RE

<u>The Good News:</u> know that families show love by keeping each other happy, healthy and safe; that Jesus shows us how he wants us to live, showing kindness and love in performing miracles. To retell the story of the feeding of the five thousand.

<u>Lent:</u> knowing that Lent is a time to prepare. To understand that praying is talking to God. To retell the story of Jesus arriving in Jerusalem and the events of the Easter week.

Maths

We begin by consolidating our learning on addition and subtraction, building learning by exploring different ways to record. We will be making and finding change using money, estimating and measuring using different scales. We are learning to tell the time and estimating, ordering and comparing time. We will be doubling and halving, and developing this into time tables,(x2,5s, and 10s). We build on Y1 learning in multiplication and division, including problem solving.

Art and Design

Painting and mixed media: exploring colour, making texture and them creating a collage form the textured papers created.

Design and Technology

Cooking and Nutrition: Balanced diet: what is a balanced diet? Food groups, planning and preparing a recipe.

Music: Orchestral Instruments: Through traditional stories, listen to orchestral instruments and identify them, select and create sounds to accompany a story and perform it to peers.
