




We are all looking forward to working with you after the holidays, getting to know you and supporting your learning.

Pencil case	One pencil case, not too big, it will need to fit into your tray
Wet ink pen (NOT biro)	Blue or black – we will also have one for you
Pencil	At least 2 – we will also have 2 for you
Rubber (1)	Optional—we have plenty in class
Pencil sharpener	Optional—we have plenty in class
Coloured pencils	Optional—we do have plenty in class
Plimsolls	Please bring some indoor shoes
School bag	Make sure it fits into a school locker!
Snacks	Snacks are eaten after break time, please only bring fruit or vegetables
Water bottle	You can refill this during the day
Sorry Please don't bring any of these.	Toy pencil sharpeners, Sharpies or any permanent pens, Post-it notes, Sellotape, Tipp-Ex, felt-tips, toys
