










Outside learning in Reception

Managing to remain calm and cool this week.






















The children in Reception enjoyed sharing their special books with their friends.






IN THIS SCHOOL

We have been learning about worms and singing a new rhyme.







Cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, cast out devils. You received without charge, give without charge."






