










Children in Reception are having lots of fun outside in the sunshine. We have a new role play area which is a cafe, we are experimenting with the percussion instruments and practising our counting skills.




























This week in Lego club, we built models of our Arctic Ride to help us explore!



















Year 5 experimented with yeast, mixing it with different ingredients.

Year 3 enjoying their PE session, in the sunshine, problem solving. Working together as a team is such an important skill.






Year 3 joined together to do the rosary, as we think of Mary our mother during the month of October.


Year 3 Seacole really enjoyed creating their cave paintings. Can you guess the animals on the cave walls?

The pupils enjoyed observing how chalk reacts to vinegar (acid).




Year One had an enjoyable, relaxing time exploring lines. Can you spot wavy, curved, zigzags, dashed and dotted lines?



















