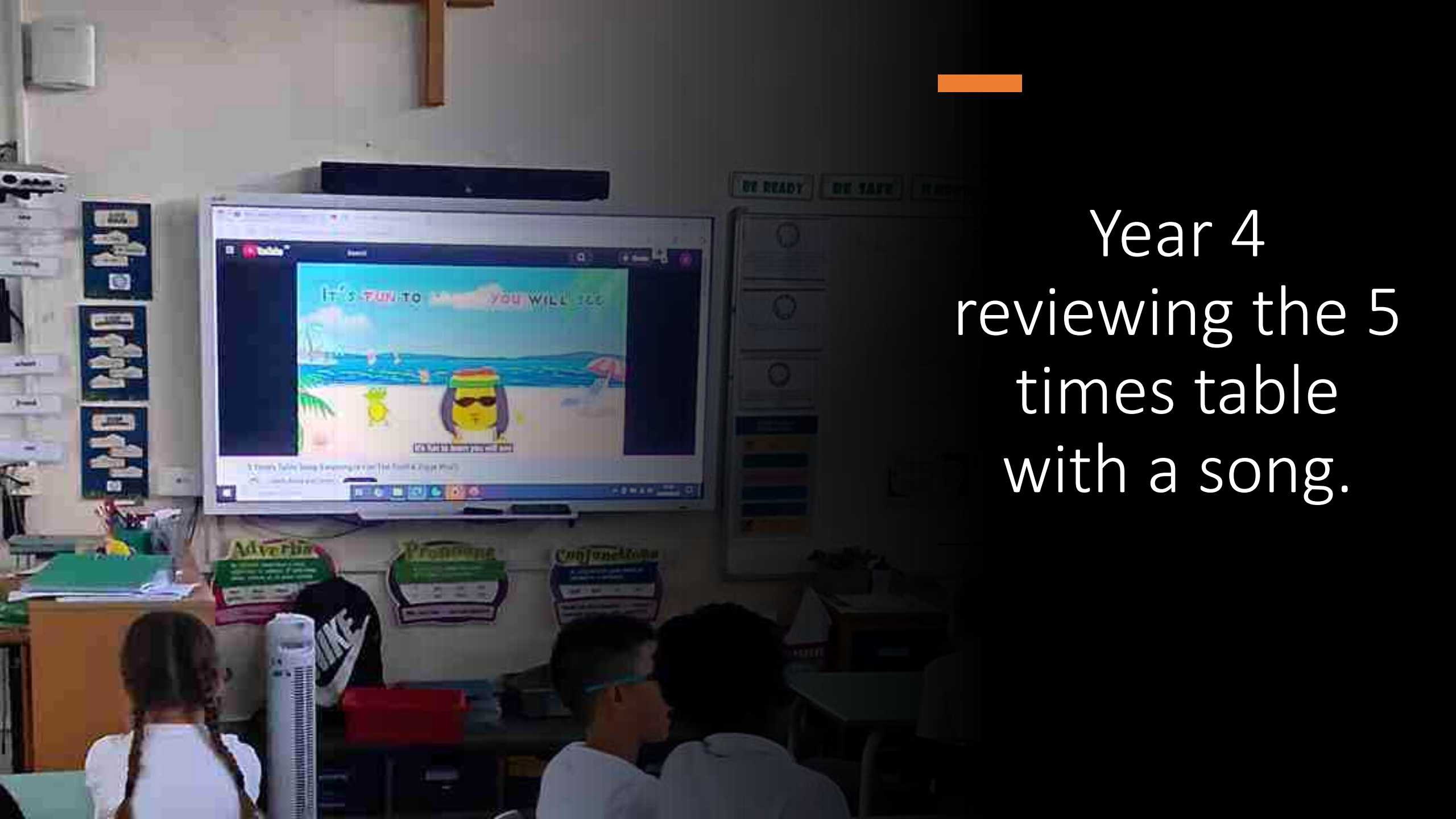

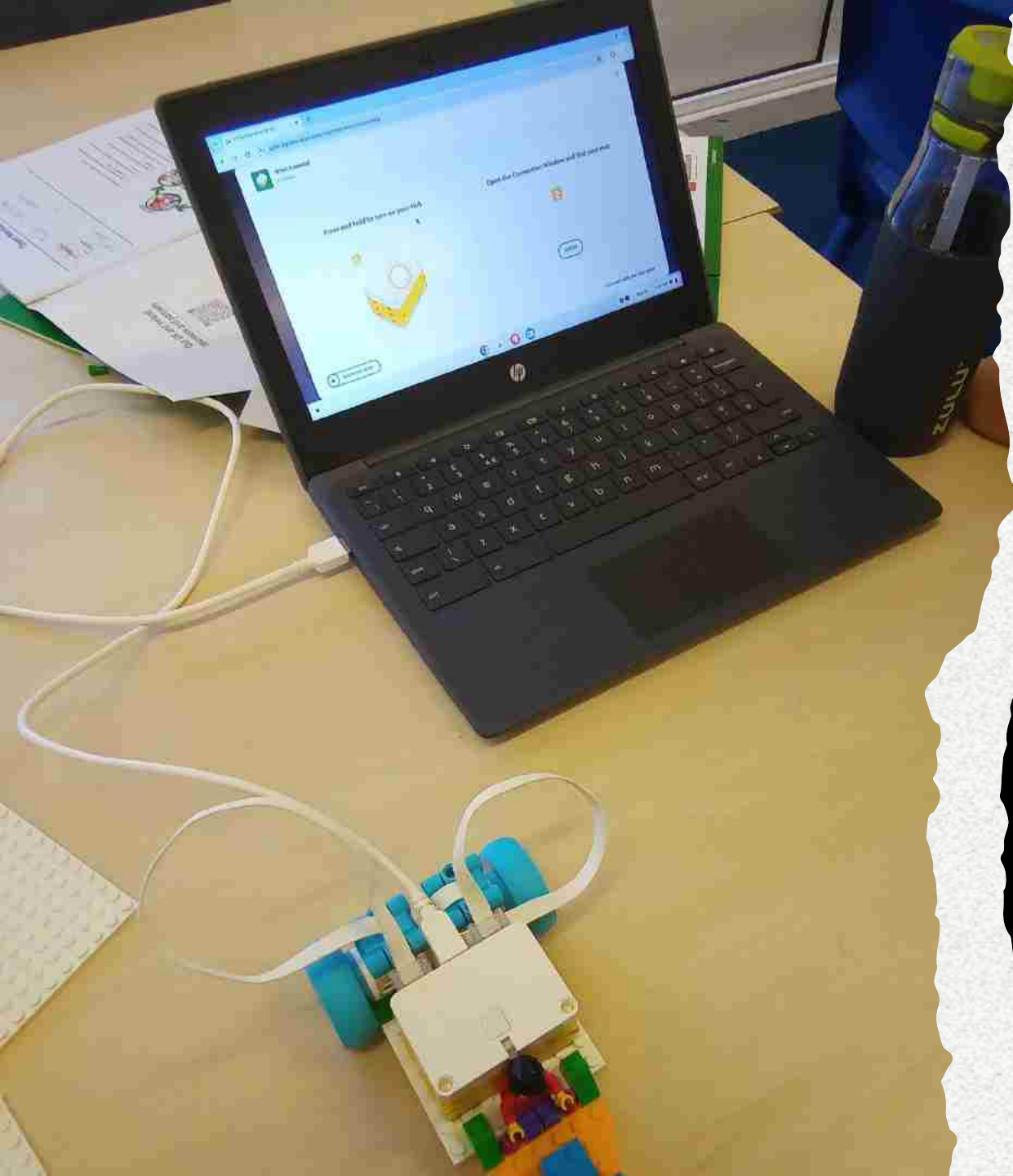

skills.

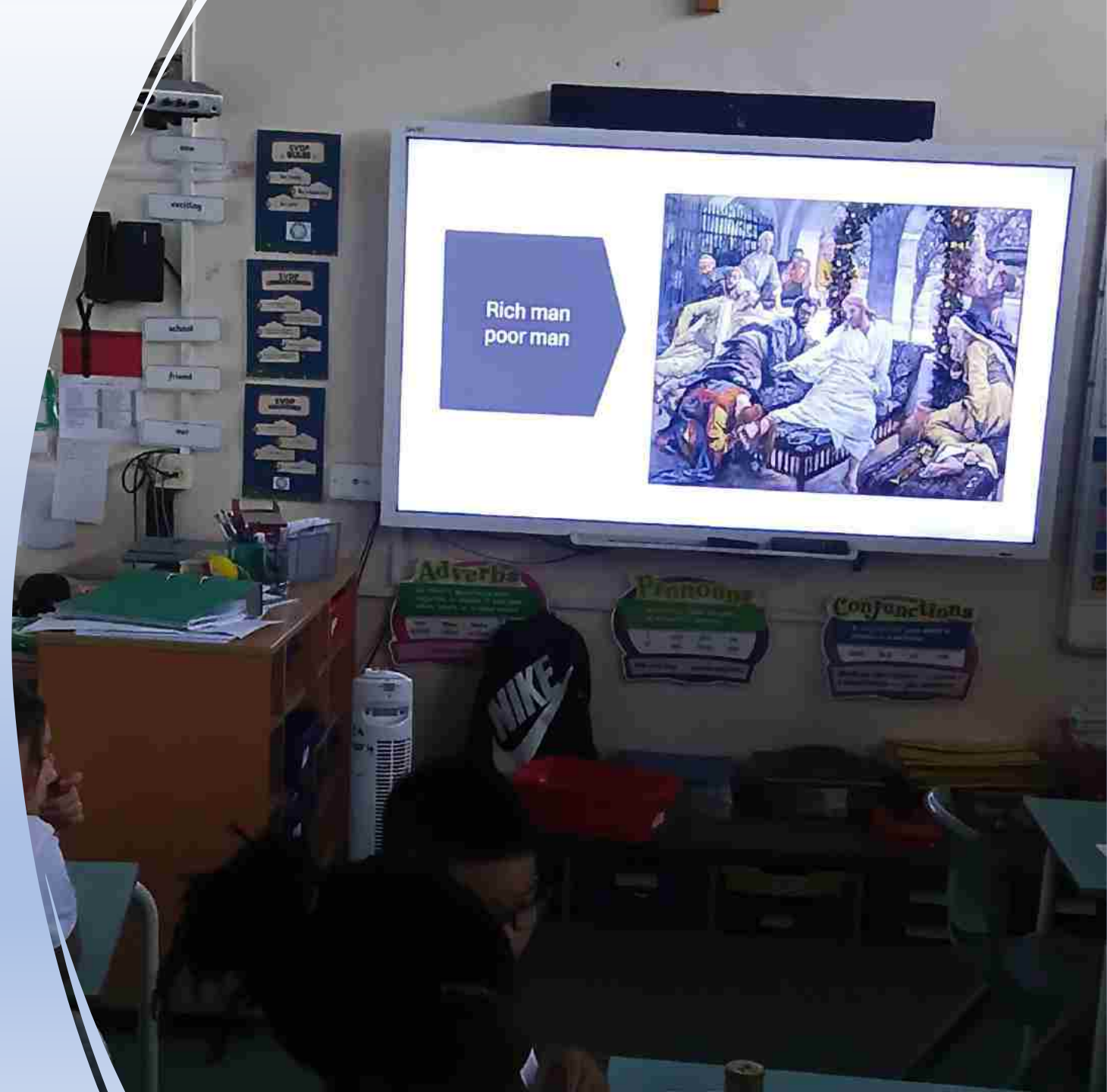


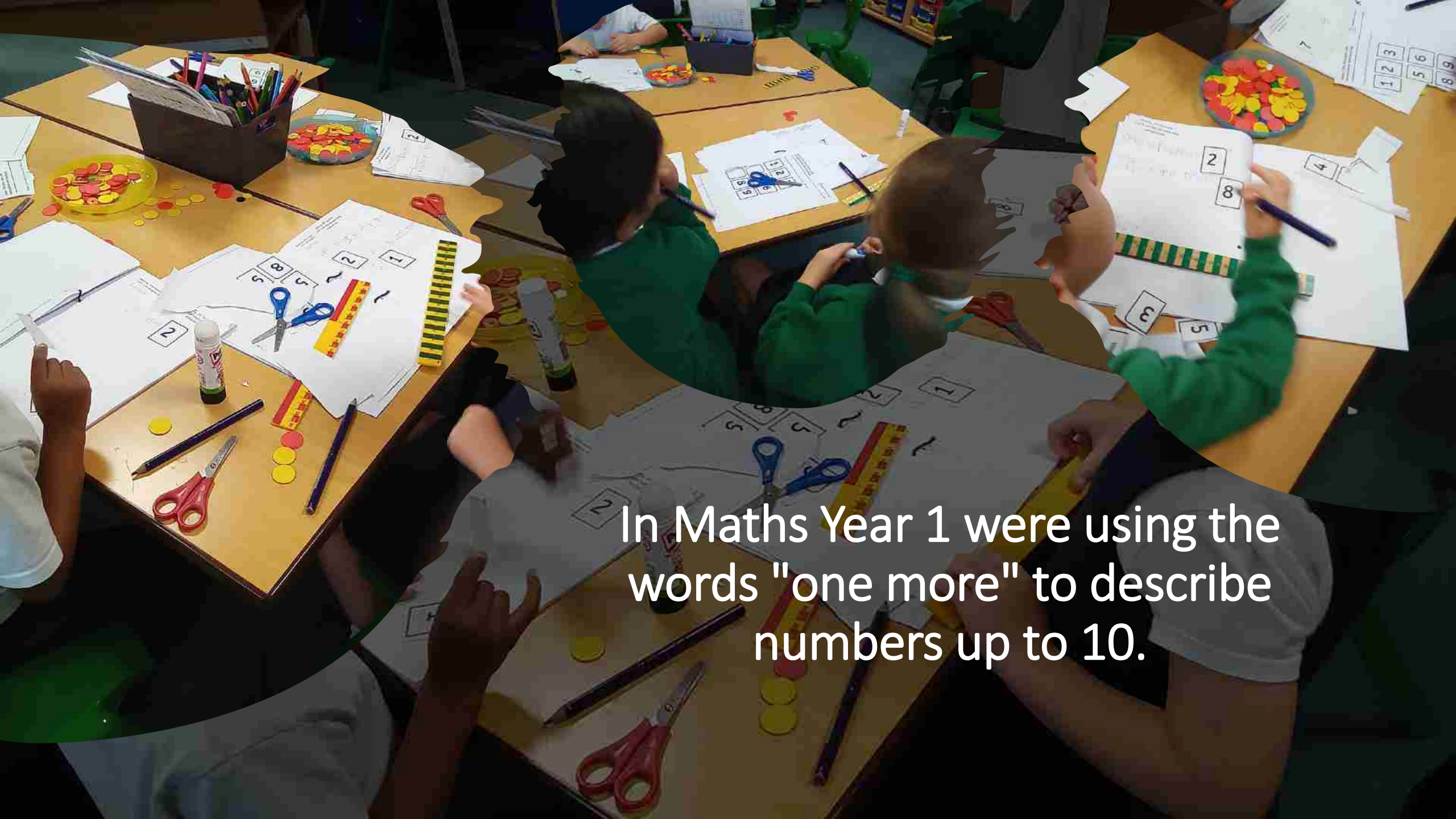




This week in Lego club,

Working together as a team is such an important skill.

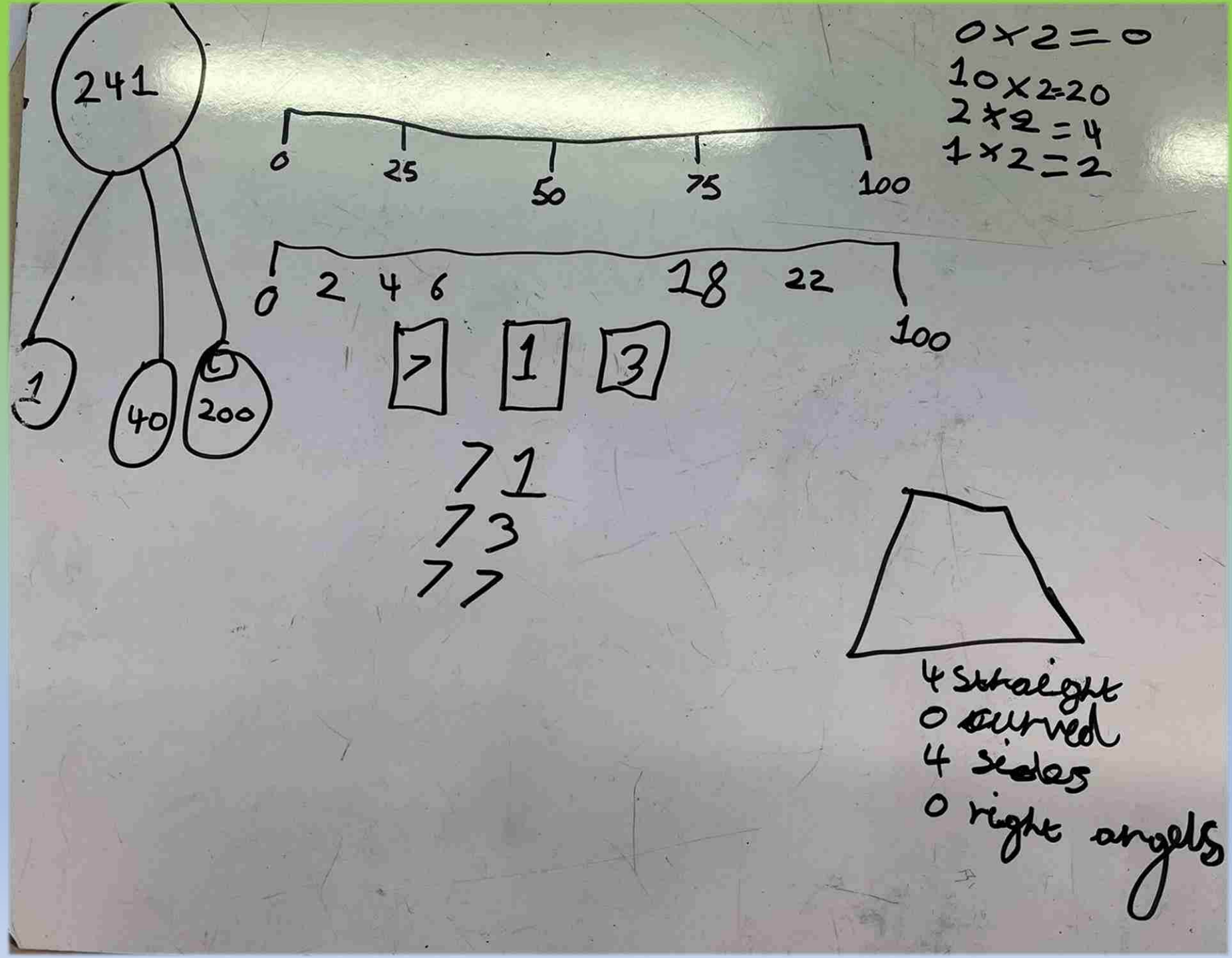




Year 3 joined together to do the rosary, as we think of Mary our mother during the month of October.

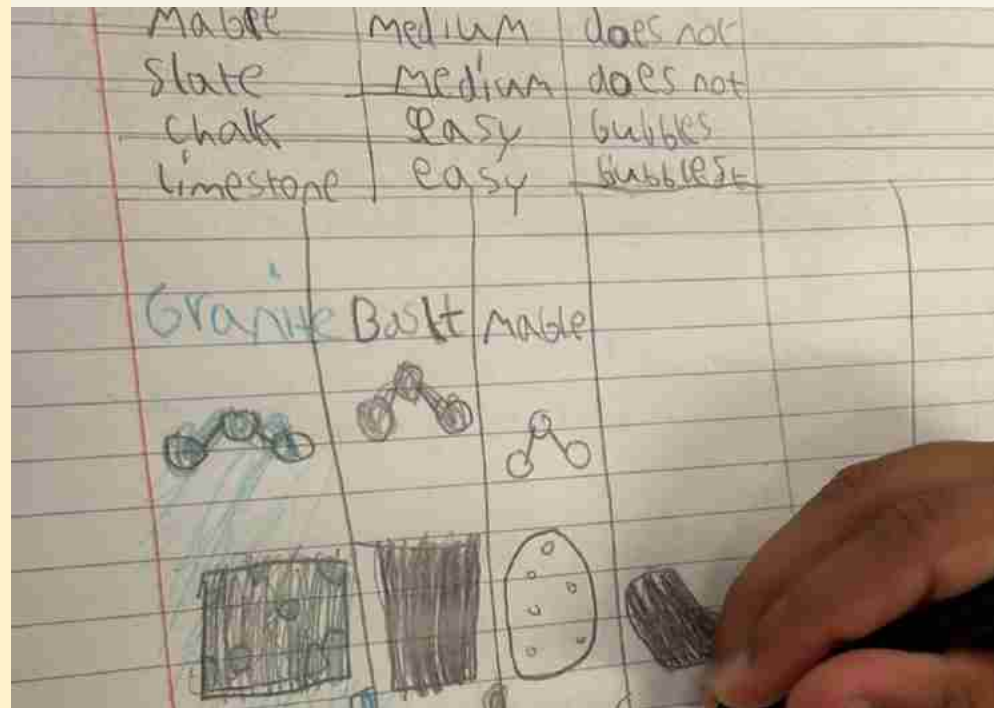

This week Year 3 has been investigating the properties of rocks by doing the hardness and acid test. The pupils enjoyed observing how chalk reacts to vinegar (acid).



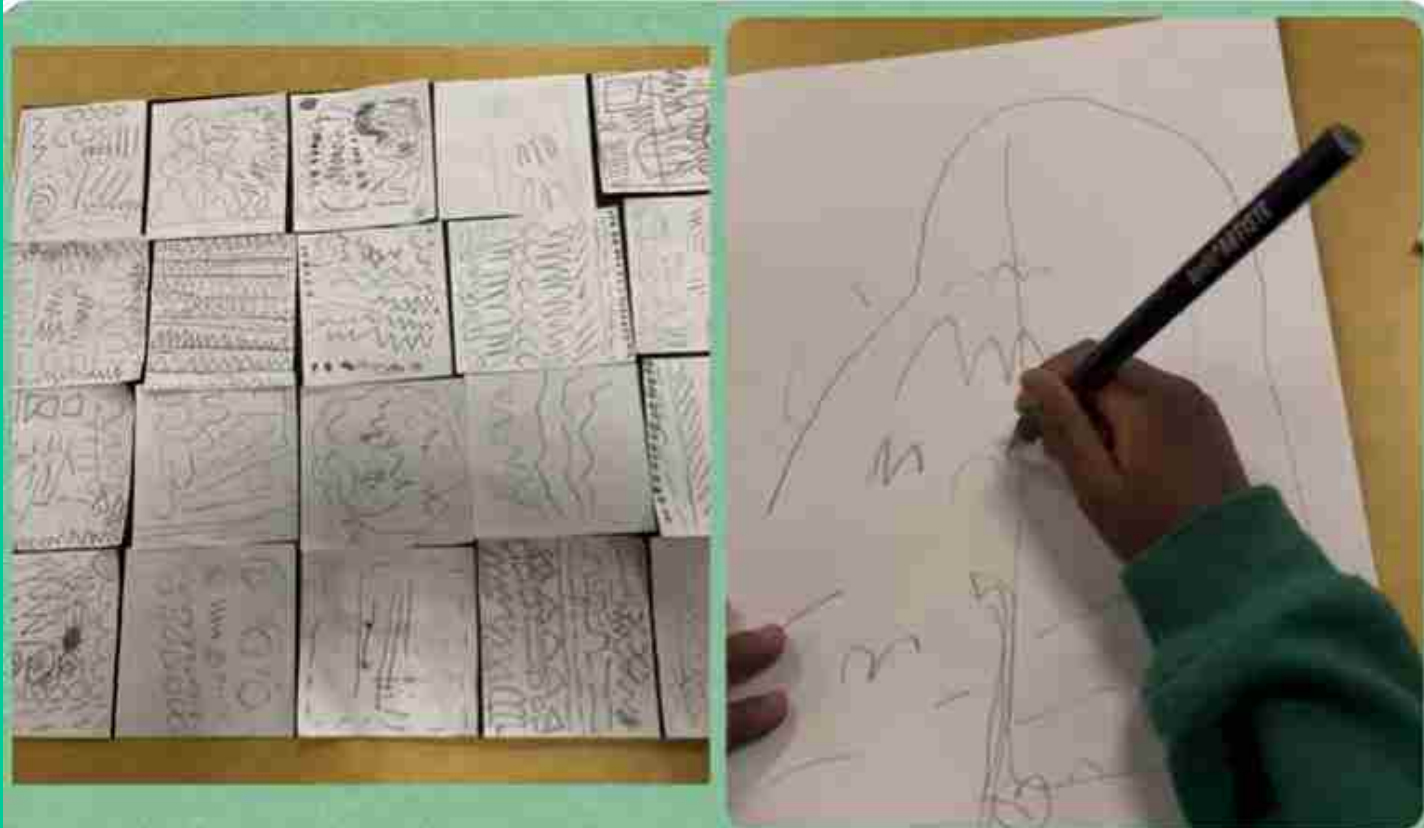
Year One had an enjoyable, relaxing time exploring lines. Can you spot wavy, curved, zigzags, dashed and dotted lines?

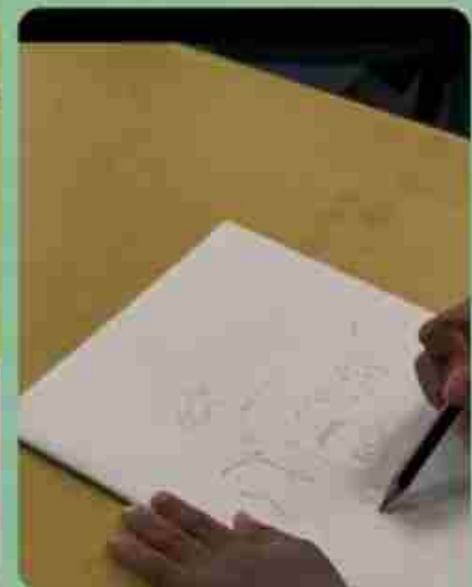
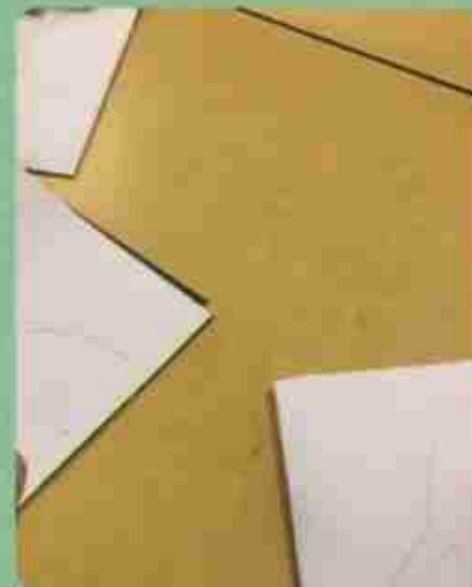

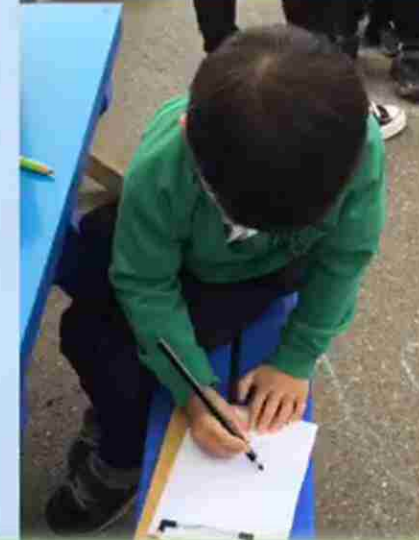
