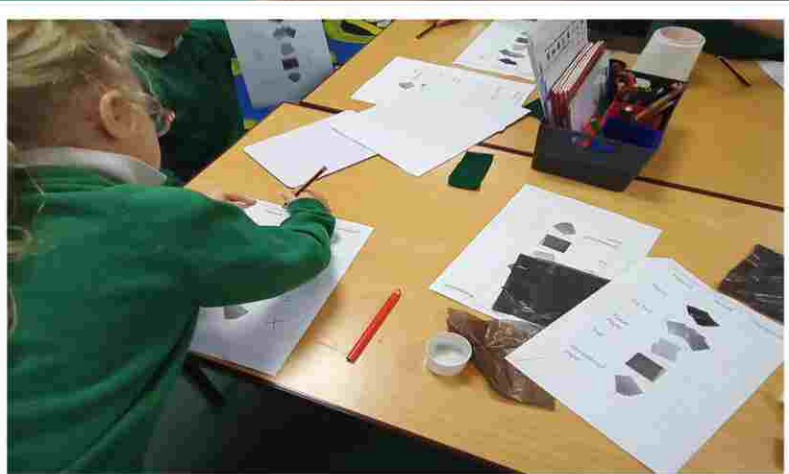

In Y2's geography lesson, the children were investigating local habitats.



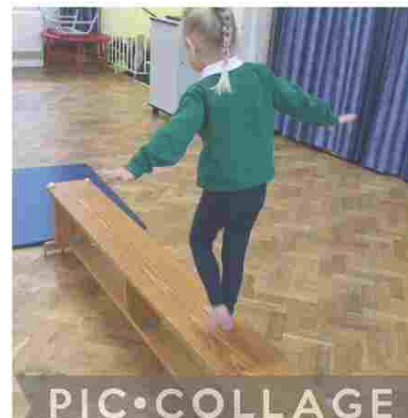
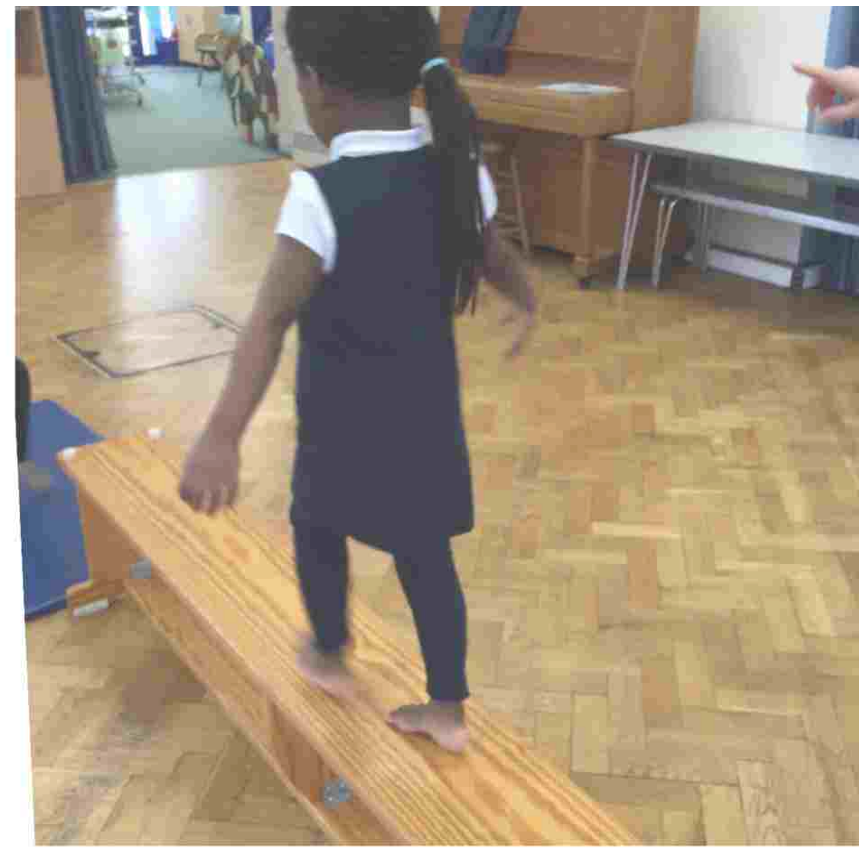


Y6 MF have been learning about CHIAROSCURO in Art and have been exploring the use of light and dark. Here are some of their finished pieces!





The Nursery children exploring how they can travel safely on equipment.

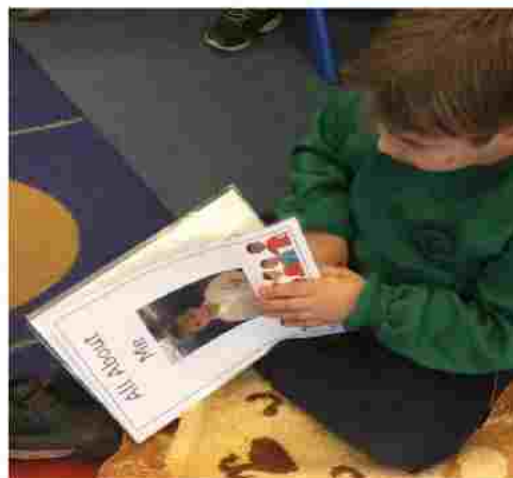

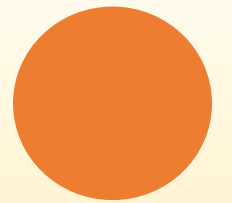
# Our Winter Wednesday Wellie Walk in Nursery

Thank you to Mr. Jennings and SLT - they are fabulous balls. Look at us bouncing and catching them!

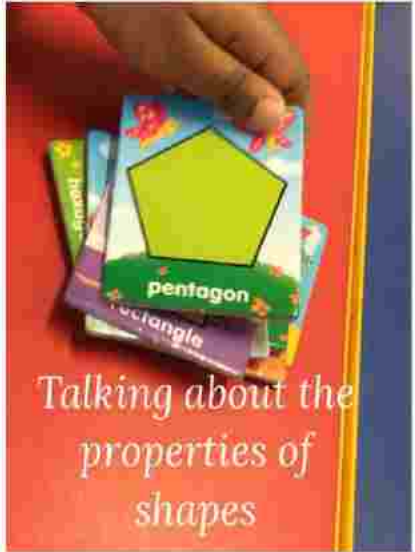






Year 6 have been learning about the 7 sacraments and sorting them into sacraments of Initiation, Service and Healing.

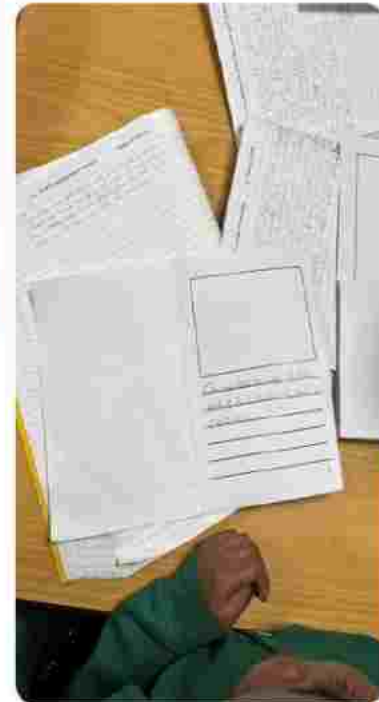
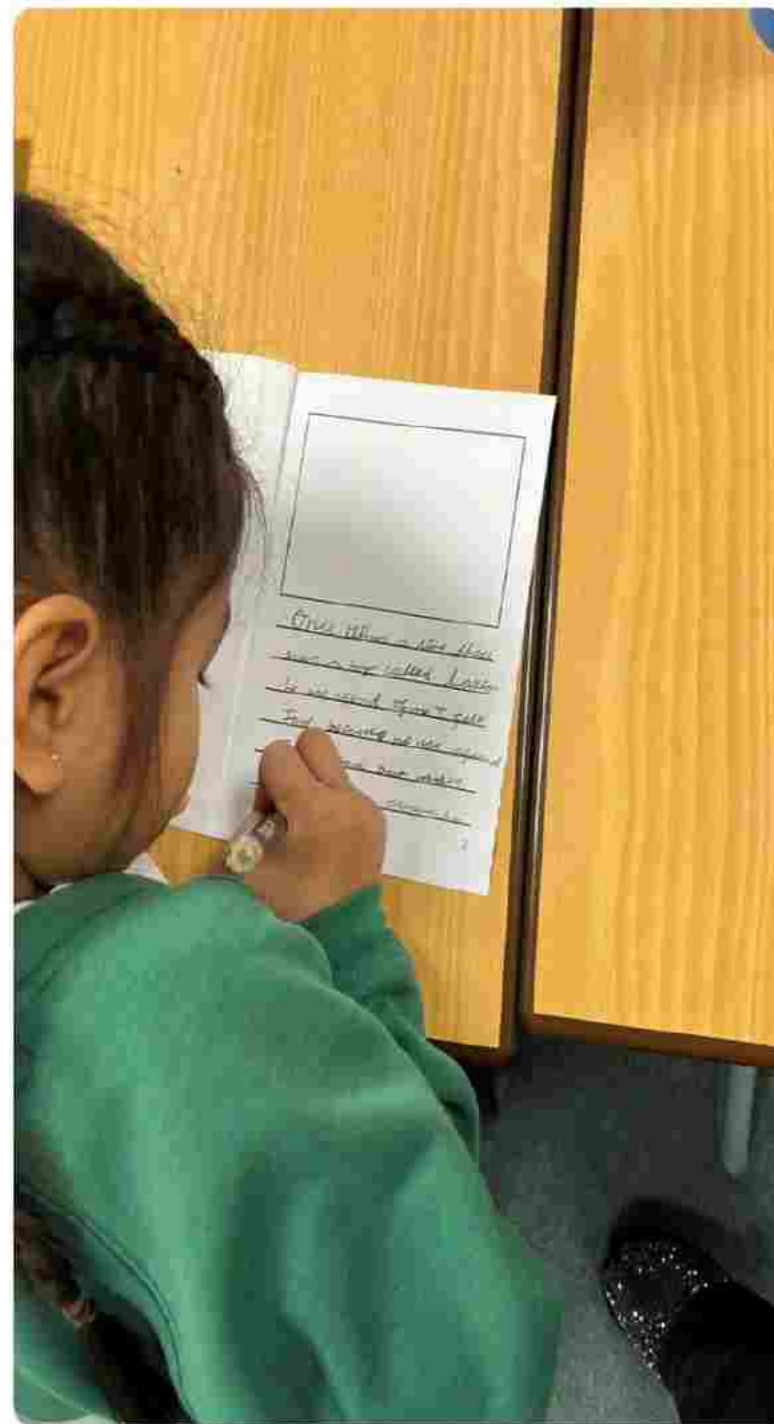
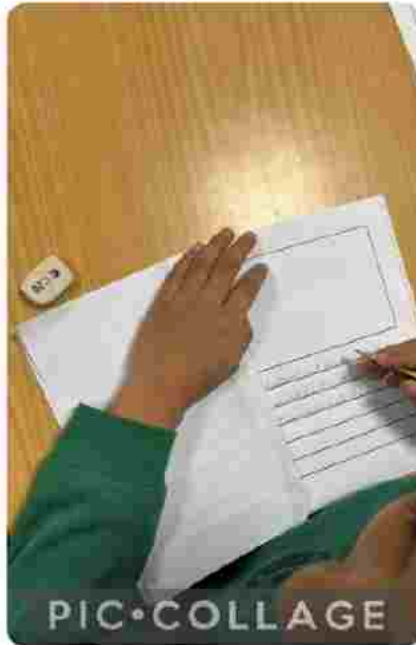
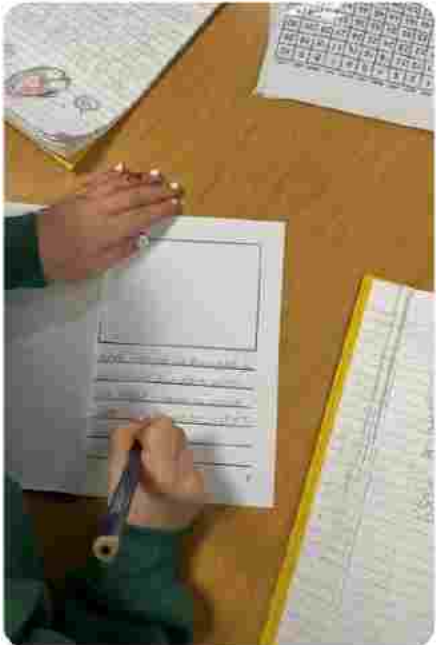
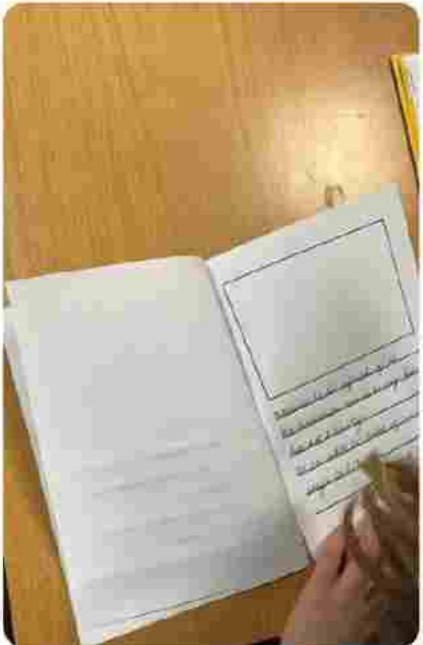
# Nursery busy learning and having fun!

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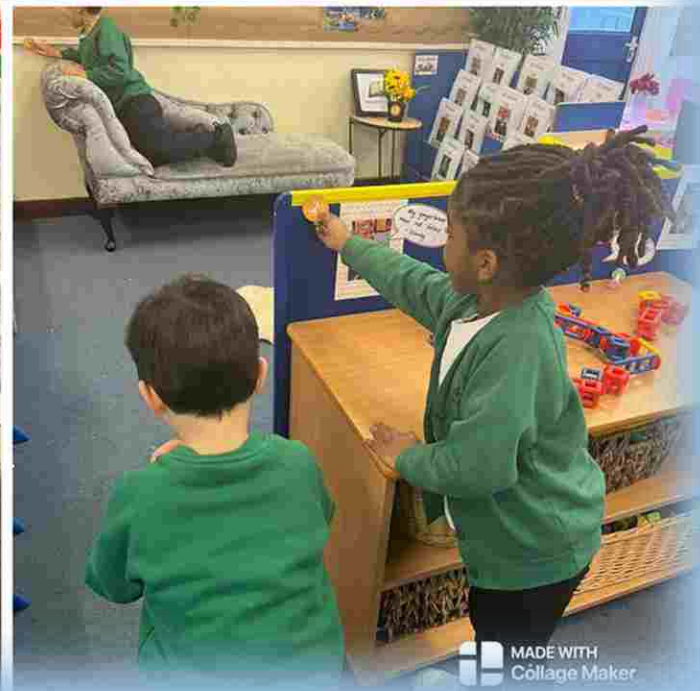


The Reception children had a fantastic time celebrating NSPCC Number Day



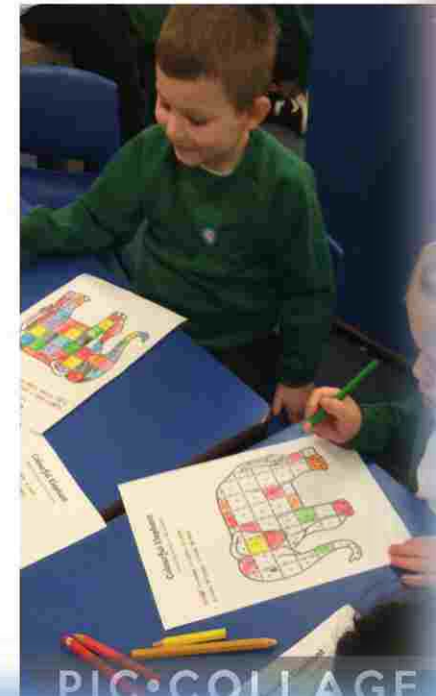


Initially we went on a number hunt in the classroom

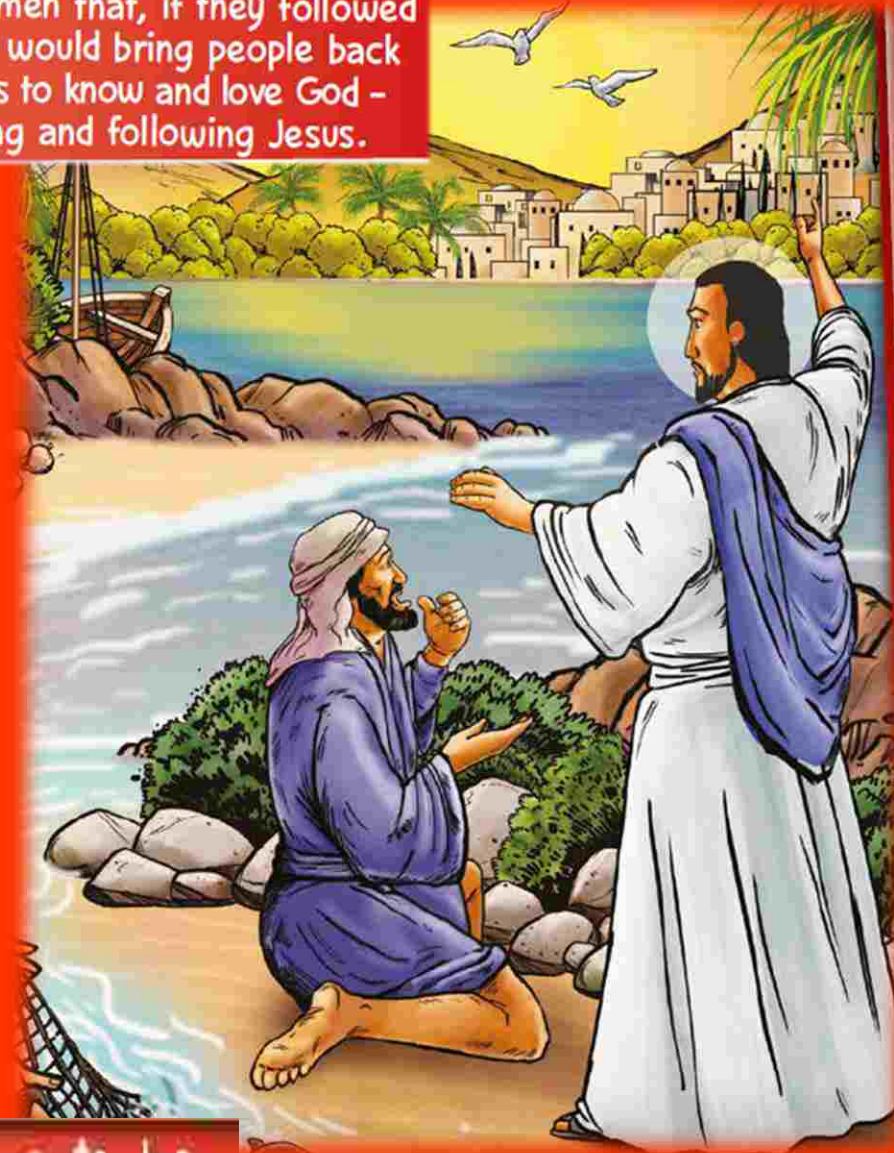
