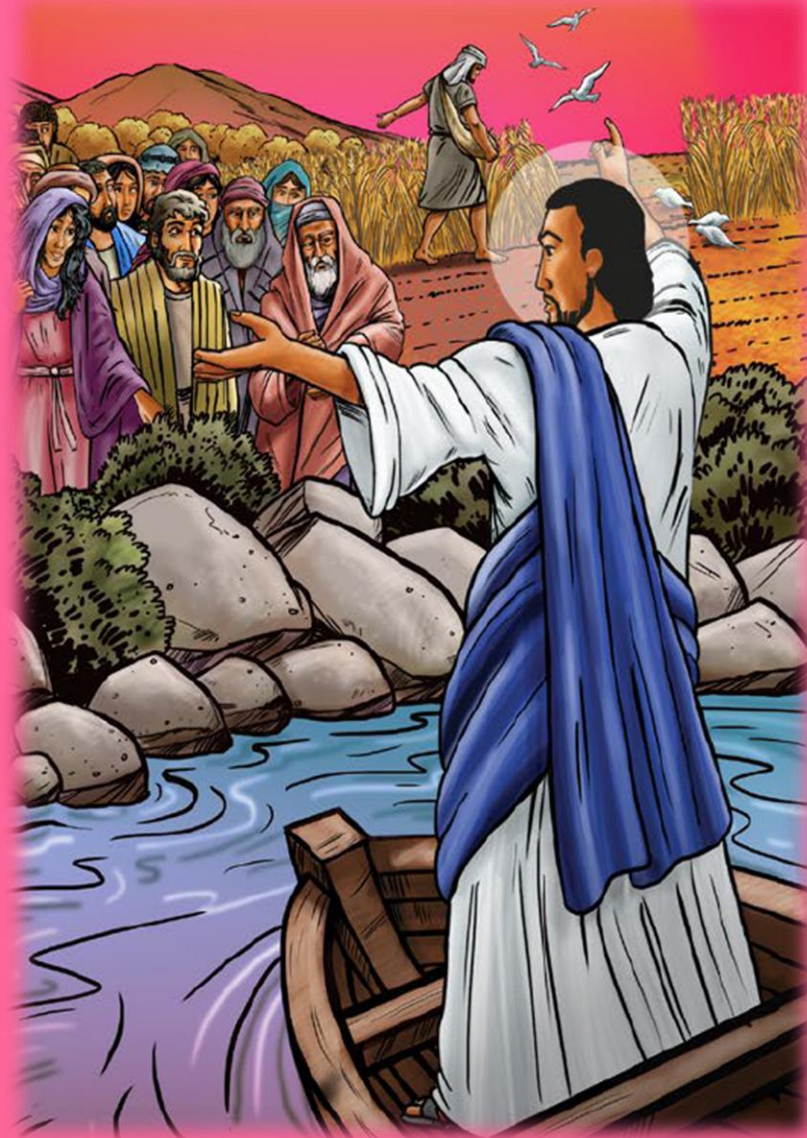

## SCRIPTURE

***Jesus said:***

*“Other seeds fell on rich soil and produced a great crop.*

*This is like those people who hear my words and understand them;”*

## TEACHING

*Jesus is like a sower, scattering his words like seeds. Jesus’ words have stood the test of time. They are rooted in love and can be trusted to guide us*



## WORSHIP

*Jesus wants us to take the time to think and show we understand what he is saying– to be like good soil so the seed (his words) can take root and grow. Then God can work through us to build the Kingdom.*
