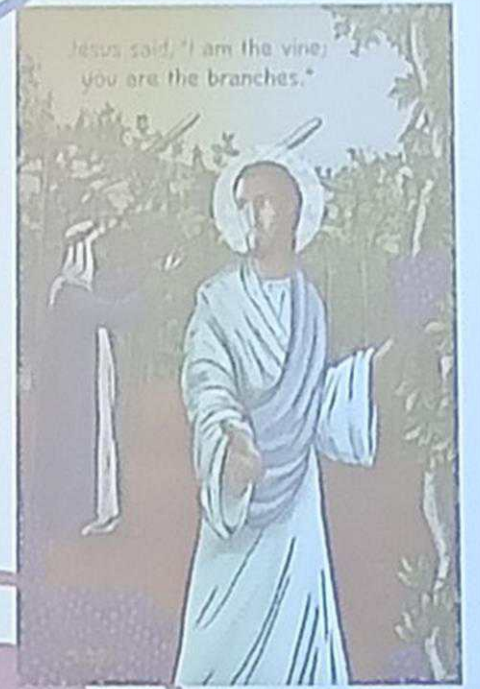
A reading from the holy gospel according to John.

Over the Easter holidays, year 5 designed and made some pop up books for our year 1 class. They had a lovely time sharing the books.

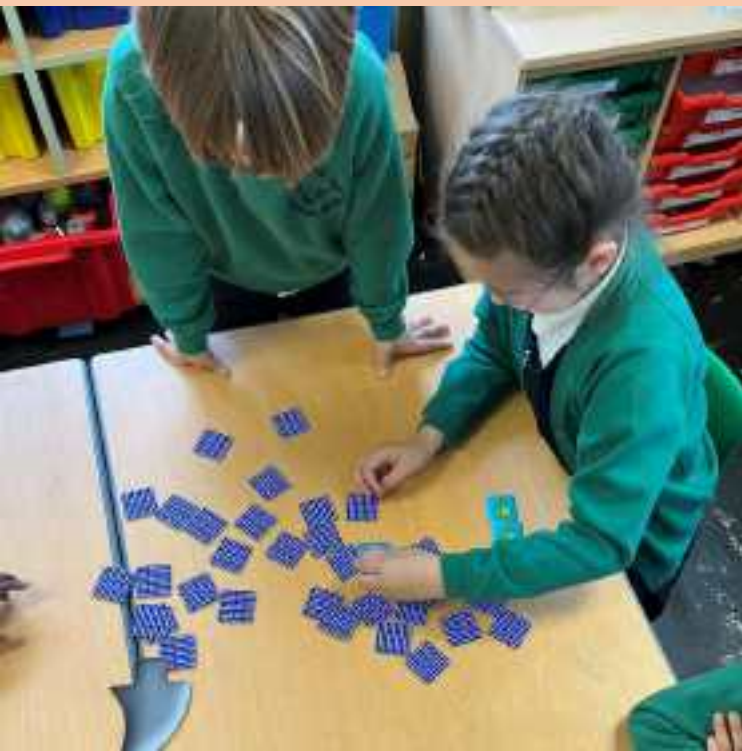




Year 5 sharing their super handmade pop-up books with Year 1; it was great to see them enjoying each other's company.

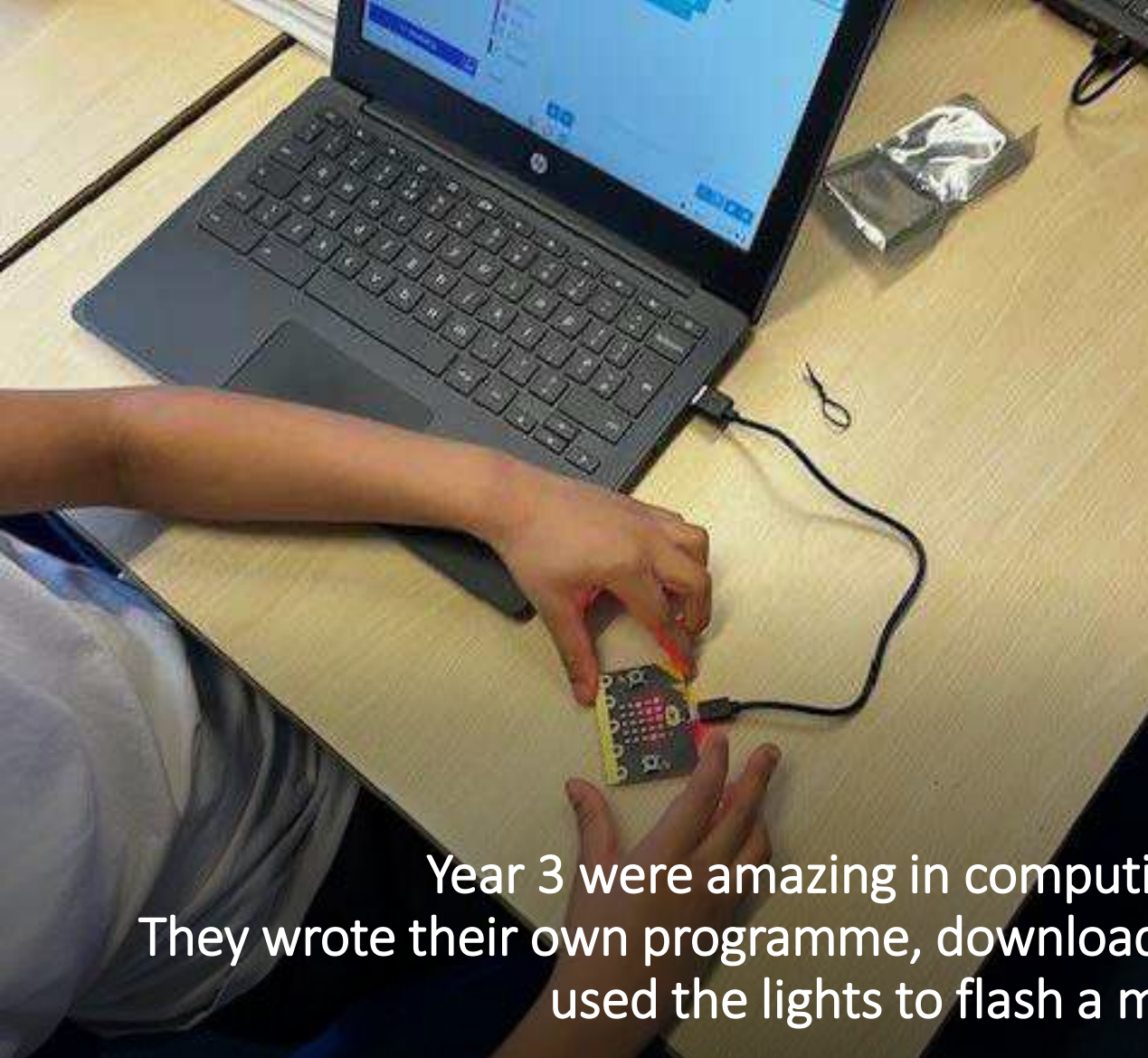
The Reception children were overjoyed to have the sandpit open for the first time this year!



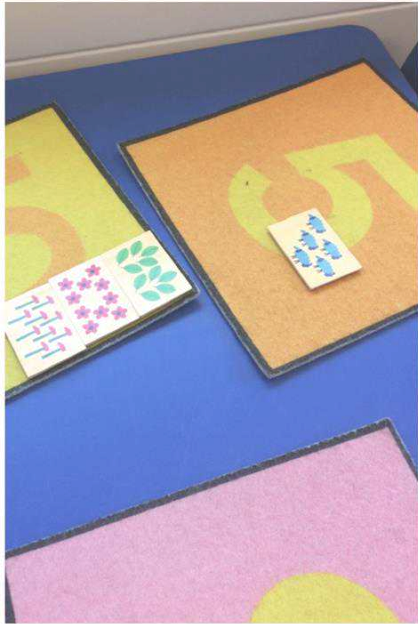
Year 1 and 2 games club had a great time playing a variety of board games after school.

The disciples were scared then Jesus was in the locked room. The disciples



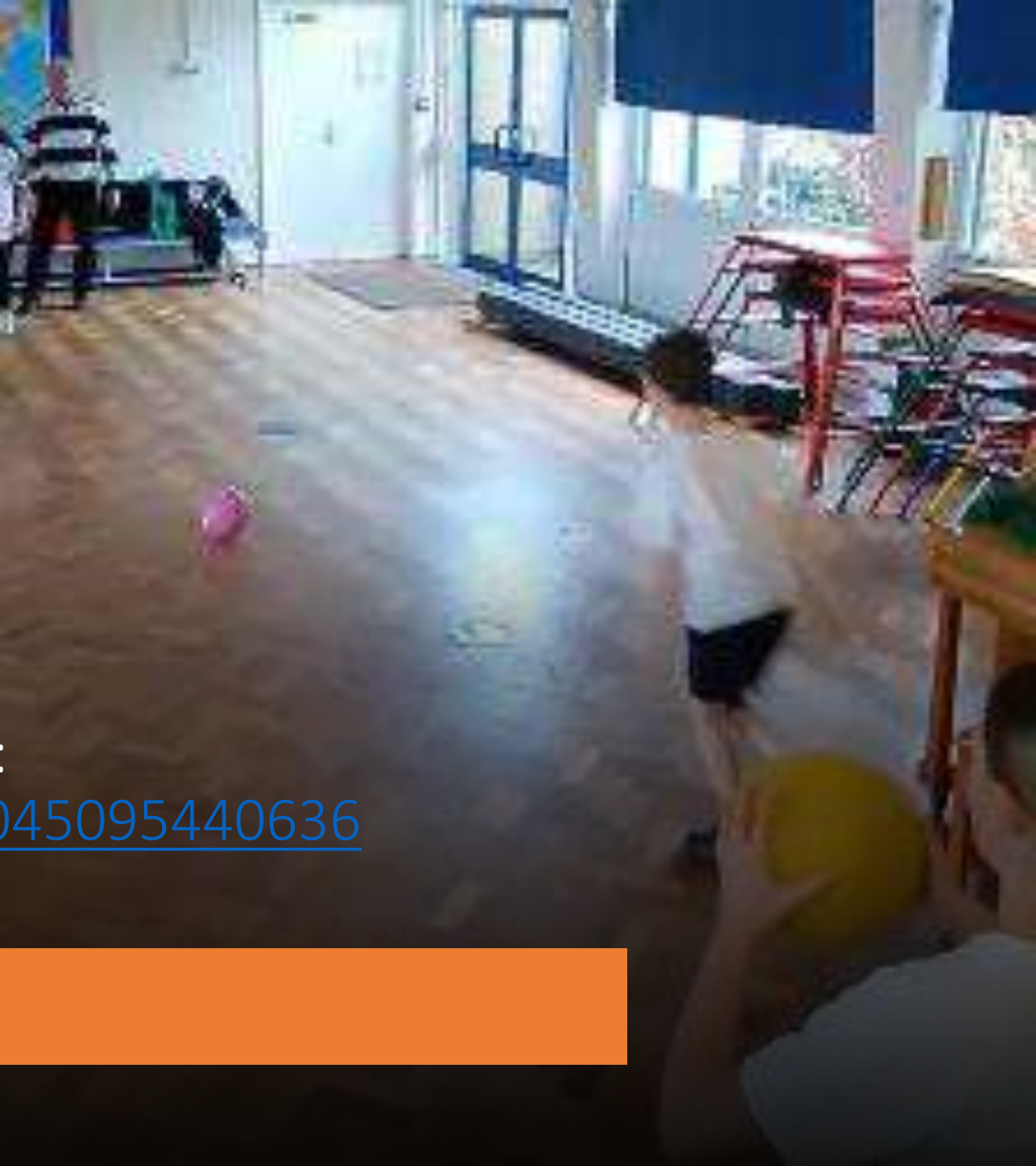

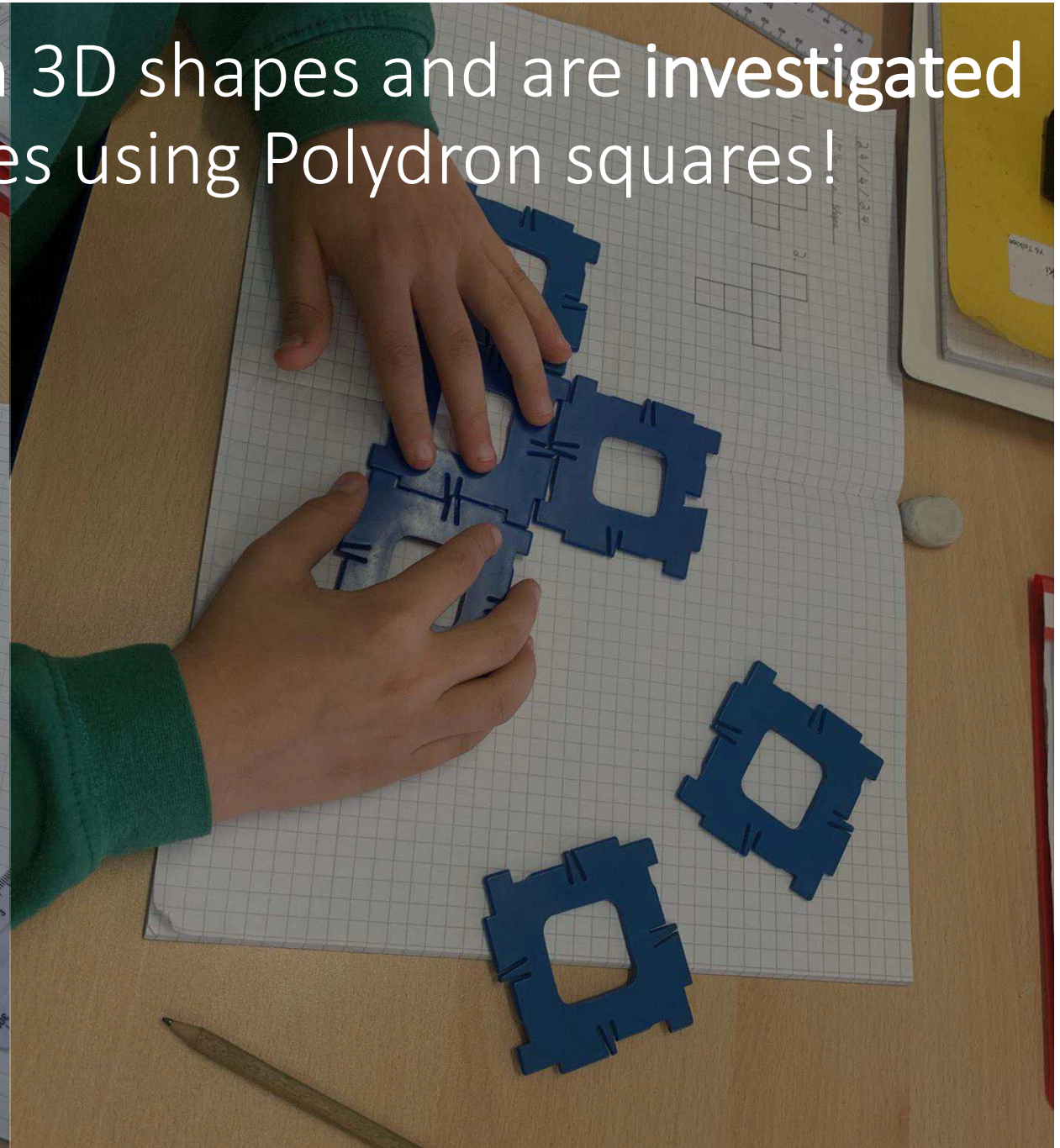
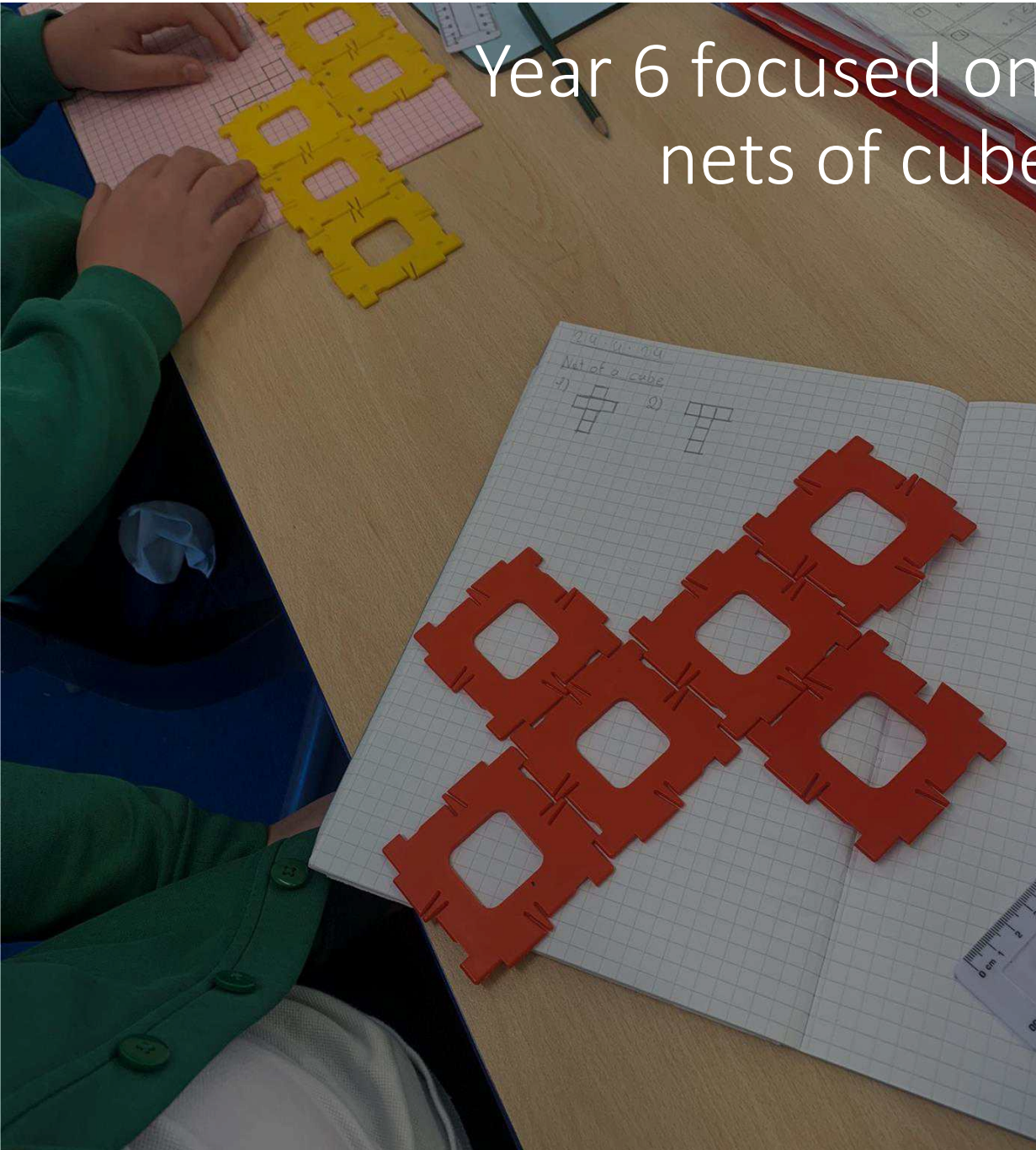
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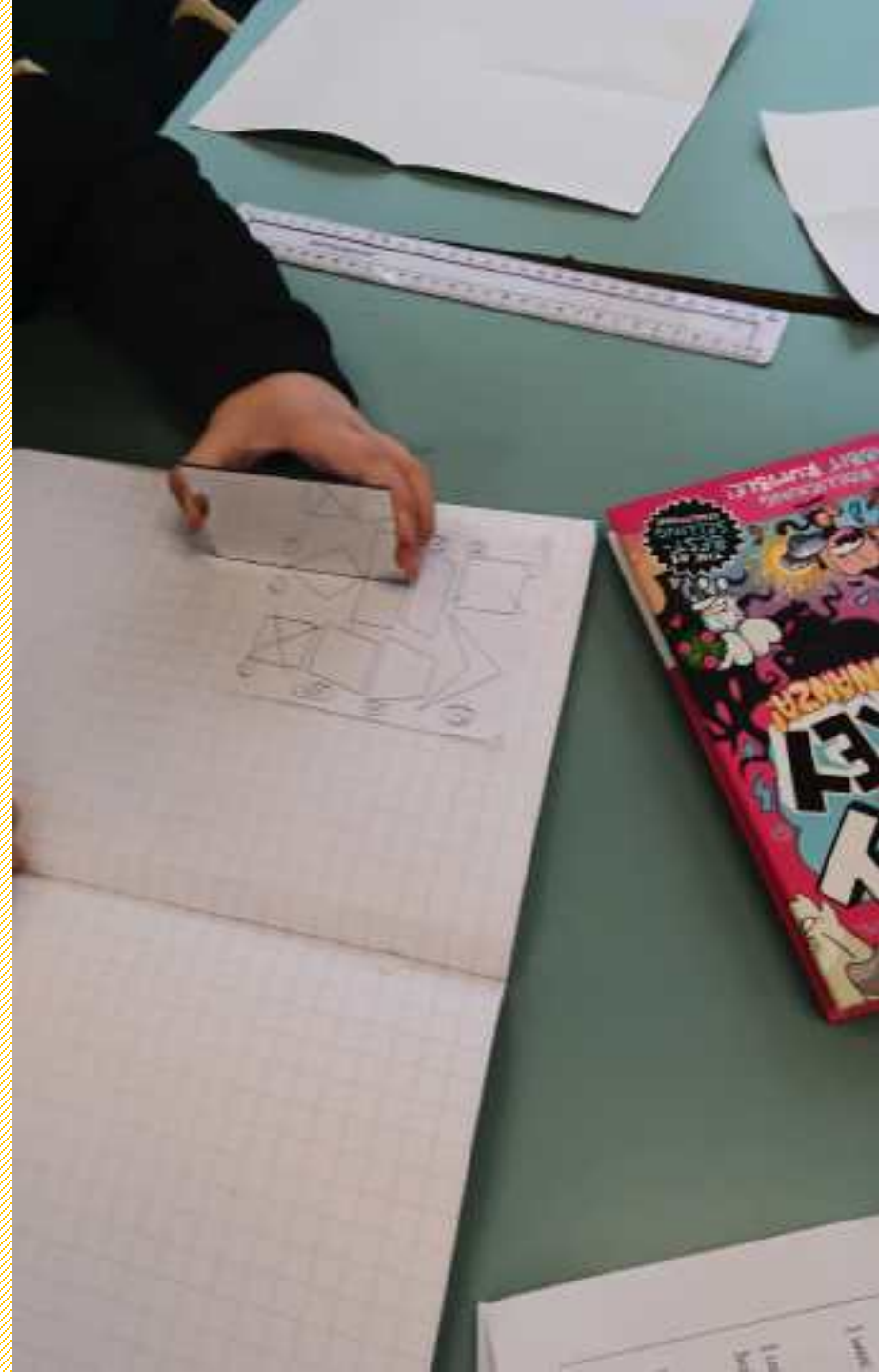
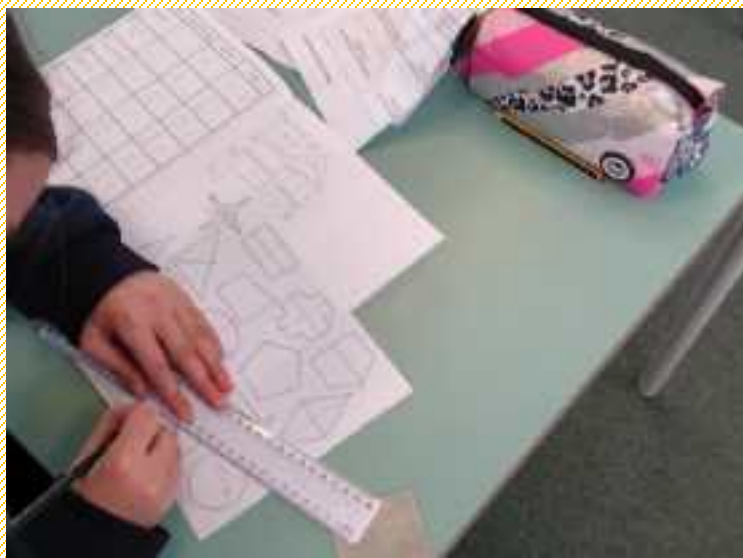
Year One has been investigating plants this week.

We were also delighted that our bean investigation from last week has produced a shoot!

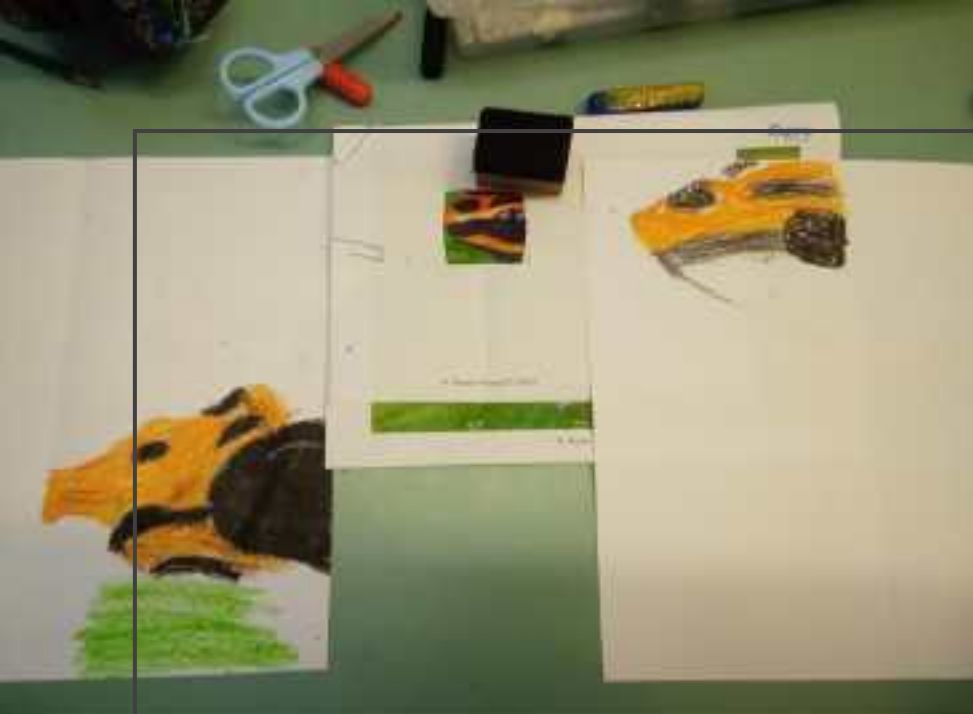


Year 6 focused on 3D shapes and are investigated nets of cubes using Polydron squares!

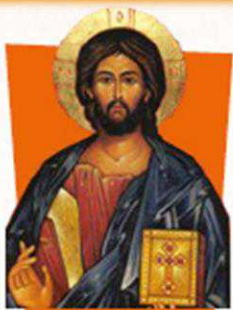

Pope Francis

"May nothing keep you from growing in friendship with God."



Jesus said to his disciples, "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinedresser. Every branch in me that bears no fruit he cuts away, and every branch that does bear fruit he prunes to make it bear even more.

You are pruned already, by means of the word that I have spoken to you. Make your home in me, as I make mine in you. As a branch cannot bear fruit all by itself, but must remain part of the vine, neither can you unless you remain in me. I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever remains in me, with me in him, bears fruit in plenty; for cut off from me you can do nothing. If you remain in me and my words remain in you, you may ask what you will and you shall get it. It is to the glory of my Father that you should bear much fruit, and then you will be my disciples."

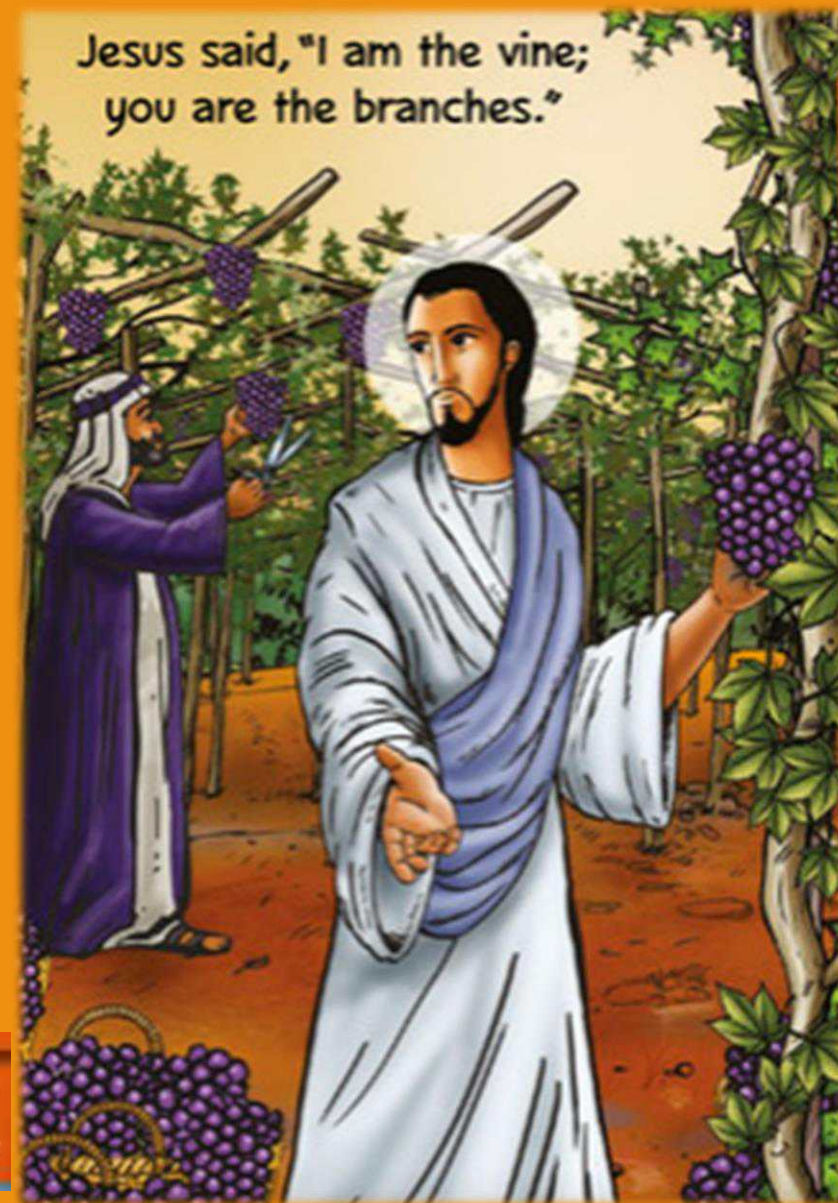
