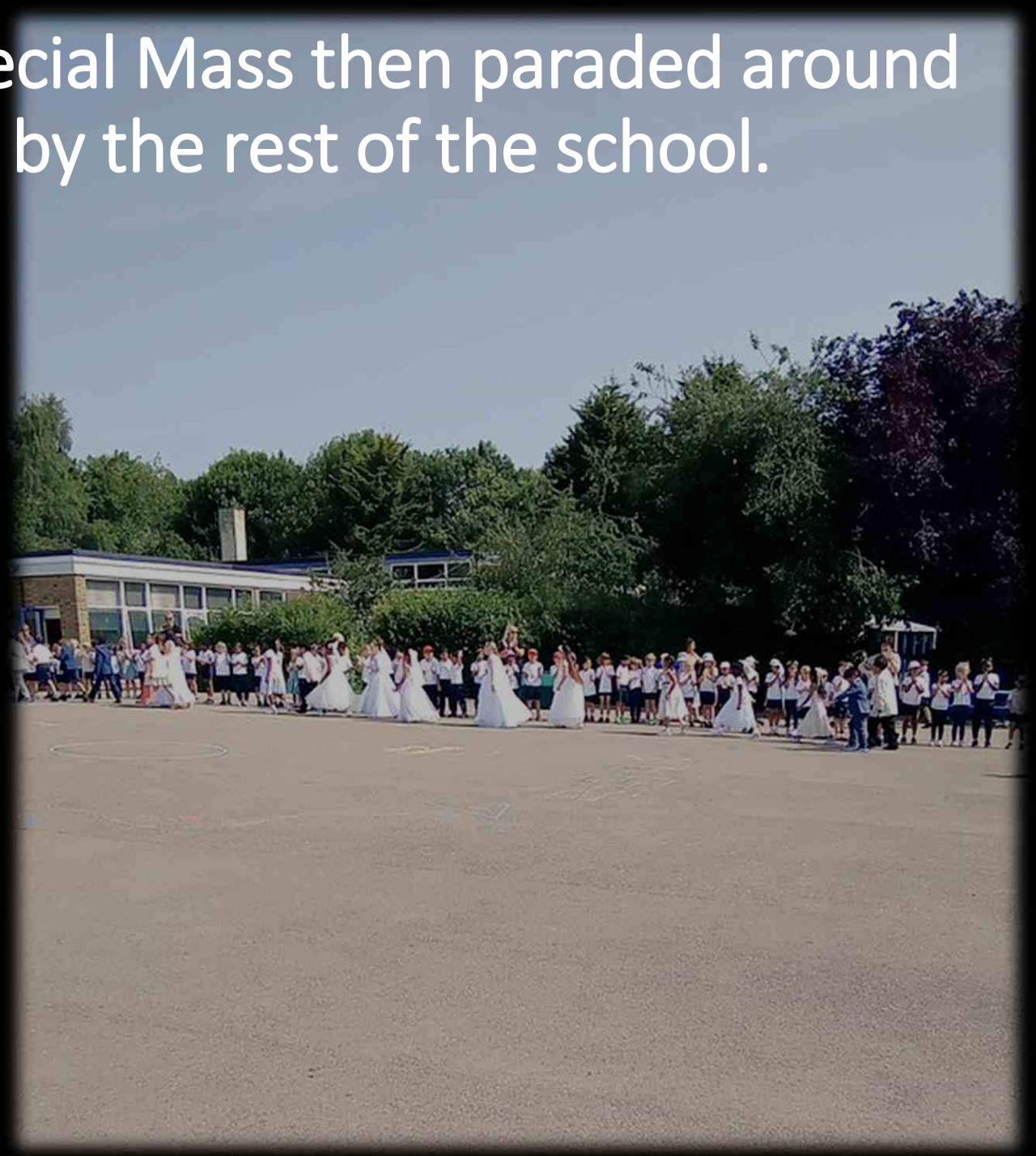


Year 6 creating cardboard relief sculptures to represent their memories of primary school through abstract and literal shapes.

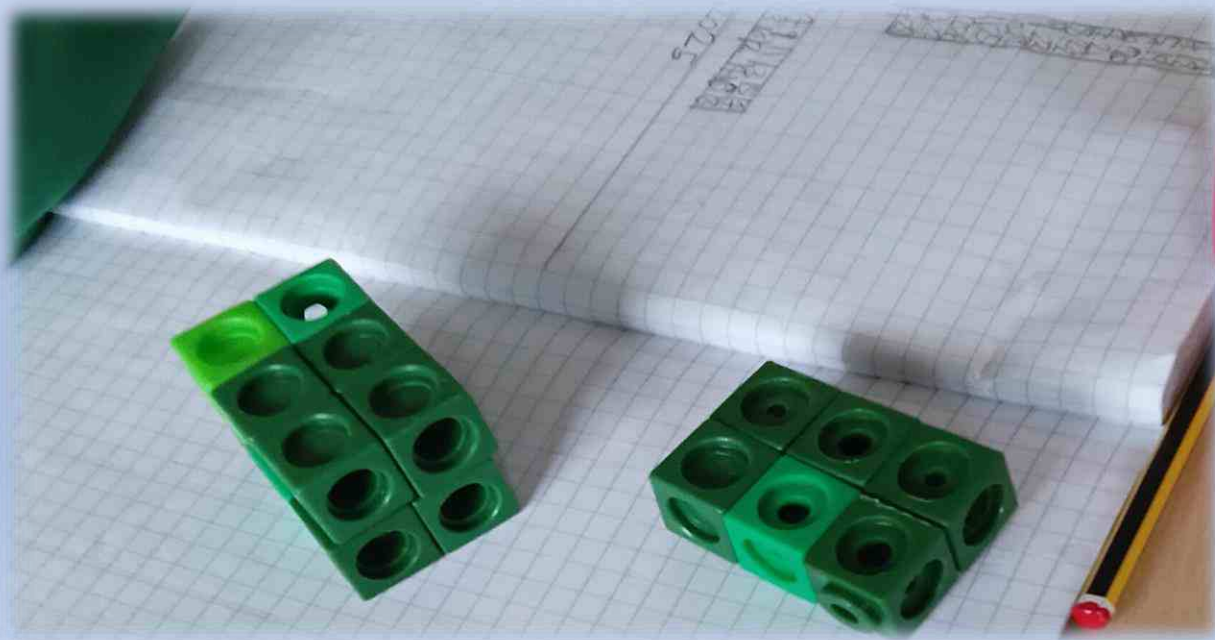
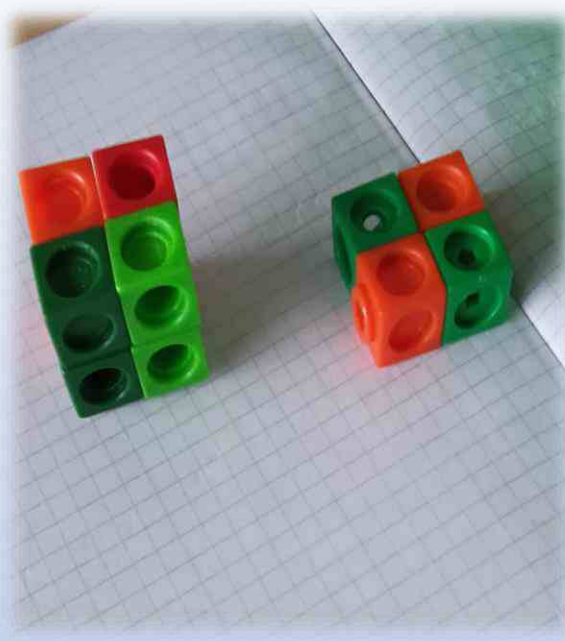

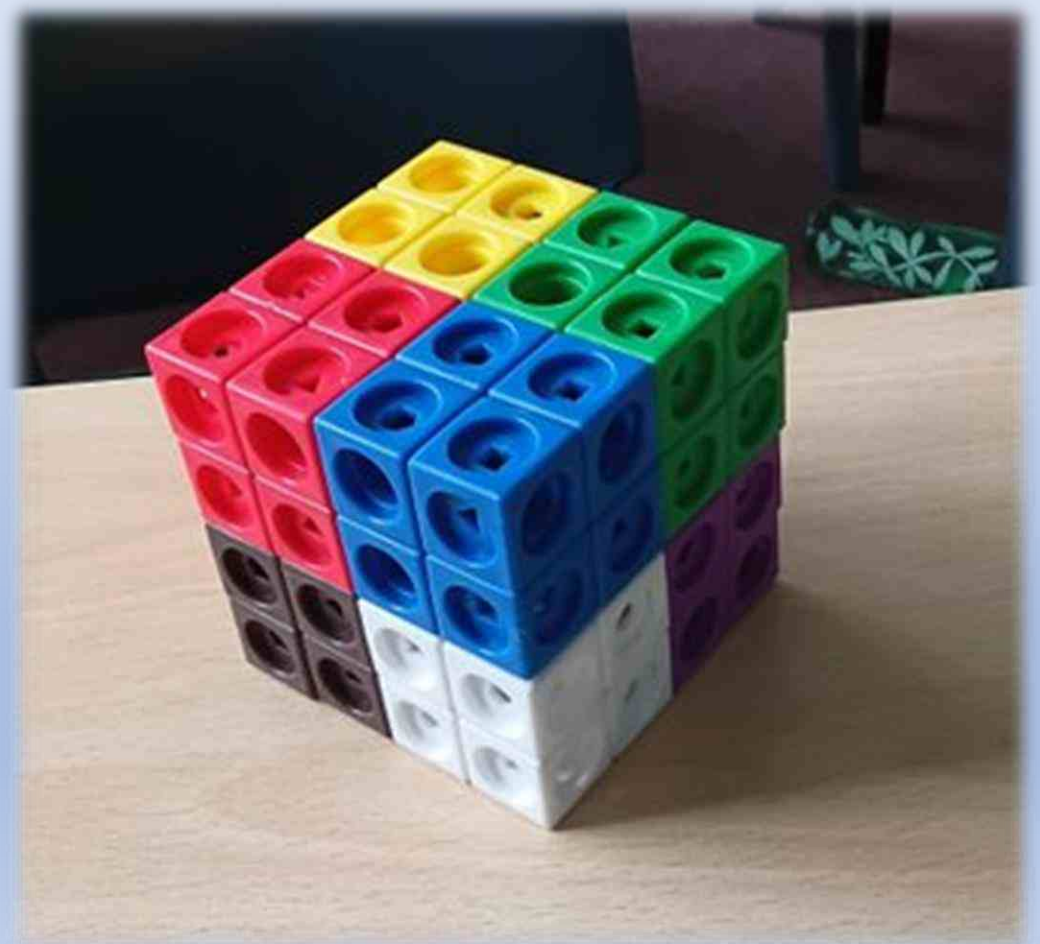

HOLY TRINITY

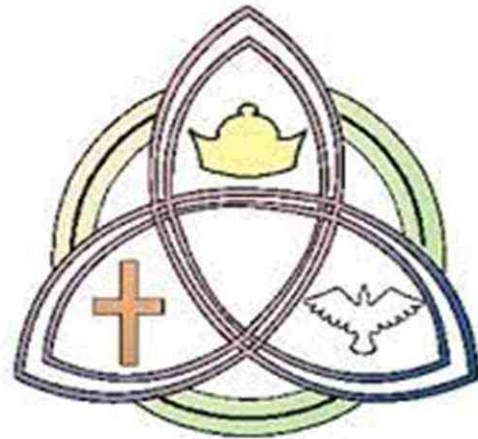
