

## RE

We will continue to follow the liturgical year and study two further topics, which are:

- *Jesus the Messiah* – pupils will explore the appearances of Jesus after his death as well as Jesus' disciples becoming apostles.
- *Called to Serve* – pupils will research the different Sacraments and explore their relationship between belief and worship whilst relating it to their own personal choices.

## Maths

We continue to work through the HfL Essentials Planning. Topics that will be covered this term are:

- Statistics – bar charts, line graphs, pie charts and mean.
- Properties of 3D shapes – knowledge of faces, edges, vertices, and nets of 3D shapes.
- Algebra – one and two step problems as well as constructing and understanding formulas.
- Preparation for KS3 – continued focus on key areas of the curriculum.

## English

- Continuing our picture book study of *'The Journey'* by Francesca Sanna that has a theme of compassion and happiness, where pupils will write in a variety of different styles.
- Beginning our new text – a novel with human themes of exploring values, fear, conflict, and forgiveness.

## Music

- Baroque – define key features of this music style, as well as playing and composing using staff notation.
- Leavers' Song – preparing a memorable song for our leavers' assembly.



## Summer 2024

### PE

- Tolkien – Monday  
Shakespeare - Friday
- Striking and Fielding – throwing, catching, striking, and fielding skills.
  - Athletics – preparation for our annual sports day, including running, jumping and throwing events.

### Computing

- Quizzing – whilst consider their audience, pupils will create a range of quizzes for different audiences.
- Binary – pupils will examine how 1s and 0s are used to represent data in digital systems.

### French

- Extra grammar teaching – focusing on regular and irregular verbs.

## Science

We have two more units to cover this half-term which are:

- Animals – Health and Circulation – pupils will explore factors affecting health, as well as the role of the heart and blood has in the body. Pupils will also investigate the impact exercise has on heart rate.
- Making Connections: Are some sunglasses safer than others? Pupils learning about safety as well as conducting investigations.

## History

- Unheard Histories – Who should feature on the £10 banknote? Pupils will explore historical figures from different eras and professions and explain their significance.

## Geography

- Can I carry out an independent fieldwork enquiry? Pupils will develop an enquiry question and then plan and conduct a fieldwork investigation.

## PSHE

TenTen Relationship and Sex education (RSE) unit –

- Created and Loved by God: Gifts and talents, girls' bodies, boys' bodies, body image, peculiar feelings, emotional changes, making babies and menstruation.

## Art

- Sculpture and 3D – Making memories – pupils will create abstract sculptures from cardboard based on their memories of primary school.

- Cooking and nutrition – Come dine with me – pupils will explore food and flavour combinations before creating a three-course meal.
