




Lots of maths fun in Year 3 this week.

The children are thinking about the value of each digit and were representing their numbers in lots of different ways with the equipment.











They have enjoyed looking at and sharing their 'All About Me' books with their friends. We have also been visiting the Infant library in small groups.





















Jesus and his disciples left for the villages round Caesarea Philippi.
